SCHOOL EDUCATION ACT 1999**DECLARATION OF LOCAL-INTAKE AREAS FOR SCHOOLS WITH PRIMARY STUDENTS**

(Pursuant to Sections 60, 78, 79 and 80)

The Hon. Minister for Education has declared that the local-intake areas for the schools listed hereunder shall be as stated in this notice. Children of compulsory school age who reside within the local-intake areas stated shall be entitled to attend the schools to which such local-intake areas apply if there is an appropriate educational program for them at that school. Children who reside outside these local-intake areas may apply to attend the schools to which such local-intake areas apply.

APPLECROSS PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the Canning Bridge, north along the foreshore of the Canning River and continuing west and south west along the foreshore of the Swan River to a point due north of the junction of Canning Highway and Chesson Street, south through Tompkins Park to the junction of Canning Highway and Chesson Street and north east along Canning Highway to the Canning Bridge. The boundary part of Canning Highway (north side) is included within this area.

ATTADALE PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Canning Highway and Stock Road, east along Canning Highway to Chesson Street, north from the junction of Canning Highway and Chesson Street to the foreshore of the Swan River, generally north west along the Swan River foreshore to the northern extension of Stock Road, and south along this extension and Stock Road to Canning Highway. The boundary part Canning Highway is included within this area. Students resident in the boundary part of Stock Road (both sides) are entitled to attend either Attadale Primary School or Bicton Primary School.

BALDIVIS PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines a local-intake area for Baldivis Primary School—

From the junction of Mandurah Road and Stakehill Road, north along Mandurah Road to Millar Road, east, north east and south east along Millar Road and the locality boundary of Baldivis to the bridge over the drain near the junction of Mundijong Road and Duckpond Road, south along the drain to a point due north of the junction of Karnup Road and Yangetti Road, south along Yangetti Road to Henderson Road, west along Henderson Road and its westward extension to the Serpentine River.

The boundary parts of Yangetti Road (both sides), Henderson Road (both sides) and Mandurah Road (east side) are included within the area for Baldivis Primary School.

The following is an optional area for Baldivis, Marri Grove and Mundijong Primary Schools—

From the junction of Duckpond Road and Mundijong Road, west along Mundijong Road to the locality boundary between Baldivis and Oldbury, north west along this locality boundary and continuing east and north east along the locality boundary between Oldbury and Wellard to the railway line, east along the railway line to a drain, south south east along the drain to the Birraga Main Drain, south and south west along the main drain to Mundijong Road and west along Mundijong Road to Duckpond Road. The boundary parts of Mundijong Road (north side) are included in this optional area.

BEACONSFIELD PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Hampton Road and South Street, south along Hampton Road to Douro Road, west along Douro Road to the coastline, south along the coastline to the western extension of Rollinson Road, east along this extension and Rollinson Road to Cockburn Road, north along Cockburn Road to Hampton Road, north along Hampton Road to Clontarf Road, east along Clontarf Road to Mather Road, north along Mather Road to Lefroy Road, west along Lefroy Road to Badham Close, north along the north-south section of Badham Close and its northern extension to the junction of Grosvenor Street and Field Street, north along Field Street to South Street and west along South Street to Hampton Road. The boundary parts of Hampton Road (northern section, east side), Douro Road (south side), Rollinson Road (both sides), Cockburn Road (west side), Hampton Road (southern section, west side), Clontarf Road (north side), Lefroy Road (south side), Badham Close (west side), Field Street (west side) and South Street (south side) are included within this local-intake area. The boundary street of Mather Road (both sides) is excluded from this local-intake area.

The following is an optional area between Beaconsfield and Winterfold Primary Schools—

From the junction of South Street and Fifth Avenue, south along Fifth Avenue to Lefroy Road, west along Lefroy Road to Badham Close, north along the north-south section of Badham Close and its northern extension to the junction of Grosvenor Street and Field Street, north along Field Street to South Street and east along South Street to Fifth Avenue. The boundary parts of Fifth Avenue (west side), Lefroy Road (north side), Badham Close (east side), Field Street (east side) and South Street (south side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

The following is an optional area between Beaconsfield and Winterfold Primary Schools—

From the junction of Hampton Road and Clontarf Road, south along Hampton Road to Rockingham Road, south west along Rockingham Road to Healy Road, east along Healy Road to a point west of the north west extremity of Gordon Road, north from this point to Clontarf Road and west along Clontarf Road to Hampton Road. The boundary parts of Hampton Road (west side), Rockingham Road (north side), Healy Road (north side) and Clontarf Road (south side) are included within this local-intake area. The boundary part of Gordon Road (both sides) is excluded from this local-intake area.

The following is an optional area between Beaconsfield and Fremantle Primary Schools—

From the intersection of Hampton Road and South Street, south along Hampton Road to Douro Road, west along Douro Road to Marine Terrace, north along Marine Terrace to South Street and east along South Terrace to Hampton Road. The boundary parts of Hampton Road (west side), Douro Road (north side), Marine Terrace (both sides) and South Street (south side) are included within this local-intake area.

BELMONT PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Epsom Avenue and Mathieson Road, south east along Epsom Avenue to Belvidere Street, south west along Belvidere Street to Hardey Road, south east along Hardey Road to Esther Street, south west along Esther Street to Abernethy Road, north west along Abernethy Road to the Swan River foreshore, north and north east along the Swan River foreshore to the Garratt Road Bridge, south east along Grandstand Road to a point due west of the junction of Mathieson Road and Carbine Street, east from this point to the aforesaid junction, north east from this junction along Mathieson Road to the intersection with Epsom Avenue.

The boundary parts of Belvidere Street (north side), Hardey Road (both sides), Esther Street (north side), Abernethy Road (north side), Grandstand Road (both sides) and Mathieson Road (both sides) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Epsom Avenue (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area of this school.

BRENTWOOD PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Leach Highway and Riseley Street, north along Riseley Street to Karoonda Road, east along Karoonda Road to Canning Avenue, north east along Canning Avenue to the foreshore of the Canning River, south along the Canning River and Bull Creek foreshores to and through Bateman Park to the junction of Leach Highway and Bull Creek Drive, west along Leach Highway to Riseley Street. The boundary parts of Riseley Street (east side) and Leach Highway (north side) are included within this area. The boundary parts of Karoonda Road (both sides) and Canning Avenue (both sides) are excluded from this area.

The following is an optional area between Brentwood and Mount Pleasant Primary Schools—

From the junction of Riseley Street and Coomoora Road, east along Coomoora Road to Reynolds Road, south along Reynolds Road to Crest Avenue, east along Crest Avenue and its extension to the foreshore of the Canning River, south along the Canning River foreshore to the eastward extension of Canning Avenue, west along this extension and south west along Canning Avenue to Karoonda Road, west along Karoonda Road to Riseley Street and north along Riseley Street to Coomoora Road. The boundary parts of Canning Avenue (both sides), Karoonda Road (both sides) and Riseley Street (east side) are included within the optional area. The boundary parts of Coomoora Road (both sides), Reynolds Road (both sides) and Crest Avenue (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

CANNING VALE PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Nicholson Road and Ranford Road, north west along Ranford Road to Bannister Road, north east and east along Bannister Road to Nicholson Road, generally south and south west along Nicholson Road to Hughes Street, generally south east along Hughes Street to Fraser Road North, south west along Fraser Road North to Shreeve Road, south east along Shreeve Road to Warton Road, south west along Warton Road to Amherst Road, north west along Amherst Road to Campbell Road, south west along Campbell Road to Birnam Road, north west along Birnam Road to Fraser Road North, south west along Fraser Road North and its extension to the intersection of Nicholson Road and Ranford Road.

The boundary parts of Ranford Road (north east side), Bannister Road (south side), Nicholson Road (west side), Hughes Street (west side), Fraser Road North (north east section, west side), Shreeve Road (west side), Warton Road (north side), Amherst Street (east side), Campbell Road (north side), Birnam Road (north side) and Fraser Road North (south west section, north side) are included within the local-intake area of Canning Vale Primary School.

CASTLETOWN PRIMARY

The following defines the local-intake area for this school—

From the most easterly point on the shore of Lake Warden, east to Norseman Road, south along Norseman Road to Harbour Road, south west and south along Harbour Road to the railway line, south east and east along the railway and its extension to the tanker jetty, and north and north east along the coastline from the jetty to Bandy Creek Harbour.

The boundary parts of the Norseman Road (east side) and Harbour Road (east side) are included within this local-intake area.

The following defines an optional area between Castletown Primary School and Esperance Primary School—

From a point on shore of Lake Warden at the northern extension of Warden Road, east and north east along the shoreline of Lake Warden to the most easterly point of Lake Warden, east from this point to Norseman Road, south along Norseman Road to Harbour Road, south west and south along Harbour Road to Monjingup Road, west along Monjingup Road to Warden Road, north along Warden Road and its northern extension to Lake Warden.

The boundary parts of Norseman Road (west side), Harbour Road (north west and west side) and Warden Road (both sides) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Monjingup Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The boundary for Castletown Primary School includes the following school bus routes: Merivale, Myrup, Neridup, Cape Le Grand, Jendabillup, Scaddan and Dempster. Approval to travel as a complimentary passenger on any of these buses does not entitle a child to attend Castletown Primary School.

CHIDLOW PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area for Chidlow Primary School—

From the junction of Sime Road and Elliott Road, south along Sime Road to Great Eastern Highway, east and north along Great Eastern Highway to Doconing Road, west and north along Doconing Road to Old Northam Road.

The boundary parts of Sime Road (both sides), Great Eastern Highway (both sides) and Doconing Road (both sides) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

The local-intake area for Chidlow Primary School includes the following bus routes—Mayo Road, Ash Road/El Caballo and Rolling Green/Lilydale. Approval to travel as a complimentary passenger on any of these buses does not entitle a child to attend Chidlow Primary School.

CLOVERDALE PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Hardey Road and Esther Street, south west along Esther Street to Belmont Avenue, south east along Belmont Avenue to Fulham Street, north east along Fulham Street to Abernethy Road, south east along Abernethy Road to Leach Highway, north east along Leach Highway to Tonkin Highway, north along Tonkin Highway to the easterly extension of Middleton Street, north west to and along Middleton Street to McGlenn Way, south west along McGlenn Way to Hardey Road, north west along Hardey Road to Esther Street.

The boundary parts of Esther Street (south east side), Belmont Avenue (both sides), Fulham Street (both sides), Abernethy Road (north east side), Leach Highway (north west side), Tonkin Highway (west side), Middleton Street (south west side), McGlenn Way (both sides) and Hardey Road (south west side) are included within this local-intake area.

COLLIER PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Canning Highway and South Terrace, east along South Terrace to Hayman Road, south along Hayman Road to Thelma Street, west along Thelma Street to Canning Highway and north east along Canning Highway to South Terrace.

The boundary parts of South Terrace (south side), Hayman Road (west side), Thelma Street (both sides) and Canning Highway (east side) are included within this local-intake area.

The following is an optional area between Collier, Kensington and South Perth Primary Schools—

From the intersection of Canning Highway and Douglas Avenue, south east along Douglas Avenue to South Terrace, west along South Terrace to Canning Highway, north east along Canning Highway to Douglas Avenue.

The boundary parts of Douglas Avenue (south west side), South Terrace (north side) and Canning Highway (south east side) are included within this optional area.

The following is an optional area between Collier and Koonawarra Primary schools—

From the intersection of Canning Highway and Thelma Street, east along Thelma Street to Morrison Street, south along Morrison Street to Baldwin Street, west along Baldwin Street to Saunders Street, west along Saunders Street to Canning Highway and north east along Canning Highway to Thelma Street.

The boundary parts of Morrison Street (both sides), Baldwin Street (north side), Saunders Street (north side) and Canning Highway (east side) are included within this optional area. Thelma Street (both sides) is excluded from this optional area.

COMO PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Canning Highway and South Terrace, south west along Canning Highway to the Kwinana Freeway, north along the Kwinana Freeway to South Terrace and east along South Terrace to Canning Highway.

The boundary parts of Canning Highway (west side), Kwinana Freeway (both sides) and South Terrace (south side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

COOLAMON PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area for this school—

From the junction of Gnangara Road and Pinaster Parade, north and north east along Pinaster Parade to The Promenade, east along The Promenade to the most eastern point on the proposed section of this road, north from this point to the proposed Perth Darwin Highway, south and south west along the proposed Perth Darwin Highway to Gnangara Road and east along Gnangara Road to Pinaster Parade. The boundary parts of Pinaster Parade (north west side), The Promenade (north side) and Gnangara Road (north side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

EAST MADDINGTON PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From a point on Tonkin Highway and the north east extension of Lancaster Place, south west from this point to and along Lancaster Place to Dellar Road, north west along Dellar Road to a point on the north east extension of the western arm of Rangeview Court, south west from this point to and along Rangeview Court to Alcock Street, north west along Alcock Street to Revesby Street, south west along Revesby Street to Westfield Street, south along Westfield Street to Helm Street, south west along Helm Street to Albany Highway, south east along Albany Highway to Gosnells Road, east along Gosnells Road to Mills Road West, south east along Mills Road West to Ellis Brook, in a generally north easterly direction along Ellis Brook to Tonkin Highway and north along Tonkin Highway to the north east extension of Lancaster Place.

The boundary parts of Dellar Road (both sides), Rangeview Court (both sides), Westfield Street (both sides), Albany Highway (both sides), Gosnells Road (both sides), Mills Road West (both sides), Tonkin Highway (west side) and the boundary streets of Revesby Street (both sides) and Helm Street (both sides) are included within the area for East Maddington Primary School, while the boundary parts of Alcock Street (both sides) and Rushton Road (both sides) are excluded from the area for East Maddington Primary School.

The following is an optional area for East Maddington and Gosnells Primary Schools—

From the eastern extremity of Rushton Road, west and north west along Rushton Road to Ellis Brook, in a generally westerly direction along Ellis Brook to Mills Road West, north west along Mills Road West to Gosnells Road, west along Gosnells Road to Albany Highway, south along Albany Highway to Fremantle Road, west along Fremantle Road to the railway line, south east and south along the railway line to a point due west of the junction of Albany Highway and Tonkin Highway, east from this point to Tonkin Highway, north east along Tonkin to Mills Road East, east along Mills Road East to Pages Way and due east from this point.

The boundary parts of Rushton Road (both sides), Albany Highway (both sides), Fremantle Road (both sides) and Tonkin Highway (west side) are included within the optional area, while the boundary parts of Mills Road West (both sides), Gosnells Road (both sides) and Mills Road East (both sides) are excluded from the optional area.

EAST VICTORIA PARK PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Albany Highway and Miller Street, north east along Miller Street to the railway line, south east along the railway line to Welshpool Road, west along Welshpool Road to Albany Highway and north west along Albany Highway to Miller Street.

