FISH RESOURCES MANAGEMENT ACT 1994
PROHIBITION ON FISHING (COCKBURN SOUND) ORDER 2000
Order No. 9 of 2000

Made by the Minister under section 43.

Citation

1. This order may be cited as the *Prohibition on Fishing (Cockburn Sound) Order 2000*.

Interpretation

2. In this order—

“the waters of Cockburn Sound” means the waters of Cockburn Sound east of the causeway extending from the mainland to Garden Island, then east of the line extending from the north western point of Garden Island to the south-eastern point of Carnac Island and from that point, all waters south of a line extending to the western point of Woodman Point.

Prohibition on fishing

3. A person must not fish for pink snapper in the waters of Cockburn Sound during the period commencing on 15 September and ending on 31 October in any year.
