1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the Vocational Education and Training Amendment Regulations 1999.

15A. Tuition fees for overseas students

- (1) The tuition fee for any course for a student who is not an Australian resident is —
 - (a) if there is a relevant determination in force under this regulation, the fee specified in that determination; or
 - (b) otherwise, the fee calculated in accordance with regulation 12, 13, 14 or 15, as the case requires.

- (3) The Minister may determine different fees for different courses or different students based on
 - (a) the categories of the course;
 - (b) the subject matter of the course;
 - (c) which college provides the course;
 - (d) the country of origin of the student;
 - (e) the level and extent of the student's previous vocational education, training and experience; or
 - (f) any other criteria the Minister considers relevant to the cost of providing the course,

or any combination of those criteria.

(4) In this regulation —

"Australian resident" means a person who ----

- (a) is an Australian citizen within the meaning of the *Australian Citizenship Act 1948* of the Commonwealth; or
- (b) holds a permanent visa within the meaning of the *Migration Act 1958* of the Commonwealth.

MEDICAL ACT 1894

IN THE MATTER OF AN INQUIRY WITH REFERENCE TO THE CONDUCT OF DR WILLIAM PETER JONES

Date Heard: 8th and 26th February 1999

Medical Board of Western Australia.

I advise that the Medical Board of Western Australia convened on 8 February 1999 and 26 February 1999 pursuant to section 13 of the Medical Act 1894 (as amended).

Particulars of the findings of the Board are as follows-

- 1. That Dr Jones is guilty of infamous and improper conduct in a professional respect;
- 2. That Dr Jones is affected by a dependence on alcohol;
- 3. Dr Jones is guilty of gross carelessness in prescribing an adult dosage of medication for a child;
- 4. Dr Jones is guilty of failing to comply with the restriction imposed by the Board relating to the prescribing of Schedule 8 drugs without the prior authority of the Board; and
- 5. That Dr Jones is suffering from a physical or mental illness to such an extent that his ability to practise as a medical practitioner is or is likely to be affected.

As a result of the above, the Board delivered the following Order-

1. Dr William Peter Jones' registration as a medical practitioner be suspended for a period of 12 months, effective immediately;

- 2. Within 3 months, Dr Jones is to submit himself to an examination by a consultant psychiatrist and a consultant physician appointed by the Board;
- 3. After receiving the above medical reports, the matter will be adjourned for a period of 10 months for the Board's consideration, at which time a decision will be made whether Dr Jones' supervision should be revoked or extended, or be struck off the Register of Medical Practitioners; and
- 4. Dr Jones to pay the Board's costs of the Inquiry.