The boundary parts of Miller Street (south east side), Welshpool Road (north side) and Albany Highway (east side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

ELLENBROOK PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area for this school—

From the junction of Gnangara Road and Pinaster Parade, north and north east along Pinaster Parade to The Promenade, east along The Promenade to the proposed Henley Brook Avenue, south along the proposed Henley Brook Avenue to Gnangara Road and west along Gnangara Road to Pinaster Parade.

The boundary parts of Pinaster Parade (east side), The Promenade (south side), the proposed Henley Brook Avenue (west side) and Gnangara Road (north side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

The following is an optional area between Ellenbrook Primary School, Caversham Primary School and Upper Swan Primary School—

The locality of Henley Brook west of the Swan River as delineated in the 2000 Perth StreetSmart Directory.

ESPERANCE PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Collier Road and South Coast Highway, south east and east along Collier Road to the railway line, south east and south along the railway line to the junction (where one track goes south to the port, and the other goes east to the tanker jetty), south from this junction along the railway line to a point north east from the junction of Johns Street and Wollamai Place, south west from this point on the railway line to the junction of Johns Street and Woollamai Place, south along Johns Street to Twilight Beach Road, and continuing south to the coastline, east and north along the coastline to the tanker jetty, west from the jetty to where the railway

line intersects Harbour Road, north along Harbour road to Monjingup Road, west along Monjingup Road to Warden Road, north along Warden Road and its northern extension to the shore line of Lake Warden, west and north west to a point on the shore due east of the intersection of Stearnes Road and the railway line, west from this point along Stearnes Road to the railway line, south along the railway line to South Coast Highway and west along South Coast Highway to the intersection with Collier Road.

The boundary parts of Harbour Road (west side), Monjingup Road (both sides) and Stearnes Road (both sides) are included within the local-intake area of Esperance Primary School. The boundary parts of Harbour Road (east side), and Warden Road (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake of Esperance Primary School. The boundary parts of Johns Street from Woollamai Place to Twilight Beach Road (both sides) are optional between Esperance Primary School and Nulsen Primary School.

The following defines an optional area between Castletown Primary School and Esperance Primary School—

From a point on shore of Lake Warden at the northern extension of Warden Road, east and north east along the shoreline of Lake Warden to the most easterly point of Lake Warden, east from this point to Norseman Road, south along Norseman Road to Harbour Road, south west and south along Harbour Road to Monjingup Road, west along Monjingup Road to Warden Road, north along Warden Road and its northern extension to Lake Warden.

The boundary parts of Norseman Road (west side), Harbour Road (north west and west side) and Warden Road (both sides) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Monjingup Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The boundary for Esperance Primary School includes the following school bus routes: Caitup, Gibson, Dalyup, Lort and Helms. Approval to travel as a complimentary passenger on any of these buses does not entitle a child to attend Esperance Primary School.

FALCON PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the entry of the Dawesville Channel into the Indian Ocean, north along the ocean shoreline to the locality boundary between Falcon and Halls Head, east along this locality boundary to the locality boundary between Erskine and Falcon, east and south along this locality boundary to the Peel Inlet, generally south and south west along the western shoreline of the Peel Inlet to the Dawesville Channel and north west along the Dawesville Channel to the Indian Ocean.

FOREST CRESCENT PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Warton Road and Forest Lakes Drive, north west along Forest Lakes Drive to Murdoch Road, north west along Murdoch Road to Yale Road, south west along Yale Road and continuing south west along Nicholson Road to Hughes Street, south east along Hughes Street to Fraser Road North, south west along Fraser Road North to Shreeve Road, south east along Shreeve Road to Warton Road and north east along Warton Road to Forest Lakes Drive.

The boundary parts of Forest Lakes Drive (both sides), Murdoch Road (south side), Yale Road (both sides), Nicholson Road (south side), Hughes Street (east side), Fraser Road North (south side), Shreeve Road (east side) and Warton Road (north side) are included within the local-intake area of Forest Crescent Primary School.

The following is an optional area between Forest Crescent and Huntingdale Primary Schools:—

From the junction of Ranford Road and Southern River Road, north east along Southern River Road to Gay Street, north west along Gay Street and its extension to Warton Road, south west along Warton Road to the junction of the north west extension of Barrett Street, south east along this extension and Barrett Street to Balfour Street, south west along the proposed Balfour Street to Ranford Road and south east along Ranford Road to Southern River Road.

The boundary parts of Southern River Road (both sides), Gay Street (both sides) and Warton Road (south east side), Barrett Street (north east side) and proposed Balfour Street (south east side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Ranford Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

GLEN FORREST PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area for Glen Forrest Primary School—

From the junction of Great Eastern Highway and Brooking Road, south along Brooking Road to Strettle Road, east along Strettle Road and its eastward extension to Phillips Road, east along Phillips Road to the locality boundary between Mahogany Creek and Mundaring, south, east and south west along this locality boundary to the Helena River, generally west along the Helena River to the locality boundary between Darlington and Glen Forrest, north along this locality boundary to Nelson Road, north along Nelson Road to the junction with Ryecroft Road, north west to the junction of Dalry Street and Newman Road, north along Newman Road and its northern extension to Great Eastern Highway, east along Great Eastern Highway to Brooking Road. The boundary part of Great Eastern Highway (south side) is included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Brooking Road (both sides), Strettle Road (both sides), Phillips Road (both sides), Nelson Road (both sides) and Newman Road (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area of this school.

The following is an optional area for Glen Forrest and Parkerville Primary Schools—

From the junction of Great Eastern Highway and Brooking Road, north along Brooking Road to Hedges Road, west along Hedges Road to Oxley Road, west along Oxley Road to Park Road, south along Park Road to Great Eastern Highway and east along Great Eastern Highway to Brooking Road. The boundary parts of Brooking Road (both sides), Hedges Road (both sides), Oxley Road (both sides), Park Road (both sides) and Great Eastern Highway (north side) are included within this optional area.

The following is an optional area for Glen Forrest, Mundaring and Parkerville Primary Schools—

From the junction of Great Eastern Highway and Craven Road, south along Craven Road to Jacoby Street, east along Jacoby Street to Coppin Road, south along Coppin Road to Phillips Road, west along Phillips Road and its westward extension to the junction of Homestead Road and Strettle Road, west along Strettle Road to Brooking Road, north along Brooking Road to Great Eastern Highway and east along Great Eastern Highway to Craven Road. The boundary parts of Craven Road (both sides), Jacoby Street (both sides), Phillips Road (both sides), Strettle Road (both sides), Brooking Road (both sides) and Great Eastern Highway (south side) are included within this optional area. The boundary part of Coppin Road (both sides) is excluded from this local-intake area.

HUNTINGDALE PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Warton Road and Gay Street, north east along Warton Road to Corfield Street, south east along Corfield Street to the Southern River, generally south along the Southern River to Southern River Road, south west along Southern River Road to Gay Street and north west along Gay Street to Warton Road.

The boundary parts of Warton Road (south east side) and Corfield Street (south side), Southern River Road (north east side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary street, Gay Street (both sides), is excluded from this area.

The following is an optional area between Huntingdale and Ranford Primary Schools—

From the junction of Warton Road and Barrett Street, south east along the proposed and existing sections of Barrett Street to Balfour Street, south west along the proposed Balfour Street to Ranford Road, north west along Ranford Road to Warton Road and north east along Warton Road to Barrett Street.

The boundary parts of the proposed and existing sections of Barrett (south west side), the proposed Balfour Street (north west side) and Warton Road (south east side) are included within this optional area. The boundary part of Ranford Road (both sides) is excluded from this optional area.

The following is an optional area between Forest Crescent and Huntingdale Primary Schools—

From the junction of Ranford Road and Southern River Road, north east along Southern River Road to Gay Street, north west along Gay Street and its extension to Warton Road, south west along Warton Road to the junction of the north west extension of Barrett Street, south east along this extension and Barrett Street to Balfour Street, south west along the proposed Balfour Street to Ranford Road and south east along Ranford Road to Southern River Road.

The boundary parts of Southern River Road (both sides), Gay Street (both sides) and Warton Road (south east side), Barrett Street (north east side) and proposed Balfour Street (south east side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Ranford Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

KENSINGTON PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Canning Highway and Berwick Street, south east along Berwick Street to Rathay Street, south west along Rathay Street to Anketell Street, north west along Anketell Street to George Street, south west along George Street to Douglas Avenue, north west along Douglas Avenue and its north westerly extension to the Swan River foreshore, east along the foreshore to a point on the north westerly extension of Ellam Street, south east from the foreshore along the extension of Ellam Street, and south east along Ellam Street to Mill Point Road, north east on the extension of Mill Point Road to the junction of Canning Highway and Berwick Street.

The boundary parts of Berwick (south west side), Rathay Street (north west side), Anketell Street (north east side), George Street (north west side), Douglas Avenue (north east side) and Ellam Street (both sides) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

The following is an optional area between Collier, Kensington and South Perth Primary Schools—

From the intersection of Canning Highway and Douglas Avenue, south east along Douglas Avenue to South Terrace, west along South Terrace to Canning Highway, north east along Canning Highway to Douglas Avenue.

The boundary parts of Douglas Avenue (south west side), South Terrace (north side) and Canning Highway (south east side) are included within this optional area.

KEWDALE PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Leach Highway and Abernethy Road, south west along Leach Highway to Orrong Road, north west along Orrong Road to Fulham Street, north east along Fulham Street to Abernethy Road, and south east along Abernethy Road to Leach Highway.

The boundary parts of Leach Highway (north west side), Orrong Road (north east side), Fulham Street (south east side) and Abernethy Road (south west side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

MADDINGTON PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Albany Highway and Helm Street, north east along Helm Street to Weston Street, north west along Weston Street to Kelvin Road, north east along Kelvin Road to Davidson Street, north west along Davidson Street to Caruso Court, south west along Caruso Court to Austin Avenue, south west along Austin Avenue and its south westerly extension to Aldinga Street, and continuing south west along Aldinga Street and south west to the Canning River, generally south east and east along the Canning River to the railway line, south west along the railway line to a point due west of the junction of Albany Highway and Gosnells Road West, east to the aforesaid junction and north east along Albany Highway to Helm Street.

The boundary parts of Helm Street (both sides), Weston Street (both sides), Kelvin Street (both sides), Davidson Street (both sides), Caruso Court (both sides), Austin Avenue (both sides), Aldinga Street (both sides) and Albany Highway (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area for this school.

The following is an optional area between East Kenwick, Beckenham, Maddington and Thornlie Primary Schools—

From the intersection of Austin Avenue and the Perth- Armadale railway line, south west along Austin Avenue and its south westerly extension to Aldinga Street, and continuing south west along Aldinga Street and south west to the Canning River, generally north west along the Canning River to the Kwinana railway line, north east along the Kwinana railway line to the Perth-Armadale railway line and south east along the Perth-Armadale railway line to the railway crossing at Austin Avenue.

The boundary parts of Austin Avenue (both sides) and Aldinga Street (both sides) are included within this optional area.

MELVILLE PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Canning Highway and Stock Road, east along Canning Highway to North Lake Road, south along North Lake Road to Leach Highway, west along Leach Highway to Stock Road and north along Stock Road to Canning Highway.

The boundary parts of Canning Highway (south side), North Lake Road (west side), Leach Highway (north side) and Stock Road (east side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

MUNDARING PRIMARY SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the areas covered by the Post Codes for Mundaring (6073) and Stoneville (6081) as shown in the Perth 2001 StreetSmart Street Directory. The following streets are excluded from this local-intake area—Short Street (both sides), Jacoby Street (west of Coppin Road) and Phillips Road (west of Coppin Road).

The following is an optional area for Glen Forrest, Mundaring and Parkerville Primary Schools—

From the junction of Great Eastern Highway and Craven Road, south along Craven Road to Jacoby Street, east along Jacoby Street to Coppin Road, south along Coppin Road to Phillips Road, west along Phillips Road and its westward extension to the junction of Homestead Road and Strettle Road, west along Strettle Road to Brooking Road, north along Brooking Road to Great Eastern Highway and east along Great Eastern Highway to Craven Road. The boundary parts of Craven Road (both sides), Jacoby Street (both sides), Phillips Road (both sides), Strettle Road (both sides), Brooking Road (both sides) and Great Eastern Highway (south side) are included within this optional area. The boundary part of Coppin Road (both sides) is excluded from this local-intake area.

NEDLANDS PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the Nedlands Yacht Club, north west to the junction of The Avenue and Bruce Street, north along Bruce Street to Melvista Avenue, west along Melvista Avenue to Vincent Street, north along Vincent Street to Stirling Highway, east along Stirling Highway to Hampden Road, north along Hampden Road to Park Road, east along Park Road and its east north easterly extension to Park Avenue, east north east along Park Avenue to Forrest Drive, south east along Forrest Drive and its south easterly extension to the Swan River.

The boundary parts of Bruce Street (east side), Melvista Avenue (north side), Vincent Street (east side), Stirling Highway (south side), Hampden Road (east side), Park Road (south side), Park Avenue (south side) and Forrest Drive (both sides) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

NORTH FREMANTLE PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the Stirling Bridge, north along the Swan River western foreshore to the local government boundary between the City of Fremantle and the Town of Mosman Park, north and west along

this local government boundary to the coastline of the Indian Ocean, south along the coastline to North Mole, east and north east along the north wharf of Fremantle Harbour and the northern foreshore of the Swan River to the Stirling Bridge.

NORTHAM PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area for Northam Primary School—

From the junction of Gairdner Street and Throssell Street, north west along Gairdner Street to the Avon River, generally north and west along the Avon River to a point adjacent to the cemetery.

The boundary part of Gairdner Street (both sides) is excluded from this local-intake area.

The local-intake area for Northam Primary School includes the following bus routes—Grass Valley, Inkpen, Irishtown, Jennacubbine/Goomalling, Jennapullin, Meckering, Mokine, Southern Brook and Toodyay. Approval to travel as a complimentary passenger on any of these buses does not entitle a child to attend Northam Primary School.

NULSEN PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Pink Lake Drive and Collier Road, south east and east along Collier Road to the railway line, south east and south along the railway line to the junction (where one track goes south to the port, and the other goes east to the tanker jetty), south from this junction along the railway line to a point north east from the junction of Johns Street and Woollamai Place, south west from this point on the railway line to the junction of Johns Street and Woollamai Place, south along Johns Street to Twilight Beach Road, and continuing south to the coastline, west along the coast to the south east extension of Riche Road, north west along this extension and Riche Road to the junction with Stewart Street, north west from this junction through the golf course to Nicholson Drive, north along Nicholson Drive to Eleven Mile Beach Road, north along Eleven Mile Beach Road to Pink Lake Road, and continuing north along Pink Lake Drive to Collier Road.

The boundary parts of Collier Road (both sides), Eleven Mile Beach Road (both sides) and Pink Lake Drive (both sides) are included within the local-intake area for Nulsen Primary School. The boundary parts of Riche Road (both sides) and Nicholson Drive (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area for Nulsen Primary School. The boundary parts of Johns Street from Woollamai Place to Twilight Beach Road (both sides) are optional between Esperance Primary School and Nulsen Primary School.

