is invited to submit to the Electoral Commissioner within one month after the day of publication of this notice, a statement which—

- (a) sets out in detail the grounds for the elector's belief in respect to (i) and (ii) above;
- (b) sets out the electors' residential address and postal address; and
- (c) is signed by the elector.

Any statement submitted will be available for public inspection without fee at the Office of the Electoral Commissioner, Level 2, AXA Centre, 111 St George's Terrace, Perth 6000.
