#### 1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Coal Industry Superannuation Amendment Regulations 1998*.

(B) such lesser amount as is determined by the Board on the recommendation of the actuary;

and

(ii) any additional amount agreed between the Board and all employers.

"

**EXEMPTION CERTIFICATE PURSUANT TO REGULATION 2.13**

I, NEIL BARTHOLOMAEUS, WorkSafe Western Australia Commissioner, hereby grant an exemption to Agriculture Western Australia from the specific requirements of subsections (g), (k), (r) and (t) of section 3.8 of AS2359.2–1985 under Regulation 4.55(a) of the Occupational Safety and Health Regulations 1996 in relation to the use of a tractor mounted platform for the inspection of sugarcane crops for sugarcane smut disease in the Ord River Irrigation Area, provided the following conditions are met—

- the Safety Protocol at Appendix 1 be amended to only allow a travelling speed of up to 5km per hour while personnel are being transported;
- (ii) the operator is to remain at the tractor controls at all times when personnel are being transported;
- (iii) the operator is to ensure the platform is lifted to the required height to check all systems are functioning correctly prior to any person being elevated or supported by the platform;
- (iv) warning signs or barriers are to be used to prevent interference while the platform is in use and/or being lifted in any area subject to passing traffic;
- (v) the tractor with mounted work platform is not to be used for any other purpose; and
- (vi) any operator of the tractor with mounted work platform shall be trained in and familiarised with the operation of this particular unit.