PALMYRA PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Canning Highway and Petra Street, south along Petra Street to Marmion Street, west along Marmion Street to Coode Street, south along Coode Street to High Street, east along High Street to Carrington Street, south along Carrington Street to Sainsbury Road, east along Sainsbury Road to Stock Road, north along Stock Road to Canning Highway, south west along Canning Highway to Petra Street. The boundary parts of Petra Street (east side), Marmion Street (south side), Coode Street (east side), High Street (north side), Carrington Street (east side), Sainsbury Road (north side), Stock Road (west side), and Canning Highway (south side) are included within this area.

PARKERVILLE PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following is an optional area for Glen Forrest and Parkerville Primary Schools—

From the junction of Great Eastern Highway and Brooking Road, north along Brooking Road to Hedges Road, west along Hedges Road to Oxley Road, west along Oxley Road to Park Road, south along Park Road to Great Eastern Highway and east along Great Eastern Highway to Brooking Road. The boundary parts of Brooking Road (both sides), Hedges Road (both sides), Oxley Road (both sides), Park Road (both sides) and Great Eastern Highway (north side) are included within this optional area.

The following is an optional area for Glen Forrest, Mundaring and Parkerville Primary Schools—

From the junction of Great Eastern Highway and Craven Road, south along Craven Road to Jacoby Street, east along Jacoby Street to Coppin Road, south along Coppin Road to Phillips Road, west along Phillips Road and its westward extension to the junction of Homestead Road and Strettle Road, west along Strettle Road to Brooking Road, north along Brooking Road to Great Eastern Highway and east along Great Eastern Highway to Craven Road. The boundary parts of Craven Road (both sides), Jacoby Street (both sides), Phillips Road (both sides), Strettle Road (both sides), Brooking Road (both sides) and Great Eastern Highway (south side) are included within this optional area. The boundary part of Coppin Road (both sides) is excluded from this local-intake area.

QUINNS BEACH PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of the proposed Mitchell Freeway and the proposed Lukin Drive, south west along the proposed Lukin Drive to the proposed Marmion Avenue, south along the proposed Marmion Avenue to the existing Marmion Avenue, continuing south along Marmion Avenue to Santa Barbara Parade, generally west along Santa Barbara Parade to Morialta Avenue, south west along Morialta Avenue to Tapping Way, north west and west along Tapping Way to the junction with Ocean Drive, west from this junction to the coastline, north along the coastline to

the locality boundary between Alkimos and Jindalee, east along the locality boundary between Alkimos and Jindalee to the locality boundary between Alkimos and Butler, continuing east along the locality boundary between Alkimos and Butler and its extension to the proposed Mitchell Freeway and south along the proposed Mitchell Freeway to the proposed Lukin Drive.

The boundary parts of the proposed Lukin Drive (north side), proposed and existing Marmion Avenue (west side) and Tapping Way (north side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The following boundary parts are optional between Quinns Beach Primary School and Quinns Rocks Primary School—Santa Barbara Parade (both sides from Marmion Avenue to Morialta Avenue) and Morialta Avenue (both sides from Santa Barbara Parade to Tapping Way).

QUINNS ROCKS PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Marmion Avenue and Santa Barbara Parade, generally west along Santa Barbara Parade to Morialta Avenue, south west along Morialta Avenue to Tapping Way, north west and west along Tapping Way to the junction with Ocean Drive, west from this junction to the coastline, south along the coastline to a point on the south west extension of Quinns Road, north east along this extension, and north east along Quinns Road to Marmion Avenue and north along Marmion Avenue to Santa Barbara Parade.

The boundary parts of Tapping Way (south side), Quinns Road (both sides) and Marmion Avenue (west side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The following boundary parts are optional between Quinns Beach Primary School and Quinns Rocks Primary School—Santa Barbara Parade (both sides from Marmion Avenue to Morialta Avenue) and Morialta Avenue (both sides from Santa Barbara Parade to Tapping Way).

RANFORD PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Nicholson Road and Ranford Road, north east along the south west extension of Fraser Road North, and north east along Fraser Road North itself to Birnam Road, south east along Birnam Road to Campbell Road, north east along Campbell Road to Amherst Road, south east along Amherst Road to Warton Road, south west along Warton Road to Nicholson Road, north along Nicholson Road to Acourt Road, north west along Acourt Road to Fraser Road, south west along Fraser Road to a point where the south east extension of the north west/south east runway of Jandakot airport intersects with Fraser Road, north west along this extension to the runway and north east along the south west extension of Johnston Road, and Johnston Road itself to the junction with Acourt Road, and continuing north along Johnston Road to Leeming Road, west along Leeming Road to the proposed Roe Highway, north east along the proposed Roe Highway to South Street, south east along South Street and continuing south east along Ranford Road to the intersection with Nicholson Road.

The boundary parts of Fraser Road North (south east side), Birnam Road (south west side), Campbell Road (south east side), Amherst Road (south west side), Warton Road (north east side), Nicholson Road (both sides), Acourt Road (both sides), Fraser Road (west side), Johnston Road (both sides), Leeming Road (both sides), South Street (south side) and Ranford Road (south side) are included within the local-intake area of Ranford Primary School.

The following is an optional area for Ranford and Forrestdale Primary Schools—

From the intersection of Nicholson Road and Warton Road, north along Nicholson Road to Acourt Road, north west along Acourt Road to Fraser Road, south west along Fraser Road to Jandakot Road, south east along Jandakot Road to Warton Road and north east along Warton Road to Nicholson Road.

The boundary parts of Fraser Road (east side) and Jandakot Road (north side) are included within this optional area, while the boundary parts of Nicholson Road (both sides), Acourt Road (both sides) and Warton Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The following is an optional area between Huntingdale and Ranford Primary Schools—

From the junction of Warton Road and Barrett Street, south east along the proposed and existing sections of Barrett Street to Balfour Street, south west along the proposed Balfour Street to Ranford Road, north west along Ranford Road to Warton Road and north east along Warton Road to Barrett Street.

The boundary parts of the proposed and existing sections of Barrett (south west side), the proposed Balfour Street (north west side) and Warton Road (south east side) are included within this optional area. The boundary part of Ranford Road (both sides) is excluded from this optional area.

RIVERTON PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Leach Highway and High Road, east along High Road to Vahland Avenue, south along Vahland Avenue to a point opposite the junction of Sylvana Way and Twomey Place east from this point along the east-west alignment of Sylvana Way and its extension to Shawood Place, east along Shawood Place and its extension to Inglis Place, in a general easterly direction along Inglis Place to Rostrata Avenue, south along Rostrata Avenue to Mansard Road, in a generally easterly direction along Mansard Road and its extension to Julia Place, east along Julia Place and Barenco Place to Willeri Drive, north along Willeri Drive to High Road, east along High Road to Duff Road, north along Duff Road to the Canning River, west and north along the Canning River foreshore, to the Shelley Bridge, south west along Leach Highway to Vahland

Avenue, south east and south along Vahland Avenue to Corinthian Road East, west along Corinthian Road East to Leach Highway and south west along Leach Highway to High Road. The boundary parts of High Road (both western and eastern sections, north side), Vahland Avenue (both southern and northern sections, east side), Sylvania Way (both sides), Shawwood Place (both sides), Inglis Place), Rostrata Avenue (both sides), Mansard Road (both sides), Julia Place (both sides), Barenco Place (both sides), Willeri Drive (west side), Duff Road (both sides), Leach Highway (both north east and south west sections, south side) and Corinthian Road East (south side) are included within this area.

The following is an optional area between Riverton Primary School and Willetton Primary School—

From the junction of High Road and Vahland Avenue, south along Vahland Avenue to Querrin Avenue, west along the east-west alignment of Querrin Avenue and continuing in a westerly direction to and along Acanthus Road to Herald Avenue, north along Herald Avenue to High Road, and east along High Road to Vahland Avenue. The boundary parts of Vahland Avenue (west side), Querrin Avenue (north side), Acanthus Road (north side), High Road (south side) and Herald Avenue (both sides) are included within this optional area.

The following is an optional area between Riverton Primary School and Shelley Primary School—

From the intersection of Leach Highway and Vahland Avenue, south east and south along Vahland Avenue to Corinthian Road East, west along Corinthian Road East to Leach Highway, and north east along Leach Highway to Vahland Avenue. The boundary parts of Vahland Avenue (west side), Corinthian Road East (north side) and Leach Highway (south side) are included within this optional area.

SOUTH PERTH PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Canning Highway and Douglas Avenue, south west along Canning Highway to South Terrace, west along South Terrace to the Swan River foreshore, north, east and south east along the foreshore to a point on the north westerly extension of Douglas Avenue to the foreshore, south east along this extension and south east along Douglas Avenue to Canning Highway.

The boundary parts of Canning Highway (north west side), South Terrace (north side), and Douglas Avenue (south west side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

The following is an optional area between Collier, Kensington and South Perth Primary Schools—

From the intersection of Canning Highway and Douglas Avenue, south east along Douglas Avenue to South Terrace, west along South Terrace to Canning Highway, north east along Canning Highway to Douglas Avenue.

The boundary parts of Douglas Avenue (south west side), South Terrace (north side) and Canning Highway (south east side) are included within this optional area.

TAMBREY PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Balmoral Road and Tambrey Drive, north, east and south east along Balmoral Road to the drainage channel located west of Bathgate Road, generally south west along the drainage channel to Tambrey Drive, and west along Tambrey Drive to Balmoral Drive. The boundary parts of Balmoral Drive (east, south and south west sides) and Tambrey Drive (north side) are included within this local-intake area.

WANNEROO JUNIOR PRIMARY SCHOOL AND WANNEROO PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area for Wanneroo Junior Primary School and Wanneroo Primary School—

From the junction of Wanneroo Road and Flynn Drive, south east along Wanneroo Road to Joondalup Drive, west along Joondalup Drive to the boundary between the localities of Joondalup and Wanneroo, south along this locality boundary to the northern shore of Lake Joondalup, east and south along the northern and eastern shores of Lake Joondalup to Ocean Reef Road, east along Ocean Reef Road to Wanneroo Road, north along Wanneroo Road to Dundobar Road, in generally easterly direction along Dundobar Road to Griffiths Road, north along Griffiths Road and its northern extension to the western extension of the northern arm of Casuarina Way, east along this extension and Casuarina Way and its easterly extension to Franklin Road, south along Franklin Road to the junction with Rome Road, east from this junction to Hawkins Road. The boundary parts of Wanneroo Road (northern section, east side), Joondalup Drive (south side), Ocean Reef Road (north side) and Wanneroo Road (southern section, west side) are included within the above local-intake area. The boundary parts of Dundobar Road (both sides), Griffiths Road (both sides), Casuarina Way (both sides) and Franklin Road (both sides) are excluded from the above local-intake area.

The following defines an optional local-intake area for Landsdale Primary School and Wanneroo Junior Primary and Wanneroo Primary Schools: as delineated in the 2000 edition of the Perth StreetSmart Street Directory, the localities of Darch, Madeley, Gnangara, Wangara, and the portion of the locality of Landsdale bounded by Gnangara Road, Madeley Street, Furniss Road and Cowle Street. The boundary part of Madeley Street (both sides), and the boundary part of Gnangara Road (south side) between Madeley Street and Sydney Street, are excluded from this optional area.

Except where the following Department of Transport school bus routes lie within the defined local-intake areas of other primary schools, the local-intake area for Wanneroo Junior Primary

and Wanneroo Primary Schools includes the areas served by the following bus routes: Route 23 (Susan Street to Wanneroo), Route 24 (Gnangara-Wanneroo), Route 25 (Wanneroo-Karaborup), Route 26 (Wanneroo-Old Yanchep Road), Route 27 (Wanneroo-Pinjar), Route 28 (Wanneroo South). Approval to travel as a complimentary passenger on any of these buses does not entitle a child to attend a school serving this local-intake area.

WHITE GUM VALLEY PRIMARY SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Carrington Street and High Street, south along Carrington Street to South Street, west along South Street to Hampton Road, north along Hampton Road to Knutsford Street, east along Knutsford Street to Montreal Street, north along Montreal Street to High Street, and east along High Street to Carrington Street. The boundary parts of Carrington Street (west side), South Street (north side), Hampton Road (east side) and High Street (south side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Knutsford Street (both sides) and Montreal Street (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area of White Gum Valley Primary School.

YANCHEP DISTRICT HIGH SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area for the primary school year levels of Yanchep District High School: The localities of Eglinton, Two Rocks and Yanchep, and the area of the locality of Carabooda located to the north of the following boundary: from the intersection of the locality boundaries of Alkimos, Carabooda and Eglinton, north east across Wanneroo Road to 476 Old Yanchep Road (as shown on Map 8 in the Perth 2000 StreetSmart Street Directory).

SCHOOL EDUCATION ACT 1999**DECLARATION OF LOCAL-INTAKE AREAS FOR SCHOOLS WITH SECONDARY STUDENTS**

(Pursuant to Sections 60, 78, 79 and 80)

The Hon. Minister for Education has declared that the local-intake areas for the secondary schools listed hereunder shall be as stated in this notice. Children of compulsory school age who reside within the local-intake areas of the following secondary schools shall be entitled to attend the schools to which such local-intake areas apply if there is an appropriate educational program for them at that school. The local-intake area of a secondary school may be defined in this notice by listing the names of the contributory primary schools, the local-intake areas and the traditional catchment areas of which, when amalgamated, constitute the local-intake area of that secondary school. Children who reside outside these local-intake areas may apply to attend the schools to which such local-intake areas apply.

ALBANY SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—Albany, Flinders Park and Spencer Park, the traditional catchment area of Mount Manypeaks Primary School and the following boundary between Albany and North Albany Senior High Schools—

From Princess Royal Harbour at the locality boundary between Mount Elphinstone and Mount Melville, generally north along the locality boundary to Cuming Road, north east from Cuming Road to the intersection of Lion Street and Serpentine Road, south east along Serpentine Road to Wellington Street, north east along Wellington Street to the intersection with Pioneer Road, north north east from this intersection along the boundary of the recreation area to the intersection of North Road and Barnesby Drive, south east along North Road to Range Road and north along Range Road to Bond Road. The boundary parts of Serpentine Road (both sides), Wellington Street (both sides), Pioneer Road (both sides), North Road (both sides) and Range Road (both sides) are included within the area for North Albany Senior High School and excluded from the area for Albany Senior High School.

APPLECROSS SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—Applecross, Booragoon, Brentwood, Mt Pleasant and Winthrop, and the traditional catchment area of Ardross Primary School.

