Mining Act 1978

Mining Amendment Regulations (No. 5) 2000

Made by the Administrator in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations may be cited as the *Mining Amendment Regulations (No. 5) 2000*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation on 1 July 2000.

3. Regulation 86 amended

The Table to regulation 86 of the *Mining Regulations 1981** is amended as follows:

- (a) after the item relating to silver —
 - (i) in the column headed “Mineral”, by inserting —
 - “ Spongolite ”; and
 - (ii) in column 2, by inserting —
 - “ 5% ”;
- (b) by deleting the items relating to the minerals listed in the Table to this paragraph;
