I, the Deputy of the Governor, acting under section 10 (2) (a) of the *Shipping and Pilotage Act 1967* and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby declare the place described in the Schedule to this Proclamation to be a mooring control area for the purposes of that Act.

SCHEDULE

Port of Broome Mooring Control Area

All that portion of the territorial waters below the high tide mark, within the boundary and coloured blue on Transport Plan 302-06-01A and comprising an area of about 20669 hectares.

SHIPPING AND PILOTAGE (MOORING CONTROL AREA) REGULATIONS 1983

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION OF FEES

Pursuant to the *Shipping and Pilotage (Mooring Control Area) Regulations*, the Department of Transport hereby gives notice that, in respect of the mooring control area in the Port of Broome, it has been determined that as of 1 July 1999 until further notice, the fee payable for hiring a swing mooring control site shall be the amount calculated in accordance with the schedule.