The local-intake area of this school is as follows—

From the intersection of Leach Highway and North Lake Road, east along Leach Highway to Riseley Street, north along Riseley Street to Karoonda Road, east along Karoonda Road to Canning Avenue, north east along Canning Avenue and its extension to the foreshore of the Canning River, north along the foreshore of the Canning River and continuing west and south west along the foreshore of the Swan River to the northern extension of North Lake Road, south along this extension and North Lake Road to the intersection with Leach Highway. The boundary parts of Leach Highway (north side), Riseley Street (west side), Karoonda Road (both sides), Canning Avenue (both sides) and North Lake Road (east side) are included within the above local-intake area.

Students resident within the following area have the entitlement of attending either Applecross Senior High School or Rossmoyne Senior High School—

From the junction of Leach Highway and Riseley Street, north along Riseley Street to Karoonda Road, east along Karoonda Road to Canning Avenue, north east along Canning Avenue and its extension to the Canning River foreshore, south along the Canning River and Bull Creek foreshores to Bateman Park, south through Bateman Park to the junction of Leach Highway and Bull Creek Drive, west along Leach Highway to the junction with Riseley Street.

The boundary parts of Riseley Street (east side) and Leach Highway (north side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Karoonda Road (both sides) and Canning Avenue (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

Students resident within the following area have the entitlement of attending either Applecross Senior High School or Melville Senior High School—

From the junction of Leach Highway and Winthrop Drive, south along Winthrop Drive to Somerville Boulevard, east along Somerville Boulevard to Prescott Drive, south along Prescott Drive to South Street, east along South Street to Murdoch Drive, north along Murdoch Drive to Leach Highway and west along Leach Highway to the junction with Winthrop Drive. The boundary parts of Leach Highway (south side), Winthrop Drive (east side), Somerville Boulevard (north side), Prescott Drive (both sides), South Street (north side) and Murdoch Drive (west side) are included within the above optional area.

AUSTRALIND SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains the following primary schools—Australind, Clifton Park, Eaton, Glen Huon and Parkfield and all or part of the traditional catchment areas of Brunswick Junction and River Valley Primary Schools.

The following defines the local-intake area of Australind Senior High School—

From the intersection of the westerly extension of Pead Road with the coastline, east along the aforesaid extension of Pead Road, Pead Road and the easterly extension of Pead Road to the electricity transmission line, south along the electricity transmission line to a point due west from the confluence of the Mornington River and Wellesley River, east to the aforesaid confluence, south along the Wellesley River into the Brunswick River, south west along the Brunswick River to the Australind Bypass, south and south west along the Australind Bypass to the railway crossing, west and north west along the railway line to the railway bridge crossing the Preston River.

The following defines the boundary for an optional area between Australind Senior High School and Harvey Senior High School—

From the Wellington Dam north west and west along the Collie River to the Australind Bypass, north along the Australind Bypass to the Brunswick River, east and north east along the Brunswick River to the confluence with the Wellesley River, north along the Wellesley River to the confluence with the Mornington River, east along the Mornington River to the intersection with Campbell Road, east to the intersection of Sandalwood Road with the South Western Highway and east along Sandalwood Road for a distance of three kilometres.

The boundary parts of Sandalwood Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

BALCATT SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—Balcatta, Takari, West Balcatta and Yuluma, the traditional catchment areas of Lake Gwelup and Osborne Primary Schools and the following exception.

Children resident within the traditional catchment area of Osborne Primary School and resident in Main Street (both sides) and west thereof are entitled to attend Balcatta Senior High School Children resident within the traditional catchment area of Osborne Primary School and resident in the area east of Main Street are entitled to attend either Balcatta Senior High School or Mirrabooka Senior High School.

The following defines an optional area between the Western Suburbs High Schools cluster and Balcatta Senior High School—

From the intersection of the Mitchell Freeway and the Reid Highway, south along the Mitchell Freeway to Erindale Road, east along Erindale Road to Boya Way, south along Boya Way to Odin Road, south along Odin Road and its extension to the Mitchell Freeway, south and south east along the Mitchell Freeway to Scarborough Beach Road, north west along Scarborough Beach Road to Holbeck Street, north along Holbeck Street to Sackville Terrace, east along Sackville to Huntriss Road, north along Huntriss Road and its northern extension through Lake Karrinyup to North Beach Road, west along North Beach Road to Okley Road, north along Okley Road to the proposed Reid Highway and east along the proposed Reid Highway to the Mitchell Freeway.

The boundary parts of the Mitchell Freeway (both sections, west side), Erindale Road (south side), Boya Way (south side), Odin Road (west side), Scarborough Beach Road (north side), North Beach Road (north side) and proposed Reid Highway (south side) are included within this option area. The boundary parts of Holbeck Street (both sides), Sackville Terrace (both sides), Huntriss Road (both sides) and Okley Road (both sides) are excluded from this option area.

BALGA SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—Balga, Boyare, Dryandra, North Balga, Waddington and Warriapendi.

BALLAJURA COMMUNITY COLLEGE

The local-intake area for this school contains the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—Alinjarra, Ballajura, Illawarra and South Ballajura.

The following defines the local-intake area for Ballajura Community College—

From the intersection of Alexander Drive and Marangaroo Drive, south along Alexander Drive to Marshall Road, east along Marshall Road to the proposed northern extension of the Tonkin Highway, north along the proposed extension of the Tonkin Highway to the boundary between the localities of Ballajura and Cullacabardee, north west, north and west along this locality boundary to the intersection with Marangaroo Drive, north west and west along the proposed Hepburn Avenue to Rangeview Road, south along Rangeview Road and its extension to Derbi Road, south along Derbi Road to Hillcrest Road, south west along Hillcrest Road to Gerosa Place, south along Gerosa Place to Marangaroo Drive and east along Marangaroo Drive to Alexander Drive.

The boundary parts of Alexander Drive (east side), Marshall Road (north side), proposed Hepburn Avenue (south side), Rangeview Road (both sides), Hillcrest Road (both sides) and Marangaroo Drive (north side), and the boundary streets of Derbi Road (both sides) and Gerosa Place (both sides) are included within the area for Ballajura Community College.

BELMONT CITY COLLEGE

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of Belmont and Cloverdale Primary Schools and the traditional catchment areas of Belmay, Redcliffe and Tranby Primary Schools.

The following defines the local-intake area of Belmont City College—

From the junction of Belmont Avenue and Great Eastern Highway, south-east along Belmont Avenue and its extension through the Belmont shopping centre to Fulham Street, north-east

along Fulham Street to Abernethy Road, south-east along Abernethy Road to Keane Street, north-east along Keane Street to Whiteside Street, south-east along Whiteside Street and its extension to the Tonkin Highway, south-east along the Tonkin Highway to Horrie Miller Drive, north along Horrie Miller Drive and its extension to the local government authority boundary (City of Belmont and Shire of Swan), north-west along the local government boundary to Great Eastern Highway, south-west along Great Eastern Highway to Ivy Street, north-west along Ivy Street to the Swan River, south and south-west along the Swan River to the north-westerly extension of Belmont Avenue to the Swan River, and south-east along this extension to the junction of Belmont Avenue and Great Eastern Highway.

The boundary parts of Belmont Avenue (north side), Abernethy Road (north side), Keane Street (north side), Whiteside Street (north side) and Ivy Street (both sides) are included within the area for Belmont City College.

The following defines an optional area for the following secondary schools—

Armadale, Belmont, Cannington, Cecil Andrews, Como, Forrestfield, Gosnells, Kalamunda, Kelmscott, Kent Street, Leeming, Lesmurdie, Lynwood, Yule Brook, Rossmoyne, Thornlie and Willetton;

From the Belmont Park railway station, east to the Swan River foreshore and continuing south and east along the foreshore to a point where the north west extension of Belmont Avenue meets the river, south east along this extension, Belmont Avenue and its extension through the Belmont shopping centre to Fulham Street, north east along Fulham Street to Abernethy Road, south east along Abernethy Road to Keane Street, north east along Keane Street to Whiteside Street, south east along Whiteside Street and its extension to Tonkin Highway, south east along Tonkin Highway to Kewdale Road, south west along Kewdale Road to Welshpool Road, west along Welshpool Road to the railway line, and north west along the railway line to the Belmont Park station.

The boundary parts of Belmont Avenue (south side), Fulham Street (south side), Abernethy Road (south side), Keane Street (south side), Whiteside Street (south side), Tonkin Highway (south side), Kewdale Road (north side) and Welshpool Road (north side) are included within this optional area.

BELBRIDGE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—Beldon, Connolly, Currambine, Eddystone, Edgewater, Heathridge and Joondalup.

The following defines a boundary for an optional area between Belridge Senior High School and Ocean Reef Senior High School—

From the intersection of Shenton Avenue and Marmion Avenue, north along Marmion Avenue to Burns Beach Road, east along Burns Beach Road to Connolly Drive, south along Connolly Drive to Shenton Avenue, and west along Shenton Avenue to Marmion Avenue. The boundary parts of Marmion Avenue (east side), Burns Beach Road (south side), Connolly Drive (west side) and Shenton Avenue (north side) are included within this optional area.

BUNBURY SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—Bunbury, Carey Park, Coinda and South Bunbury, the traditional catchment areas of Boyanup, Dardanup, Picton and River Valley Primary Schools and the following exceptions.

The following defines a boundary between Bunbury Senior High School and Newton Moore Senior High School—

From the confluence of the Preston River with the Ferguson River, north west and west along the Preston River to the railway bridge, west and north west along the railway line to the intersection of the railway line and Forrest Avenue, west and north west along Forrest Avenue to Wisbey Street, south west along Wisbey Street to Yorla Road, north west along Yorla Road to Clarke Street East, west along Clarke Street East to Clarke Street, west along Clarke Street to Hoylake Avenue, and north west and west along Hoylake Avenue and its extension to the Indian Ocean.

Children from Carey Park Primary School living in the area north of (but not including) the above boundary have the entitlement of attending either Bunbury Senior High School or Newton Moore Senior High School. Children from Carey Park Primary School living in Hoylake Avenue, Clarke Street and Clarke Street East (both sides in all cases) and the boundary parts of Yorla Road, Wisbey Street and Forrest Avenue (both sides in all cases), and south of the boundary are entitled to attend Newton Moore Senior High School.

Children from South Bunbury Primary School living in the area north of (but not including) the above boundary are entitled to attend Bunbury Senior High School.

Children from South Bunbury Primary School living in Hoylake Avenue, Clarke Street, and Clarke Street East (both sides in all cases) and the boundary parts of Yorla Road, Wisbey Street and Forrest Avenue (both sides in all cases), and south of the boundary are entitled to attend Newton Moore Senior High School.

The following defines a boundary between Bunbury Senior High School and Harvey Senior High School—

From the bridge carrying the Australind Bypass over the Collie River, east and south east along the Collie River to Wellington Dam.

The following defines a boundary between Australind and Bunbury Senior High Schools—

From the bridge carrying the Australind Bypass over the Collie River, south and south west along the Australind Bypass to the railway crossing, west and north west along the railway line to the railway bridge crossing the Preston River.

BUSSELTON SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of Vasse and West Busselton Primary Schools, and the traditional catchment areas of Busselton and Dunsborough Primary Schools.

CARINE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

Carine Senior High School is one of four schools in the Western Suburbs Secondary Schools Cluster. Other secondary schools in this Cluster are: Churchlands, City Beach and Perth Modern. Children resident within the Western Suburbs Secondary Schools Cluster are entitled to attend any of the secondary schools in the Cluster.

The following defines the local-intake area of the Western Suburbs Secondary Schools Cluster—

From a point on the coastline due west of the junction of West Coast Highway and Rochdale Road, east from the coastline to this junction, north along West Coast Highway to Oceanic Drive, east along Oceanic Drive and its extension into Cambridge Street, east along Cambridge Street to Station Street (northern section), south along Station Street (northern section) to Salvado Road, east along Salvado Road to Station Street (southern section), south along Station Street (southern section) to the railway line, south east from the railway line to the junction of Roberts Road and Rokeby Road, south along Rokeby Road to Nicholson Road, east along Nicholson Road to Thomas Street, south east through Kings Park to the Old Brewery on the Swan River, in a generally east and north east direction along the Swan River to Summers Street (East Perth), west along Summers Street (eastern section) to the railway line, west across the railway line to Summers Street (western section), west along Summers Street to Bulwer Street, north west along Bulwer Street to Vincent Street, west along Vincent Street to Charles Street, north along Charles Street to Green Street, west along Green Street to Scarborough Beach Road, west and north west along Scarborough Beach Road to Holbeck Street, north along Holbeck Street to Sackville Terrace, east along Sackville Terrace to Huntriss Road, north along Huntriss Road and its northern extension through Lake Karrinyup to North Beach Road, west along North Beach Road to Okley Road, north along Okley Road to the proposed Reid Highway, east along the proposed Reid Highway to the Mitchell Freeway, north along the Mitchell Freeway to Warwick Road, west along Warwick Road to Marmion Avenue, south along Marmion Avenue to Freeman Way, west along Freeman Way to High Street, and west along High Street and its extension to the Indian Ocean.

The boundary parts of West Coast Highway (west side), Oceanic Drive (north side), Cambridge Street (north side), Station Street (northern and southern sections, east side), Salvado Road (north side), Rokeby Road (east side), Nicholson Road (north side), Summers Street (both sections, both sides), Bulwer Street (both sides), Charles Street (both sides), Green Street (south side), Scarborough Beach Road (south side), Holbeck Street (both sides), Sackville Terrace (both sides), Huntriss Road (both sides), North Beach Road (south side), Okley Road (both sides), proposed Reid Highway (north side), Mitchell Freeway (west side), Warwick Road (south side), Marmion Avenue (east side), Freeman Way (south side) and High Street (south side) are included within the above area.

The following defines an optional area between the Western Suburbs Secondary Schools Cluster and Balcatta Senior High School—

From the intersection of the Mitchell Freeway and the Reid Highway, south along the Mitchell Freeway to Erindale Road, east along Erindale Road to Boya Way, south along Boya Way to Odin Road, south along Odin Road and its extension to the Mitchell Freeway, south and south east along the Mitchell Freeway to Scarborough Beach Road, north west along Scarborough Beach Road to Holbeck Street, north along Holbeck Street to Sackville Terrace, east along Sackville to Huntriss Road, north along Huntriss Road and its northern extension through Lake Karrinyup to North Beach Road, west along North Beach Road to Okley Road, north along Okley Road to the proposed Reid Highway and east along the proposed Reid Highway to the Mitchell Freeway.

The boundary parts of the Mitchell Freeway (both sections, west side), Erindale Road (south side), Boya Way (south side), Odin Road (west side), Scarborough Beach Road (north side), North Beach Road (north side) and proposed Reid Highway (south side) are included with this option area. The boundary parts of Holbeck Street (both sides), Sackville Terrace (both sides), Huntriss Road (both sides) and Okley Road (both sides) are excluded from this option area.

