METROPOLITAN REGION SCHEME (SECTION 33) AMENDMENT No. 1001/33 SOUTH WEST DISTRICTS OMNIBUS (No. 3A)-JERVOISE BAY

OUTCOME OF SUBMISSIONS

The Western Australian Planning Commission has considered all the submissions received in respect of the amendment proposals for the 'South West Districts Omnibus (No. 3A)—Jervoise Bay' amend-ment No. 1001/33. This proposal was first published in the *Government Gazette* on 6 February 1998. The amendment is shown on Western Australian Planning Commission plan 3.1163.

The amendment has been presented to and approved by the Governor in accordance with the requirements of the Metropolitan Region Town Planning Scheme Act. It will now be tabled in both Houses of Parliament, where it must remain for 12 sitting days. During this time either House may, by resolu-tion, disallow the amendment. As soon as the amendment is no longer subject to disallowance it becomes legally effective in the Metropolitan Region Scheme.
