- 10. In paragraph (n) after "lake" insert "without lawful authority".
- 11. In paragraph (q) after "utensil" insert "in a careless, dangerous or reckless manner which could endanger the health or safety of any person,".
- 12. In paragraph (r), delete "climb" and substitute "without lawful authority, climb so as to damage", and delete "without the written consent of the Council,".
- 13. In paragraph (u) delete "except in the course of a function being lawfully held" and substitute "in a dangerous manner or so as to cause nuisance".
- 14. In paragraph (v) insert after "missile" being the last word of the paragraph, "in a dangerous manner or so as to cause nuisance".
- 15. In paragraph (w) delete "or annoyance".
- 16. In paragraph (x) delete "or annoyance".
- 17. In paragraph (z) delete "unless authorised by the Council" and substitute "which is the property of the Council so as to cause damage thereto or expose property of the Council to damage or vandalism".