The following defines an optional area between the Western Suburbs Secondary Schools Cluster and Mirrabooka Senior High School—

From the junction of the Mitchell Freeway and Scarborough Beach Road, east along Scarborough Beach Road to Green Street, east along Green Street to Wanneroo Road, north along Wanneroo Road to Roberts Street, west along Roberts Street to the Mitchell Freeway and south along the Mitchell Freeway to Scarborough Beach Road. The boundary parts of Scarborough Beach Road (north side), Green Street (north side) Wanneroo Road (west side) and the Mitchell Freeway (east side) are included within this option area. Roberts Street (both sides) is excluded from this option area.

CHURCHLANDS SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

Churchlands Senior High School is part of the Western Suburbs Secondary School Cluster. The local-intake area for the Western Suburbs Secondary School Cluster is described in the Carine Senior High School local-intake area notice.

CITY BEACH HIGH SCHOOL

City Beach High School is part of the Western Suburbs Secondary School Cluster. The local-intake area for the Western Suburbs Secondary School Cluster is described in the Carine Senior High School local-intake area notice.

CLARKSON COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—Clarkson, Kinross, Merriwa, Mindarie, Quinns Beach and Quinns Rocks.

The following defines the local-intake area of Clarkson Community High School—

From the coastline, east along Burns Beach Road to the proposed extension of the Mitchell Freeway, north along the proposed Mitchell Freeway to the boundary between the localities of Alkimos and Eglinton, west along this locality boundary to the coastline, south along the coastline to Burns Beach Road. The boundary part of Burns Beach Road (north side only) is included within the area for Clarkson Community High School.

The following defines an optional area between Clarkson Community High School and Wanneroo Senior High School—

From 476 Old Yanchep Road (as shown on Map 8 in the 1998 Streetsmart street directory), in a south westerly direction towards the intersection of the locality boundaries of Alkimos, Carabooda and Eglinton, south east along the locality boundary between Alkimos and Carabooda to the proposed Mitchell Freeway, south east along the proposed Mitchell Freeway to the locality boundary between Clarkson and Tamala Park, east north east from this point to the intersection of Wanneroo Road and Flynn Drive and north, north east and east along Flynn Drive to Pinjar Road. The boundary parts of Flynn Drive (north side) are included within this optional area.

COMO SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of Collier and Como Primary Schools, and the traditional catchment areas of Koonawarra, Manning and Wilson Primary Schools.

Children resident in the catchment area of Wilson Primary School in Leach Highway (north-west side) and north-west thereof are entitled to attend Como Senior High School. Children resident in the catchment of Wilson Primary School in Leach Highway (south-east side) and south-east thereof are entitled to attend Cannington Senior High School.

Students resident within the former catchment area for Kewdale Senior High School are entitled to attend Como Senior High School. This area is described in the Belmont City College boundary notice.

COODANUP COMMUNITY COLLEGE

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—Dudley Park, Greenfields and Riverside.

The following defines the local-intake area of Coodanup Community College—

From Channel Island in the Peel Inlet, north along the Mandurah Estuary to the 'old' Mandurah Bridge, east along Pinjarra Road to the intersection with Fremantle Road, north along Fremantle Road to Murdoch Drive, east along Murdoch Drive to Bortolo Drive, north east along Bortolo Drive to the intersection with Exchequer Avenue, east along Exchequer Avenue to Lakes Road, north and east along Lakes Road to the Serpentine River, south along the Serpentine River to Goegrup Lake, south across Goegrup lake to the Serpentine River and south from Goegrup Lake along the Serpentine River to the Peel Inlet. The boundary parts of Pinjarra Road (south side), Fremantle Road (east side), Bortolo Drive (east side) and Exchequer Avenue (south side), Lakes Road (east and south sides), Goegrup Lake (west side) and the Serpentine River (west side) are included within the local-intake area for Coodanup Community College.

The following defines an optional area between Coodanup Community College and Mandurah High School—

From the intersection of Fremantle Road and Murdoch Drive, east along Murdoch Drive to Bortolo Drive, north along Bortolo Drive to Exchequer Avenue, east along Exchequer Avenue to Lakes Road, north along Lakes Road to Gordon Road, west along Gordon Road to Fremantle Road and south along Fremantle Road to Murdoch Drive. The boundary parts of Murdoch Drive (north side), Bortolo Drive (west side), Exchequer Avenue (north side), Lakes Road (west side), Gordon Road (south side) and Fremantle Road (east side) are included within this optional area.

CRAIGIE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—Camberwarra, Craigie, Lymburner, Mullaloo Beach, Mullaloo Heights and Springfield, with the following exceptions.

Children from Lymburner Primary School living in the following area are entitled to attend Craigie Senior High School—

From the intersection of Whitfords Avenue and Marmion Avenue, south along Marmion Avenue to Cook Avenue, west along Cook Avenue to Wild Road, south along Wild Road to David Crescent, west along David Crescent to Mawson Crescent, south along Mawson Crescent to Flinders Avenue, west along Flinders Avenue to Whitfords Avenue, and north and east along Whitfords Avenue to Marmion Avenue. The boundary parts of Marmion Avenue (west side), Cook Avenue (both sides), and Whitfords Avenue (east and south sides) are included within this area. The boundary parts of Wild Road (both sides), David Crescent (both sides), Mawson Crescent (both sides) and Flinders Avenue (both sides) are excluded from this area.

The following defines a boundary for an optional area between Craigie Senior High School and Ocean Reef Senior High School—

From the Indian Ocean south of the east-west alignment of Merrifield Place, due east to Northshore Drive, north along Northshore Drive to Mullaloo Drive, in a general easterly direction along Mullaloo Drive to Kallaroo Place, east along Kallaroo Place to Marmion Avenue, north

along Marmion Avenue to Ocean Reef Road, west along Ocean Reef Road to the junction with Oceanside Promenade, and due west to the Indian Ocean. The boundary part of Merrifield Place (both sides), Northshore Drive (west side), Mullaloo Drive (north side), Marmion Avenue (west side), Ocean Reef Road (south side) and the boundary street of Kallaroo Place (north side), are included within the optional area.

DENMARK HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the traditional catchment areas of Denmark and Walpole Primary Schools.

The following defines an optional area between Denmark High School and North Albany Senior High School—

From the Southern Ocean, north east along Tennessee South Road to Lower Denmark Road, north west along Lower Denmark Road to Eden Road, west along Eden Road to Two Bob Hill, and south west from Two Bob Hill to the Southern Ocean. The boundary parts of Tennessee South Road (both sides), Lower Denmark Road (both sides) and Eden Road (both sides) are included within the optional area.

DUNCRAIG SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—Duncraig, Glengarry and Sorrento.

EASTERN HILLS SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—Chidlow, Darlington, Gidgegannup, Glen Forrest, Mundaring and Woorloo, the traditional catchment areas of Mount Helena, Parkerville and Sawyers Valley Primary Schools and the following exceptions.

Children from Darlington Primary School are entitled to attend Eastern Hills Senior High School, Kalamunda Senior High School or Swan View Senior High School.

Children from Glen Forrest Primary School are entitled to attend Eastern Hills Senior High School, Kalamunda Senior High School or Swan View Senior High School.

FORRESTFIELD SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—Edney, Forrestfield, High Wycombe, Maida Vale and Woodlupine, the traditional catchment areas of Dawson Park and Wattle Grove Primary Schools, and the following exceptions.

Children from Wattle Grove Primary School are entitled to attend either Forrestfield Senior High School or Lesmurdie Senior High School.

The following defines an optional area between Forrestfield and Kalamunda Senior High Schools—

From the intersection of the Great Eastern Highway Bypass and the railway line, east along the Great Eastern Highway Bypass to the Roe Highway, north along the Roe Highway to Bushmead Road, east along Bushmead Road to the boundary between the Shires of Mundaring and Swan, south east along the shire boundary to Ridge Hill Road, south and south west along Ridge Hill Road to Watsonia Road, south, south east and south west along Watsonia Road to Kalamunda Road, south east along Kalamunda Road to Nangana Way, south along the north-south alignment of Nangana Way, south along the north-south alignment of Nangana Way to the walk trail, west along the walk trail to West Terrace, north west and north along West Terrace to Simeon Close, west along Simeon Close and its extension to Maud Road, and continuing west along Maud Road to Hawtin Road, north along Hawtin Road to Kent Road, west along Kent Road to Brewer Road, south along Brewer Road to Bruce Road, west along Bruce Road to Sultana Road East, north west along Sultana Road East to Sultana Road West, continuing north west along Sultana Road West to Milner Road, south west along Milner Road to the boundary between the localities of Forrestfield and High Wycombe, west along this locality boundary to the local government boundary between the City of Belmont and the Shire of Kalamunda, north, north west and north east along the Shire of Kalamunda boundary to the railway line and north along the railway line to the Great Eastern Highway Bypass. The boundary parts of the Great Eastern Highway Bypass (south side), Roe Highway (east side), Bushmead Road (south side), Ridge Hill Road (both sides), Watsonia Road (both sides), Kalamunda Road (south side), Nangana Way (both sides), West Terrace (both sides), Simeon Close (both sides), Maud Road (both sides), Kent Road (both sides), Brewer Road (both sides), Bruce Road (both sides), East Sultana Road (both sides), West Sultana Road (both sides) and Milner Road (both sides) are included in the optional area. The boundary parts of the Great Eastern Highway Bypass (north side), Roe Highway (west side), Bushmead Road (north side) and Kalamunda Road (north side) are excluded from this optional area.

Students resident within the former catchment area for Kewdale Senior High School are entitled to attend Forrestfield Senior High School. This area is described in the Belmont City College local-intake area notice.

GERALDTON SECONDARY COLLEGE

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Allendale, Beachlands, Bluff Point, Geraldton, Mount Tarcoola and Rangeway, and the traditional catchment area of Waggrakine Primary School.

GIRRAWHEEN SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Blackmore, Girrawheen, Hainsworth, Koondoola, Marangaroo and Montrose.

GOSNELLS SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Ashburton Drive, Gosnells, Huntingdale and Wirrabirra, and the traditional catchment area of Seaforth Primary School.

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the rail crossing of Fremantle Road and the railway line, south east along the railway line to the closest point west of the junction of Albany Highway and Tonkin Highway, east to the aforesaid junction and north east along Tonkin Highway to the Canning River, generally south along the Canning River to the road to the Harry Hunter Rehabilitation Centre, west along the aforesaid road to Albany Highway, south along Albany Highway to the local government boundary between the City of Gosnells and the City of Armadale, north west and south west along this local government boundary to Ranford Road, north west along Ranford Road to Southern River Road, north east along Southern River Road to Gay Street, north west along Gay Street to Warton Road, north east along Warton Road to Corfield Street, south east along Corfield Street to the Southern River, north, east and south east along the Canning River to Albany Highway, south along Albany Highway to Fremantle Road and west along Fremantle Road to the railway crossing.

The boundary parts of Tonkin Highway (south east side), the road to the Harry Hunter Rehabilitation Centre (north side), Albany Highway (southern section, west side), Warton Road (south east side) and Corfield Street (south side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Ranford Road (both sides), Southern River Road (both sides), Gay Street (both sides), and Albany Highway (northern section, both sides) are excluded from this local-intake area.

The following defines the boundary of an optional area between Gosnells Senior High School and Thornlie Senior High School—

From the junction of Ranford Road and Southern River Road, north east along Southern River Road to Gay Street, north west along Gay Street and its extension to Warton Road, south west along Warton Road to Ranford Road and south east along Ranford Road to Southern River Road.

The boundary parts of Southern River Road (both sides), Gay Street (both sides) and Warton Road (south side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Ranford Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The following defines the boundary of an optional area between Gosnells and Kelmscott Senior High Schools—

From the junction of Mills Road East and Tonkin Highway, south west along Tonkin Highway to the bridge over the Canning River, south along the Canning River to the local government boundary between the City of Armadale and the City of Gosnells, east, south and east along the local government boundary to the western boundary of the Cohunu Wildlife Sanctuary site and continuing north to a point east of the junction of Mills Road East and Pages Way, west from this point to the junction of Mills Road East and Pages Way and in a generally westerly direction along Mills Road East to the junction with Tonkin Highway.

The boundary parts of Tonkin Highway (south east side), Canning Highway (east side), Pages Way (both sides) and Mills Road East (both sides) are included within this optional area.

The following defines a boundary for an optional area between Gosnells Senior High School and Yule Brook College—

From the eastern extremity of Rushton Road, west and north west along Rushton Road to Ellis Brook, in a generally westerly direction along Ellis Brook to Mills Road West, north west along Mills Road West to Gosnells Road, west along Gosnells Road to Albany Highway, south along Albany Highway to Fremantle Road, west along Fremantle Road to the railway line, south east and south along the railway line to a point due west of the junction of Albany Highway and Tonkin Highway, east from this point to Tonkin Highway, north east along Tonkin Highway to Mills Road East, east along Mills Road East to Pages Way and due east from this point.

The boundary parts of Rushton Road (both sides), Albany Highway (both sides), Fremantle Road (both sides) and Tonkin Highway (west side) are included within this optional area, while the boundary parts of Mills Road West (both sides), Gosnells Road (both sides) and Mills Road East (both sides) are excluded from the optional area.

Students resident within the former local-intake area of the (now closed) Kewdale Senior High School are entitled to attend Gosnells Senior High School. This area is described in the Belmont City College local-intake area notice.

GOVERNOR STIRLING SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of Middle Swan and West Midland Primary Schools and the traditional catchment areas of the following primary schools—

Bassendean, Guildford, Herne Hill, Midland, Midvale and Upper Swan.

The following defines the local-intake area of Governor Stirling Senior High School—

From the bridge carrying Toodyay Road over Jane Brook, south-west along Toodyay Road to the Roe Highway, south along the Roe Highway to Great Eastern Highway, west along Great Eastern Highway to Lloyd Street, south along Lloyd Street to Clayton Street, south along Clayton Street to Military Road, south along Military Road to Bushmead Road, east along Bushmead Road to the Roe Highway, south along the Roe Highway to the Great Eastern Highway Bypass, west along the Great Eastern Highway Bypass to Great Eastern Highway, south-west along Great Eastern Highway to Ivy Street, north-west along Ivy Street to the Swan River, south and west along the Swan River to the extension of Iveson Place, north along Iveson Place to Reid Street, west along Reid Street to Elder Parade, north along Elder Parade to Chapman Street, west and north-west along Chapman Street to the railway line, north-east along the railway line to the Swan River, and generally north along the Swan River to the confluence with Ellenbrook.

The boundary parts of Toodyay Road (north side), Roe Highway (west side), Great Eastern Highway (north side), Lloyd Street (both sides), Bushmead Road (south side), Roe Highway (west side), Great Eastern Highway Bypass (north side), Elder Parade (east side) and Chapman Street (north side) are included within the area for Governor Stirling Senior High School.

