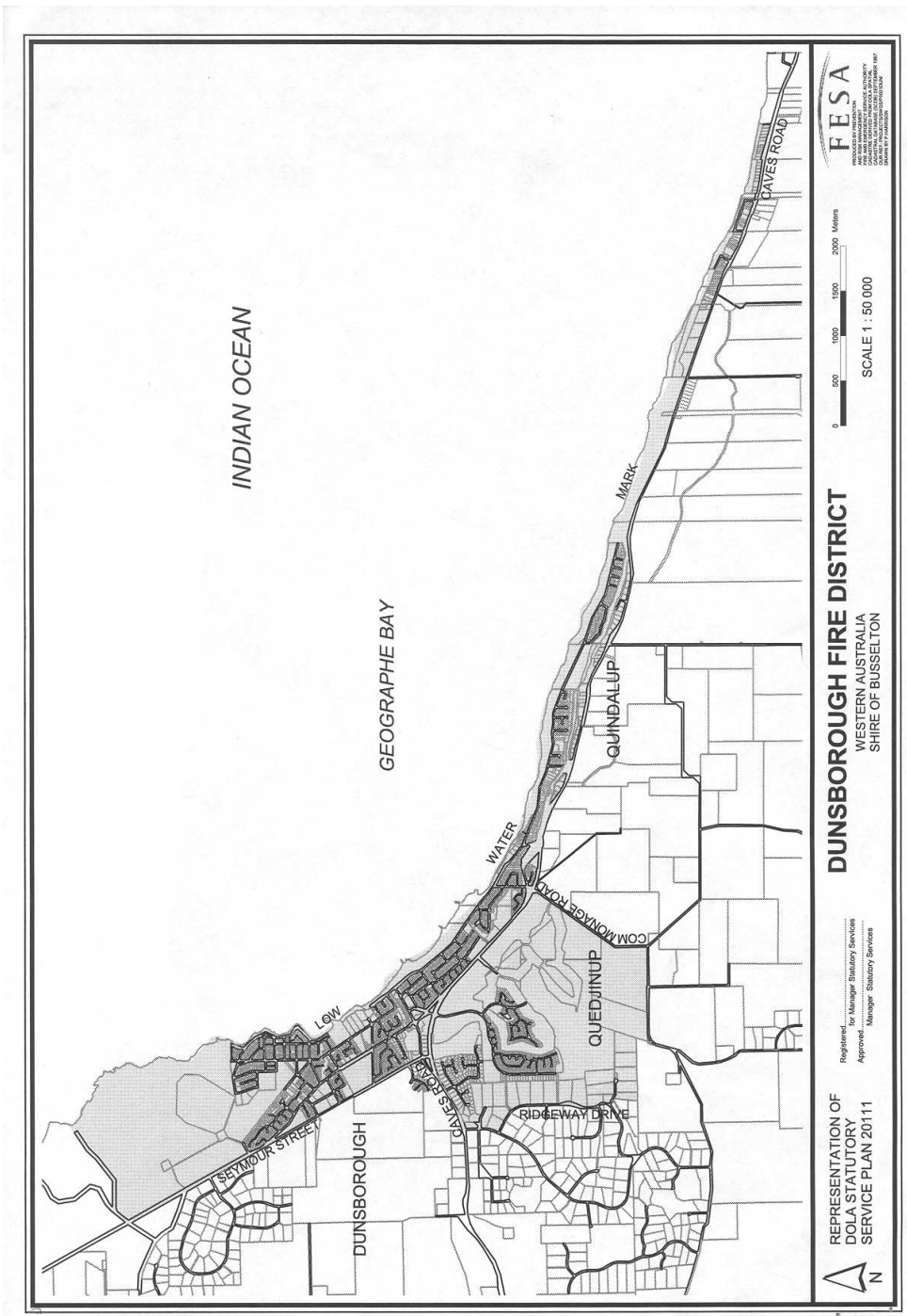

Memorandum of Imposing Rates

At a meeting of the Narembeen Shire Council held on Wednesday, 19th July 2000, it was resolved that rates and charges specified hereunder be imposed on all rateable property within the Municipality in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Act 1995 and Health Act 1911.

Schedule of Rates and Charges

General Rate—

- Rural Area—2.2100 cents in the dollar on Unimproved Values.
- Residential/GRV—9.1700 cents in the dollar on Gross Rental Values.
- Mining Tenements—2.2100 cents in the dollar on Unimproved Values.

Minimum Rate—

- Rural Area/Unimproved Values—\$150.00 per lot.
- Residential/GRV—\$50.00 per lot.
- Mining Tenements/Unimproved Values—\$150.00 per lot.

Discount—A Discount of four per cent (4%) is allowed on all current rates paid in full by the 15th September 2000.

Rubbish Charges—One hundred and twenty dollars (\$120.00) per annum per 240 litre bin.

Pensioner Concessions—

Eligible pensioners are entitled to a fifty per cent (50%) rate rebate provided by the State Government.

A ten per cent (10%) discount on the rubbish charge is offered by Council to all eligible pensioners.

Instalment Plan Interest Rates—A charge of 5.5% per annum, calculated daily by simple interest.

Late Payment Interest Rate—A charge of 11% per annum, calculated daily by simple interest.

MEMORANDUM OF IMPOSING RATES

To Whom It May Concern

At the Special Meeting of the Bunbury Water Board held on 28 June 2000, it was resolved that the Rates and Charges specified hereunder should be imposed on all rateable properties within the District of the Bunbury Water Board in accordance with the Water Boards Act 1904 for the financial year 1 July 2000 to 30 June 2001.

Rates/Consumption Schedule of Charges—

- (a) An annual Supply Fee of \$80.00 will apply to all residential properties.
- (b) 3.05 cents in the dollar to be levied on the GRV of all commercial category properties.
- (c) 2.40 cents in the dollar to be levied on the GRV of all industrial category properties.
- (d) 3.20 cents in the dollar to be levied on the GRV of all rural category properties.
- (e) 3.00 cents in the dollar to be levied on the GRV of all public facility category properties.
- (f) 5.20 cents in the dollar levied on the GRV of all residential category vacant land.
- (g) The charge for non rateable properties under Section 57 of the Water Boards Act to be \$300.00 per annum.
- (h) The charge (per kl) for water consumed at residential zoned properties to be—
 - First 150 kl \$0.35
 - Next 200 kl \$0.62
 - Next 150 kl \$0.90
 - Next 200 kl \$1.17
 - Next 300 kl \$1.38
 - Over 1,000 kl \$2.00
- (i) Registered pensioners to receive 50% rebate of the total amount of water rates payable and 50% rebate of the amount payable for water consumption up to 350 kl.
- (j) Registered seniors to receive 25% rates rebate and 50% rebate of the amount payable for water consumption up to 150 kl.
