 - (ii) Clear internal firebreaks not less than 10 metres (1/2 chain) wide surrounding compartments of maximum area of 100 hectares (250 acres).
6. Mobile Fire Fighting Units—

Throughout the abovementioned period during the conduct of the harvest of grain and seed an operational mobile fire fighting unit of minimum 450 litre capacity must be in close proximity to the harvest activities at all times.

- (1) to control the development of all forms of tourism related activities in specified sites where advantages by means of location and accessibility may enhance the proposed use.

- (b) any residential building;

Museum: means land and buildings used for storing and exhibiting objects and artefacts illustrative of history, natural history, art, nature and culture.

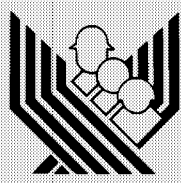