The boundary parts of Toodyay Road (south side), Roe Highway (east side), Great Eastern Highway (south side), Military Road (both sides), Bushmead Road (north side), Roe Highway (east side), Great Eastern Highway Bypass (south side), Ivy Street (both sides), Iveson Place (both sides), Reid Street (both sides), Elder Parade (west side) and Chapman Street (south side) are excluded from the area for Governor Stirling Senior High School.

The following defines the boundary for an optional area between Governor Stirling Senior High School and Swan View Senior High School—

From the intersection of Great Eastern Highway and Roe Highway, west along Great Eastern Highway to Bushby Street, north along Bushby Street and its extension northwards along the locality boundary to Eddie Barron Drive, east along the locality boundary between Middle Swan and Midvale to the Roe Highway, south along the Roe Highway to Great Eastern Highway. The boundary parts of Great Eastern Highway (both sides), Bushby Street (both sides) and Roe Highway (west side) are included within this optional area.

GREENWOOD SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Dalmain, Goollelal and West Greenwood.

HALLS HEAD COMMUNITY COLLEGE

The following primary schools are contained within the local-intake area of Halls Head Community College—Falcon, Glencoe, Halls Head and Ocean Road.

The following defines the local-intake area for Halls Head Community College—

From a point on the coast of the Indian Ocean on the western extension of Tims Thicket Road, north along the coastline to and across the Dawesville Channel, continuing north east along the ocean shoreline to the Mandurah Estuary, south along the Mandurah Estuary to the Peel Inlet, generally south and south west along the western shoreline of the Peel Inlet to and across the Dawesville Channel, and continuing south along the western shoreline of the Harvey Estuary to a point on the eastern extension of Tims Thicket Road.

HAMILTON SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Coogee, Coolbellup, Kardinya, Koorilla, Newton, North Lake, Phoenix, Samson, Southwell, Spearwood, Wattleup and Winterfold, and the traditional catchment areas of East Hamilton Hill and South Coogee Primary Schools. Spearwood Alternative Primary School is also located within this local-intake area.

The following defines a boundary for the local-intake area of Hamilton Senior High School—

From the intersection of the coastline and the westward extension of Island Street, east along Island Street to Hampton Road, south along Hampton Road to Rockingham Road, south east along Rockingham Road to Carrington Street, north along Carrington Street to Winterfold Road, east along Winterfold Road and continuing along Torquil Road to North Lake Road, south along North Lake Road to the proposed Roe Highway, north east along the proposed Roe Highway to Progress Drive, south along Progress Drive to the eastward extension of Phoenix Road, west along the extension of Phoenix Road and Phoenix Road to Sudlow Road, south along Sudlow Road to Spearwood Avenue, north west along Spearwood Avenue to Wellard Street, south along Wellard Street to Barrington Street, west along Barrington Street to the railway line, and south along the railway line to the eastward extension of Fanstone Avenue.

The boundary parts of Hampton Road (west side), Rockingham Road (south side), Carrington Street (east side), Winterfold Road (south side), Torquil Road (south side), North Lake Road (west side) and Progress Drive (both sides), are included within the area for Hamilton Senior High School. The boundary parts of Island Street and its extension are excluded from the area for Hamilton Senior High School.

Children from Winterfold Primary School living in Healy Road (both sides) and north thereof are entitled to attend South Fremantle Senior High School. Children from Winterfold Primary

School living in the area south of Healy Road are entitled to attend either South Fremantle Senior High School or Hamilton Senior High School.

The following defines an optional area between Hamilton and South Fremantle Senior High Schools—

From the intersection of Stock Road and Winterfold Road, east along Winterfold Road and continuing into Torquil Road to North Lake Road, north along North Lake Road to South Street, west along South Street to Stock Road and south along Stock Road to Winterfold Road. The boundary parts of Winterfold Road (north side), Torquil Road (north side), North Lake Road (west side), South Street (south side) and Stock Road (east side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Hamilton and Melville Senior High Schools—

From the intersection of Farrington Road and North Lake Road, east along Farrington Road to Progress Drive, south along Progress Drive to the proposed Roe Highway, west along the proposed Roe Highway to North Lake Road, and north along North Lake Road to Farrington Road. The boundary parts of Farrington Road (south side), Progress Drive (both sides) and North Lake Road (east side) are included within this optional area.

HAMPTON SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Eden Hill, Ellenbrook, Hampton Park, Morley, Noranda and Weld Square; the traditional catchment areas of Anzac Terrace and Embleton Primary Schools, and the following exceptions.

The following defines a partial boundary between Hampton Senior High School and Lockridge Senior High School—

From the junction of Benara Road and Beechboro Road, south along Beechboro Road to Devonshire Street, east between Eugene Court and Redgum Way to the north, and Seacom Court and Elettra Close to the south, to Cassia Way, south along Cassia Way to Challenger Avenue, east and north along Challenger Avenue to Bottlebrush Drive and south along Bottlebrush Drive to Morley Drive East. The boundary parts of Beechboro Road (east side), Eugene Court (both sides), Redgum Way (both sides) and Bottlebrush Drive (east side) are included within the area for Lockridge Senior High School. The boundary parts of Beechboro Road (west side), Seacom Court (both sides), Elettra Close (both sides), Cassia Way (both sides), Challenger Avenue (both sides) and Bottlebrush Drive (west side) are included within the area for Hampton Senior High School.

Children from Eden Hill Primary School living in Walter Road (south side) and south thereof and in May Road and Iolanthe Street north of Walter Road (west side in each case) and west thereof are entitled to attend Hampton Senior High School. Children from Eden Hill Primary School living in Walter Road (north side), east of Iolanthe Street, and north thereof and in May Road and Iolanthe Street north of Walter Road (east side in each case) and east thereof are entitled to attend Lockridge Senior High School.

Children from Embleton Primary School living in Collier Road (both sides) and east and north thereof are entitled to attend Hampton Senior High School. Children from Embleton Primary School living in the area west and south of Collier Road are entitled to attend John Forrest Senior High School.

Children from Morley Primary School living in Old Collier Road (both sides) and that part of Collier Road (both sides) with a south easterly orientation, and east thereof south of Walter Road, are entitled to attend Hampton Senior High School. Children from Morley Primary School living in the area west of Old Collier Road and that part of Collier Road with a south easterly orientation, south of Walter Road, are entitled to attend John Forrest Senior High School. Children from Morley Primary School living in Walter Road (both sides) and north and west thereof are entitled to attend Morley Senior High School.

Children from Noranda Primary School living in Crimea Street (east side) and east thereof are entitled to attend Hampton Senior High School. Children from Noranda Primary School living in Crimea Street (west side) and west thereof are entitled to attend Morley Senior High School.

The following defines an optional area between Hampton Senior High School and Lockridge Senior High School—

From the confluence of the Swan River and Ellen Brook, in a general northerly direction along Ellen Brook to the locality boundary of Belhus and Ellenbrook, in a general north westerly direction along this boundary to its westernmost point, in a north westerly direction from this point to the proposed Perth to Darwin Highway, south along the Perth to Darwin Highway to a point nearest the intersection of Lord Street and Youle-Dean Road, east from this point to the intersection of Lord Street and Youle-Dean Road, and continuing east along Youle-Dean Road, and north east along the unmade portion of Youle-Dean Road to the intersection with Woollcott Avenue, south east along Woollcott Avenue to West Swan Road, north along West Swan Road to Douglas Road, east and south east along Douglas Road to the Swan River and north along the Swan River to the confluence with Ellen Brook.

The boundary parts of Douglas Road (both sides) are included within the optional area. The boundary parts of Youle-Dean Road (both sides), Woollcott Avenue (both sides) and West Swan Road (both sides) are excluded from the optional area.

HARVEY SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the traditional catchment areas of the following primary schools—

Brunswick Junction, Harvey and Yarloop, and the following exceptions.

The following defines the southern boundary for Harvey Senior High School—

From the intersection of the westerly extension of Pead Road with the coastline, east along the aforesaid extension of Pead Road, Pead Road and the easterly extension of Pead Road to the electricity transmission line, south along the electricity transmission line to a point due west from the confluence of the Mornington River and Wellesley River, east to the aforesaid confluence, east along the Mornington River to the intersection with Campbell Road, east to the intersection of Sandalwood Road with the South Western Highway and east along Sandalwood Road for a distance of three kilometres. The boundary parts of Sandalwood Road (both sides) are included within the catchment area of Harvey Senior High School.

The following defines the boundary for an optional area between Australind Senior High School and Harvey Senior High School—

From the Wellington Dam north west and west along the Collie River to the Australind Bypass, north along the Australind Bypass to the Brunswick River, east and north east along the Brunswick River to the confluence with the Wellesley River, north along the Wellesley River to the confluence with the Mornington River, east along the Mornington River to the intersection with Campbell Road, east to the intersection of Sandalwood Road with the South Western Highway and east along Sandalwood Road for a distance of three kilometres. The boundary parts of Sandalwood Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

JOHN CURTIN COLLEGE OF THE ARTS

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the North Fremantle and Palmyra Primary Schools, the traditional catchment areas of the following primary schools—Bicton, East Fremantle and Richmond, and the following exception.

Children from Palmyra Primary School living in the area east of Stock Road have the entitlement of attending either John Curtin College of the Arts or Melville Senior High School. Children from Palmyra Primary School living in Stock Road (both sides) and west thereof are entitled to attend John Curtin College of the Arts.

JOHN FORREST SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of Inglewood, Morley and West Morley Primary Schools and the traditional catchment areas of Ashfield, Bayswater, East Maylands, Embleton and Hillcrest Primary Schools.

The following defines the local-intake area for John Forrest Senior High School—

From the intersection of Morley Drive and Alexander Drive, east along Morley Drive to Light Street, south-east along Light Street to Walter Road West, north-east and east along Walter Road West to Old Collier Road, south east along Old Collier Road and continuing south east into Collier Road, south east along Collier Road to the railway line, south-west along the railway line to Chapman Street, south-east along Chapman Street to Elder Parade, south along Elder Parade to Reid Street, east along Reid Street to Iveson Place, south along Iveson Place and its extension to the Swan River, south-west and west along the Swan River foreshore to the extension of Fogerthorpe Crescent, north along Fogerthorpe Crescent to Peninsula Road, west along Peninsula Road to Joseph Street, north along Joseph Street to Mephan Street, north-east along Mephan Street to Caledonian Avenue, north-west along Caledonian Avenue to the railway line, north-east along the railway line to Kennedy Street, north-west along Kennedy Street, Eleventh Avenue, Dundas Road and Homer Street to Alexander Drive, and north along Alexander Drive to Morley Drive. The boundary parts of Morley Drive (south side), Chapman Street (south side), Elder Parade (west side), Reid Street (both sides), Iveson Place (both sides), Fogerthorpe Crescent (both sides), Peninsula Road (both sides), Joseph Street (east side), Mephan Street (east side), Caledonian Avenue (north-east side), Homer Street (north-east side) and Alexander Drive (east side) are included within the area for John Forrest Senior High School.

The boundary parts of Light Street (both sides), Walter Road West (both sides), Collier Road (both sides), Chapman Street (north side), Elder Parade (east side), Joseph Street (west side), Mephan Street (west side), Caledonian Avenue (south-west side), Homer Street (south-west side) and Alexander Drive (west side) are excluded from the area for John Forrest Senior High School.

KALAMUNDA SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Darlington, Edney, Falls Road, Glen Forrest, Gooseberry Hill, High Wycombe, Kalamunda and Maida Vale, the traditional catchment area of Walliston Primary School and the following exceptions.

Children from Falls Road Primary School living in the area north of Falls Road and the portion of Lesmurdie Road north of Falls Road are entitled to attend Kalamunda Senior High School. Children from Falls Road Primary School living in the area south of Falls Road and south of the portion of Lesmurdie Road north of Falls Road are entitled to attend Lesmurdie Senior High School. Children living in Falls Road and the boundary part of Lesmurdie Road have the entitlement of attending either Kalamunda Senior High School or Lesmurdie Senior High School.

Children from Walliston Primary School living in the area north of Lesmurdie Road, Jackson Road, and a line connecting the junction of Jackson Road and Stanhope Road with the junction of Mundaring Weir Road and Aldersyde Road are entitled attend Kalamunda Senior High School. Children from Walliston Primary School living in the area south of Lesmurdie Road, Jackson Road, and a line connecting the junction of Jackson Road and Stanhope Road with the junction of Mundaring Weir Road and Aldersyde Road are entitled to attend Lesmurdie Senior High School.

Children living in the boundary part of Lesmurdie Road and in Jackson Road have the entitlement of attending either Kalamunda Senior High School or Lesmurdie Senior High School.

The following defines an optional area between Forrestfield and Kalamunda Senior High Schools—

From the intersection of the Great Eastern Highway Bypass and the railway line, east along the Great Eastern Highway Bypass to the Roe Highway, north along the Roe Highway to Bushmead Road, east along Bushmead Road to the boundary between the Shires of Mundaring and Swan, south east along the shire boundary to Ridge Hill Road, south and south west along Ridge Hill Road to Watsonia Road, south, south east and south west along Watsonia Road to Kalamunda Road, south east along Kalamunda Road to Nangana Way, south along the north-south alignment of Nangana Way, south along the north-south alignment of Nangana Way to the walk trail, west along the walk trail to West Terrace, north west and north along West Terrace to Simeon Close, west along Simeon Close and its extension to Maud Road, and continuing west along Maud Road to Hawtin Road, north along Hawtin Road to Kent Road, west along Kent Road to Brewer Road, south along Brewer Road to Bruce Road, west along Bruce Road to Sultana Road East, north west along Sultana Road East to Sultana Road West, continuing north west along Sultana Road West to Milner Road, south west along Milner Road to the boundary between the localities of Forrestfield and High Wycombe, west along this locality boundary to the local government boundary between the City of Belmont and the Shire of Kalamunda, north, north west and north east along the Shire of Kalamunda boundary to the railway line and north along the railway line to the Great Eastern Highway Bypass. The boundary parts of the Great Eastern Highway Bypass (south side), Roe Highway (east side), Bushmead Road (south side), Ridge Hill Road (both sides), Watsonia Road (both sides), Kalamunda Road (south side), Nangana Way (both sides), West Terrace (both sides), Simeon Close (both sides), Maud Road (both sides), Kent Road (both sides), Brewer Road (both sides), Bruce Road (both sides), East Sultana Road (both sides), West Sultana Road (both sides) and Milner Road (both sides) are included in the optional area. The boundary parts of the Great Eastern Highway Bypass (north side), Roe Highway (west side), Bushmead Road (north side) and Kalamunda Road (north side) are excluded from this optional area.

Children from Darlington Primary School are entitled to attend either Eastern Hills Senior High School, Kalamunda Senior High School or Swan View Senior High School

Children from Glen Forrest Primary School are entitled to attend either Eastern Hills Senior High School, Kalamunda Senior High School or Swan View Senior High School.

Students resident within the former catchment area for Kewdale Senior High School are entitled to attend Kalamunda Senior High School. This area is described in the Belmont City College boundary notice.

KELMSCOTT SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of Kingsley and Westfield Park Primary Schools and the traditional catchment areas of the following primary schools—Clifton Hills, Grovelands and Kelmscott.

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Lake Road with Albany Highway, north along Albany Highway to the road that leads to the Harry Hunter Rehabilitation Centre, east along the aforesaid road to the Canning River, south along the Canning River to the local government boundary between the City of Armadale and the City of Gosnells, east, south and east along this local government boundary to Canning Mills Road, south west along Canning Mills Road to a point due west of the southern extremity of Coventry Road, east from this point to a point due north of the eastern extremity of Buckingham Road, south from this point through the eastern extremity of Buckingham Road and continuing south through the junction of Brookton Highway and Stocker Road, and continuing south to a point due east of the eastern extension of Salter Road, west along this extension to Salter Road itself, and continuing west, and north along existing and proposed sections of Salter Road to Wahroonga Road, west along Wahroonga Road and its western extension to Albany Highway, south along Albany Highway to Galliers Avenue, west along Galliers Avenue and its extension to Railway Avenue, north along Railway Avenue to Champion Drive, north west along Champion Drive and its extension to the local government boundary between the City of Armadale and the City of Gosnells, north east and south east along this local government boundary to the intersection of Lake Road with Albany Highway.

The boundary parts of Albany Highway (northern section, east side), the road to the Harry Hunter Rehabilitation Centre (south side), Salter Road (both sides), Wahroonga Road (both sides), Albany Highway (southern section, west side), Galliers Avenue (both sides), Railway Avenue (both sides) and Champion Drive (north east side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Canning Mills Road (both sides) are excluded from this local-intake area.

The following defines the boundary of an optional area between Gosnells and Kelmscott Senior High Schools—

From the junction of Mills Road East and Tonkin Highway, south west along Tonkin Highway to the bridge over the Canning River, south along the Canning River to the local government boundary between the City of Armadale and the City of Gosnells, east, south and east along the local government boundary to the western boundary of the Cohunu Wildlife Sanctuary site and continuing north to a point east of the junction of Mills Road East and Pages Way, west from this point to the junction of Mills Road East and Pages Way and in a generally westerly direction along Mills Road East to the junction with Tonkin Highway.

The boundary parts of Tonkin Highway (south east side), Canning Highway (east side), Pages Way (both sides) and Mills Road East (both sides) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Kelmscott Senior High School and Roleystone District High School—

From the junction of Chevin Road and Canning Mills Road, east along Chevin Road to a point midway between Coventry Road and Hill Road, south from this point to a point due east of the southern extremity of Coventry Road, west from this point to Canning Mills Road and north east along Canning Mills Road to Chevin Road.

The boundary parts of Chevin Road (both sides) and Canning Mills Road (both sides) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Cecil Andrews and Kelmscott Senior High Schools—

From the intersection of Lake Road and Champion Drive, south west along Lake Road to Bay Court, north west along Bay Court and its extension to the Southern River, north along the Southern River to the north westerly extension of Champion Drive, and south east along the extension of Champion Drive to Lake Road.

The boundary parts of Lake Road (west side), and Bay Court (both sides) are included within this optional area.

Students resident within the former local-intake area of the (now closed) Kewdale Senior High School are entitled to attend Kelmscott Senior High School. This area is described in the Belmont City College local-intake area notice.

KENT STREET SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Great Eastern Highway and the railway line, south and south east along the railway line to Leach Highway, south west along Leach Highway to Manning Road, west along Manning Road to a point due south of the southern extension of Hill View Terrace, north along this extension and Hill View Terrace to Walpole Street, north east along Walpole Street to Holder Street, west along Holder Street to Maquis Street, south west along Marquis Street to Hayman Road, generally north west along Hayman Road to South Terrace, west along South Terrace to the Swan River foreshore, generally north and east along the foreshore to the Causeway, south east from the Causeway to Great Eastern Highway, and north east along Great Eastern Highway to the railway line.

The boundary parts of Leach Highway (north west side), Manning Road (north side), Hill View Terrace and extension (east side), Walpole Street (south east side), Holder Street (north side), Marquis Street (north west side), Hayman Road (north east side), South Terrace (north side) and Great Eastern Highway (both sides) are included within the local-intake area for this school.

Students resident within the former local-intake area of the (now closed) Kewdale Senior High School are entitled to attend Kent Street Senior High School. This area is described in the Belmont City College local-intake area notice.

KWINANA SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Baldivis, Calista, Hope Valley, Leda, Medina, North Parmelia and Orelia.

LAKELAND SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains the following primary schools—

Atwell, Beeliar, Bibra Lake, Jandakot, South Lake and Yangebup.

The following defines a boundary for Lakeland Senior High School—

From the intersection of the railway line and the eastward extension of Fanstone Avenue, north along the railway line to Barrington Street, east along Barrington Street to Wellard Street, north along Wellard Street to Spearwood Avenue, south east along Spearwood Avenue to Sudlow Road, north along Sudlow Road to Phoenix Road, east along Phoenix Road and the extension of Phoenix Road to Progress Drive, north along Progress Drive to the proposed Roe Highway, east along the proposed Roe Highway to the western extension of Leeming Road, east to and along Leeming Road to Johnston Road, south along Johnston Road to Acourt Road, south and east along Acourt Road to Warton Road, south west along Warton Road to Forrest Road, west along Forrest Road to a point due north of the western arm of Murdoch Way, due south from this point to Rowley Road. The boundary parts of Phoenix Road (south side), Roe Highway (south side) and Leeming Road (south side) are included within the area for Lakeland Senior High School. The boundary parts of Phoenix Road (north side), Progress Drive (both sides), Johnston Road (both sides), Acourt Road (both sides), Warton Road (both sides), Forrest Road (both sides) and Murdoch Way (both sides) are excluded from the area for Lakeland Senior High School.

The following defines an optional area between Lakeland Senior High School and Leeming Senior High School: From the junction of Farrington Road and the Kwinana Freeway, west along Farrington Road to Bibra Drive, south along Bibra Drive to the proposed Roe Highway, east along the proposed Roe Highway to the Kwinana Freeway and north along the Kwinana Freeway to Farrington Road.

The boundary parts of the Kwinana Freeway (west side), Farrington Road (south side), Bibra Lake Drive (east side) and proposed Roe Highway (north side) are included within the optional area.

LESMURDIE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of Falls Road and Lesmurdie Primary Schools, the traditional catchment areas of the following primary schools—Pickering Brook, Walliston and Wattle Grove; and the following exceptions.

Children from Falls Road Primary School living in the area north of Falls Road and the portion of Lesmurdie Road north of Falls Road are entitled to attend Kalamunda Senior High School. Children living in Falls Road and the boundary part of Lesmurdie Road are entitled to attend either Lesmurdie Senior High School or Kalamunda Senior High School.

Children from Walliston Primary School living in the area south of Lesmurdie Road, Jackson Road, and a line connecting the junction of Jackson Road and Stanhope Road with the junction of Mundaring Weir Road and Aldersyde Road are entitled to attend Lesmurdie Senior High School. Children from Walliston Primary School living in the area north of Lesmurdie Road, Jackson Road, and a line connecting the junction of Jackson Road and Stanhope Road with the junction of Mundaring Weir Road and Aldersyde Road are entitled to attend Kalamunda Senior High School. Children living in the boundary part of Lesmurdie Road and in Jackson Road are entitled to attend either Lesmurdie Senior High School or Kalamunda Senior High School.

Children from Wattle Grove Primary School are entitled to attend either Lesmurdie Senior High School or Forrestfield Senior High School.

Students resident within the former catchment area for Kewdale Senior High School are entitled to attend Lesmurdie Senior High School. This area is described in the Belmont City College local-intake-area notice.

LOCKRIDGE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Beechboro, East Beechboro, Eden Hill, Ellenbrook, Lockridge and West Beechboro; the traditional catchment area of Caversham Primary School and the following exceptions.

The following defines a partial boundary between Hampton Senior High School and Lockridge Senior High School—

From the junction of Benara Road and Beechboro Road, south along Beechboro Road to Devonshire Street, east between Eugene Court and Redgum Way to the north, and Seacom Court and Elettra Close to the south, to Cassia Way, south along Cassia Way to Challenger Avenue, east and north along Challenger Avenue to Bottlebrush Drive and south along Bottlebrush Drive to Morley Drive East. The boundary parts of Beechboro Road (east side), Eugene Court (both sides), Redgum Way (both sides) and Bottlebrush Drive (east side) are included within the area for Lockridge Senior High School. Children from Eden Hill Primary School living in Walter Road (north side) east of Iolanthe Street and north thereof and in May Road and Iolanthe Street north of Walter Road (east side in each case) and east thereof are entitled to attend Lockridge Senior High School. Children from Eden Hill Primary School living in Walter Road (south side) and south thereof and in May Road and Iolanthe Street north of Walter Road (west side in each case) and west thereof are entitled to attend Hampton Senior High School.

The following defines an optional area between Hampton Senior High School and Lockridge Senior High School—

From the confluence of the Swan River and Ellen Brook, in a general northerly direction along Ellen Brook to the locality boundary of Belhus and Ellenbrook, in a general north westerly direction along this boundary to its westernmost point, in a north westerly direction from this point to the proposed Perth to Darwin Highway, south along the Perth to Darwin Highway to a point nearest the intersection of Lord Street and Youle-Dean Road, east from this point to the intersection of Lord Street and Youle-Dean Road, and continuing east along Youle-Dean Road, and north east along the unmade portion of Youle-Dean Road to the intersection with Woollcott Avenue, south east along Woollcott Avenue to West Swan Road, north along West Swan Road to Douglas Road, east and south east along Douglas Road to the Swan River and north along the Swan River to the confluence with Ellen Brook.

The boundary parts of Douglas Road (both sides) are included within the optional area. The boundary parts of Youle-Dean Road (both sides), Woollcott Avenue (both sides) and West Swan Road (both sides) are excluded from the optional area.

LYNWOOD SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Brookman, Ferndale, Kinlock, Langford, Lynwood and Parkwood.

Students resident within the former catchment area for Kewdale Senior High School are entitled to attend Lynwood Senior High School. This area is described in the Belmont City College local-intake area notice.

MANDURAH HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—Greenfields, Mandurah, North Mandurah, Riverside, Secret Harbour and Singleton.

The following defines the local-intake area of Mandurah High School—

From the entry of the Mandurah Estuary into the Indian Ocean, south along the Mandurah Estuary to the 'old' Mandurah Bridge, east along Pinjarra Road to the intersection with Fremantle Road, north along Fremantle Road to Gordon Road, east along Gordon Road to Lakes Road, north and east along Lakes Road to the Serpentine River, north along the Serpentine River to the boundary between the Shires of Murray and Rockingham, west along the Murray-Rockingham and Mandurah-Rockingham Shire boundaries to Mandurah Road, north along Mandurah Road to the locality boundary between Golden Bay and Secret Harbour, west along the Golden Bay-Secret Harbour locality boundary to the coast.

The boundary parts of Pinjarra Road (north side), Fremantle Road (west side), Gordon Road (north side), Lakes Road (north side), the Murray-Rockingham and Mandurah-Rockingham Shire boundaries (south side), Mandurah Road (west side) and the Golden Bay-Secret Harbour locality boundary (south side) are included within the local-intake area for Mandurah High School.

The following defines an optional area between Coodanup Community College and Mandurah High School—

From the intersection of Fremantle Road and Murdoch Drive east along Murdoch Drive to Bortolo Drive, north along Bortolo Drive to Exchequer Avenue, east along Exchequer Avenue to Lakes Road, north along Lakes Road to Gordon Road, west along Gordon Road to Fremantle Road and south along Fremantle Road to Murdoch Drive. The boundary parts of Murdoch Drive (north side), Bortolo Drive (west side), Exchequer Avenue (north side), Lakes Road (west side), Gordon Road (south side) and Fremantle Road (east side) are included within this optional area.

Children of secondary school age resident within the locality of Secret Harbour are entitled to attend either Mandurah High School or Warnbro Community High School.

MARGARET RIVER SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the traditional catchment areas of the following primary schools—

Augusta, Cowaramup, Karridale and Margaret River.

MELVILLE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake-areas of the following primary schools—

Attadale, Carawatha, Kardinya, Melville, Willagee and Winthrop.

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Canning Highway and Chesson Street, west along Canning Highway to North Lake Road, south along North Lake Road to Leach Highway, east along Leach Highway to Winthrop Drive, south along Winthrop Drive to Somerville Boulevard, east along Somerville Boulevard to Prescott Drive, south along Prescott Drive to South Street, west along South Street to Windelya Road, south along Windelya Road to Farrington Road, west along Farrington Road to North Lake Road, north along North Lake Road to South Street, west along South Street to Stock Road, north along Stock Road to the Swan River foreshore, east and south east along the foreshore to a point due north of the junction of Canning Highway and Chesson Street, south from this point on the foreshore to the junction of Canning Highway and Chesson Street.

The boundary parts of Canning Highway (north side), North Lake Road (northern section, west side), Leach Highway (south side), Winthrop Drive (west side), Somerville Boulevard (south side), South Street (north side), Windelya Road (both sides), Farrington Road (north side), North Lake Road (east side between Farrington Road and South Street), South Street (north side) and Stock Road (both sides) are included within the area for Melville Senior High School. Prescott Drive (both sides) is excluded from this area.

Students resident within the following area are entitled to attend either Applecross Senior High School or Melville Senior High School—

From the junction of Leach Highway and Winthrop Drive, south along Winthrop Drive to Somerville Boulevard, east along Somerville Boulevard to Prescott Drive, south along Prescott Drive to South Street, east along South Street to Murdoch Drive, north along Murdoch Drive to Leach Highway and west along Leach Highway to the junction with Winthrop Drive. The boundary parts of Leach Highway (south side), Winthrop Drive (east side), Somerville Boulevard (north side), Prescott Drive (both sides), South Street (north side) and Murdoch Drive (west side) are included within the above optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Hamilton and Melville Senior High Schools—

From the intersection of Farrington Road and North Lake Road, east along Farrington Road to Progress Drive, south along Progress Drive to the proposed Roe Highway, west along the proposed Roe Highway to North Lake Road, and north along North Lake Road to Farrington Road. The boundary parts of Farrington Road (south side), Progress Drive (both sides) and North Lake Road (east side) are included within this optional area.

MIRRABOOKA SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of Sutherland Dianella and Yokine Primary Schools, the traditional catchment areas of the following primary

schools—Mirrabooka, Mount Hawthorn, Nollamara, Osborne, Sutherland, Tuart Hill and Westminster, and the following exceptions.

Children from Osborne Primary School living in the area east of Main Street are entitled to attend either Mirrabooka Senior High School or Balcatta Senior High School. Children from Osborne Primary School living in Main Street (both sides) and west thereof are entitled to attend Balcatta Senior High School.

Children from Yokine Primary School living in Blythe Avenue and Woodrow Avenue (north side in each case) and north thereof are entitled to attend Mirrabooka Senior High School. Children from Yokine Primary School living in Blythe Avenue and Woodrow Avenue (south side in each case) and south thereof are entitled to attend Mount Lawley Senior High School.

The following defines an optional area between the Western Suburbs High Schools cluster and Mirrabooka Senior High School—

From the junction of the Mitchell Freeway and Scarborough Beach Road, east along Scarborough Beach Road to Green Street, east along Green Street to Wanneroo Road, north along Wanneroo Road to Roberts Street, west along Roberts Street to the Mitchell Freeway and south along the Mitchell Freeway to Scarborough Beach Road. The boundary parts of Scarborough Beach Road (north side), Green Street (north side) Wanneroo Road (west side) and the Mitchell Freeway (east side) are included within this optional area. Roberts Street (both sides) is excluded from this option area.

MORLEY SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Camboon, Dianella Heights, Morley, Noranda, North Morley and West Morley.

The following defines the local-intake area for Morley Senior High School—

From the intersection of Alexander Drive and Reid Highway, west along Reid Highway to Northwood Drive, south along Northwood Drive to Yirrigan Drive, south east along Yirrigan Drive to Dianella Drive, south along Dianella Drive to Morley Drive, east along Morley Drive to Light Street, south east along Light Street to Walter Road West, north east and east along Walter Road West to Charnwood Street, north along Charnwood Street and its extension to Morley Drive, east along Morley Drive to Crimea Street, north along Crimea Street and its extension to the Reid Highway, east along the Reid Highway to the Tonkin Highway, north along the proposed extension of the Tonkin Highway to Marshall Road, west along Marshall Road to Beach Road, north west along Beach Road to Alexander Drive and south along Alexander Drive to the Reid Highway. The boundary parts of Reid Highway (west section) (south side), Northwood Drive (east side), Yirrigan Drive (north side), Dianella Drive (east side), Morley Drive (north side), Light Street (both sides), Walter Road West (both sides), Charnwood Street (both sides), Morley Drive (both sides), Crimea Street (west side), Reid Highway (east section) (north side), Tonkin Highway (west side), Marshall Road (south side), Beach Road (south side) and Alexander Drive (east side) are included within the local-intake area of Morley Senior High School.

MOUNT LAWLEY SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—Inglewood, Mount Lawley, Maylands and Yokine, and all or part of the traditional catchment areas of Coolbinia, Highgate Kyilla and North Perth.

The following defines the local-intake area for the Mount Lawley Senior High School—

From the junction of Wanneroo Road and Wiluna Street, north-east along Wiluna Street to Flinders Street, north along Flinders Street to Blythe Avenue, east along Blythe Avenue and Woodrow Avenue to Cresswell Road, south-east along Cresswell Road, Homer Street, Dundas Road, Eleventh Avenue and Kennedy Street to the railway line, south-west along the railway line to Caledonian Avenue, south-east along Caledonian Avenue to Mephan Street, south-west along Mephan Street to Joseph Street, south along Joseph Street to Peninsula Road, east along Peninsula Road to Foggerthorpe Crescent, south along Foggerthorpe Crescent and its extension to the Swan River foreshore, west and south-west along the Swan River foreshore to Summers Street, west along Summers Street to the junction with Lord Street and Bulwer Street, north-west along Bulwer Street to Vincent Street, west along Vincent Street to Charles Street, north and north-west along Charles Street to the junction with Walcott Street and Wanneroo Road, and north-west along Wanneroo Road to Wiluna Street. The boundary parts of Wiluna Street (south-east side), Flinders Street (both sides), Woodrow Avenue (south side), Cresswell Road (south-west side) and Vincent Street (both sides), and the boundary streets of Blythe Avenue (south side), Homer Street (south-west side), Dundas Road (both sides), Eleventh Avenue (both sides), Kennedy Street (both sides), Caledonian Avenue (south-west side), Mephan Street (west side) and Joseph Street (west side) are included within the area for Mount Lawley Senior High School, while the boundary parts of Peninsula Road, Foggerthorpe Crescent, Summers Street and Charles Street (both sides in each case), and the boundary street of Bulwer Street (both sides) are excluded from the area for Mount Lawley Senior High School.

NEWTON MOORE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Adam Road, Carey Park, South Bunbury and Withers; the traditional catchment area of Capel Primary School, and the following exceptions.

The following defines a boundary between Bunbury Senior High School and Newton Moore Senior High School—

From the confluence of the Preston River with the Ferguson River, north west and west along the Preston River to the railway bridge, west and north west along the railway line to the intersection of the railway line and Forrest Avenue, west and north west along Forrest Avenue to Wisbey Street, south west along Wisbey Street to Yorla Road, north west along Yorla Road to Clarke Street East, west along Clarke Street East to Clarke Street, west along Clarke Street to Hoylake Avenue and north west and west along Hoylake Avenue and its extension to the Indian Ocean.

Children from Carey Park Primary School living in the area north of (but not including) the above boundary are entitled to attend either Bunbury Senior High School or Newton Moore Senior High School. Children from Carey Park Primary School living in Hoylake Avenue, Clarke Street and Clarke Street East (both sides in all cases) and the boundary parts of Yorla Road, Wisbey Street and Forrest Avenue (both sides in all cases), and south of the boundary are entitled to attend Newton Moore Senior High School.

Children from South Bunbury Primary School living in the area north of (but not including) the above boundary are entitled to attend Bunbury Senior High School. Children from South Bunbury Primary School living in Hoylake Avenue, Clarke Street and Clarke Street East (both sides in all cases) and the boundary parts of Yorla Road, Wisbey Street and Forrest Avenue (both sides in all cases), and south of the boundary are entitled to attend Newton Moore Senior High School.

NORTH ALBANY SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Little Grove, Mount Lockyer and Yakamia; and the following boundary.

The following defines a boundary between Albany and North Albany Senior High Schools—

From Princess Royal harbour at the locality boundary between Mount Elphinstone and Mount Melville, generally north along the locality boundary to Cuming Road, north east from Cuming Road to the intersection of Lion Street and Serpentine Road, south east along Serpentine Road to Wellington Street, north east along Wellington Street to the intersection with Pioneer Road, north north east from this intersection along the boundary of the recreation area to the intersection of North Road and Barnesby Drive, south east along North Road to Range Road and north along Range Road to Bond Road. This boundary parts of Serpentine Road (both sides), Wellington Street (both sides), Pioneer Road (both sides), North road (both sides) and Range Road (both sides) are included within the area for North Albany Senior High School and excluded from the area for Albany Senior High School.

The following defines an optional area between Denmark High School and North Albany Senior High School—

From the Southern Ocean, north east along Tennessee South Road to Lower Denmark Road, north west along Lower Denmark Road to Eden Road, west along Eden Road to Two Bob Hill, and south west from Two Bob Hill to the Southern Ocean. The boundary parts of Tennessee South Road (both sides), Lower Denmark Road (both sides) and Eden Road (both sides) are included within the optional area.

NORTHAM SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of Northam and West Northam Primary Schools and the traditional catchment areas of the following primary schools—Avonvale, Bakers Hill, Goomalling, Meckering and West Northam.

OCEAN REEF SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Beamaris, Connolly, Currambine, Mullaloo Beach, Mullaloo Heights, Ocean Reef and Poseidon; and the following boundary.

Children living in the following area are entitled to attend Ocean Reef Senior High School—

From the intersection of Hodges Drive and Country Club Boulevard, north along Country Club Boulevard and continuing north to the golf course underpass at Shenton Avenue, west from the underpass to Marmion Avenue, north along Marmion Avenue to Burns Beach Road, west along Burns Beach Road to the coastline, south along the coastline to Hodges Drive and east along Hodges Drive to Country Club Boulevard.

The boundary parts of Country Club Boulevard (west side), Shenton Avenue (south side), Marmion Avenue (west side) and Burns Beach Road (south side) are included within this area. The boundary parts of Country Club Boulevard (east side), Shenton Avenue (north side), Marmion Avenue (east side) and Burns Beach Road (north side) are excluded from this area.

The following defines a boundary for an optional area between Beldridge Senior High School and Ocean Reef Senior High School—

From the intersection of Shenton Avenue and Marmion Avenue, north along Marmion Avenue to Burns Beach Road, east along Burns Beach Road to Connolly Drive, south along Connolly Drive to Shenton Avenue, and west along Shenton Avenue to Marmion Avenue. The boundary parts of Marmion Avenue (east side), Burns Beach road (south side), Connolly Drive (west side) and Shenton Avenue (north side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines a boundary for an optional area between Craigie Senior High School and Ocean Reef Senior High School—

From the Indian Ocean south of the east-west alignment of Merrifield Place, due east to Northshore Drive, north along Northshore Drive to Mullaloo Drive, in a general easterly direction along Mullaloo Drive to Kallaroo Place, east along Kallaroo Place to Marmion Avenue, north along Marmion Avenue to Ocean Reef Road, west along Ocean Reef Road to the junction with Oceanside Promenade, and due west to the Indian Ocean. The boundary part of Merrifield Place (both sides), Northshore Drive (west side), Mullaloo Drive (north side), Marmion Avenue (west side), Ocean Reef Road (south side) and the boundary street of Kallaroo Place (north side), are included within the optional area.

PADBURY SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Bambara, Lymburner, Padbury and South Padbury; and the following exception.

Children from Lymburner Primary School living in the following area are entitled to attend Padbury Senior High School—

From the intersection of Cook Avenue and Marmion Avenue, west along Cook Avenue to Wild Road, south along Wild Road to David Crescent, west along David Crescent to Mawson Crescent, south along Mawson Crescent to Flinders Avenue, west along Flinders Avenue to Whitfords Avenue, south along Whitfords Avenue to Hepburn Avenue, east along Hepburn Avenue to Marmion Avenue, and north along Marmion Avenue to Cook Avenue. The boundary parts of Wild Road (both sides), David Crescent (both sides), Mawson Crescent (both sides), Flinders Avenue (both sides), Whitfords Avenue (east side), Hepburn Avenue (north side), and Marmion Avenue (west side) are included within this area. The boundary part of Cook Avenue is excluded from this area.

PERTH MODERN SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

Perth Modern Senior High School is part of the Western Suburbs Secondary School Cluster. The local-intake area for the Western Suburbs Secondary School Cluster is described in the Carine Senior High School local area intake notice.

PINJARRA SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the traditional catchment areas of the following primary schools—

Carcoola, Dwellingup, North Dandalup and Pinjarra; and the following boundaries.

The following defines a boundary between Pinjarra Senior High School and Coodanup Senior High School—

From the Peel Inlet, north along the Serpentine River to Goegrup Lake, north across Goegrup Lake to the intersection of Lakes Road and the Serpentine River. Children living in the area to the east of this boundary are entitled to attend Pinjarra Senior High School. Children living in the area to the west of this boundary are entitled to attend Coodanup Senior High School.

The following defines a boundary between Mandurah Senior High School and Pinjarra Senior High School—

From the intersection of Lakes Road and the Serpentine River, and north along the Serpentine River to the boundary between the Shires of Murray and Rockingham. Children living in the area to the east of this boundary are entitled to attend Pinjarra Senior High School. Children living in the area to the west of this boundary are entitled to attend Mandurah Senior High School.

ROCKINGHAM SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area of Rockingham Senior High School contains the following primary schools—

Bungaree, Charthouse, Coo loongup, East Waikiki, Hillman, Rockingham Beach and Safety Bay.

The following defines a boundary for Rockingham Senior High School—

From the coastline, east along Boundary Road to the proposed Garden Island Highway, south east and east along the proposed Garden Island Highway to Rae Road, east and north east along Rae Road to Ennis Avenue, south east along Ennis Avenue to the boundary between the localities of Coo loongup and Waikiki, south east along this locality boundary to Mandurah Road, north along Mandurah Road to the intersection with Millar Road and the local government boundary between the Town of Kwinana and the City of Rockingham, north and west along this local government boundary to the coastline. The boundary parts of Rae Road (north side), Ennis Avenue (east side) and Mandurah Road (west side) are included within the local-intake area of Rockingham Senior High School.

All students resident within the local-intake area of Safety Bay Senior High School are entitled to attend either Rockingham Senior High School or Safety Bay Senior High School.

ROSSMOYNE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Bateman, Brentwood, Bull Creek, Oberthur, Riverton, Shelley and Willetton., and the traditional catchment area of Rossmoyne Primary School.

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Leach Highway and Murdoch Drive, east along Leach Highway to the junction with Bull Creek Drive, north from this junction through Bateman Park to the foreshore of Bull Creek, east and north along the eastern foreshore of Bull Creek, and continuing north east and east along the foreshore of the Canning River to the northern extension of Duff Road, south along this extension and Duff Road to High Road, west along High Road to Augusta Street, south along Augusta Street to Acanthus Road, west along Acanthus Road to Darvell Road, south along Darvell Road to Rhonda Avenue, west along Rhonda Avenue to the northern extension of Donald Street, south along this extension and Donald Street to Apsley Road, west along Apsley Road to Eagles Walk, south along the north-south alignment of Eagles Walk and its extension to Flamingo Way, south along the north-south alignment of Flamingo Way and its extension to Albatross Pass, west along Albatross Pass and its extension between Wren Close and Cormorant Cross, and continuing north east between Brolga Promenade and both The Taffrail and The Quarterdeck to the junction of The Quarterdeck and The Escarpment, west from this junction to Karel Avenue, south along Karel Avenue to Parry Avenue, west along Parry Avenue to Murdoch Drive, and north along Murdoch Drive to Leach Highway.

The boundary parts of Leach Highway (south side), Duff Road (both sides), High Road (north side), Augusta Street (both sides), Acanthus Road (both sides), Darvell Road (both sides), Donald Street (both sides), Eagles Walk (both sides), Flamingo Way (both sides), Wren Close (both sides), Brolga Promenade (both sides), Karel Avenue (west side), Parry Avenue (north side) and Murdoch Drive (east side) are included in the above local-intake area. Albatross Pass (both sides), Cormorant Cross (both sides), The Taffrail (both sides) and The Quarterdeck (both sides) are excluded from this area.

Students resident within the following area have the entitlement of attending either Rossmoyne Senior High School or Leeming Senior High School—

From the junction of Murdoch Drive and Parry Avenue, east along Parry Avenue to the Kwinana Freeway, south along the Kwinana Freeway to the northern arm of the loop forming Scandrett Way, west along the northern arm of Scandrett Way to Broadhurst Crescent, north along Broadhurst Crescent to Marsengo Road, west along Marsengo Road to Murdoch Drive and north along Murdoch Drive to Parry Avenue. The boundary parts of Parry Avenue (south side), Kwinana Freeway (west side), northern arm of Scandrett Way (north side), Broadhurst Crescent (east side), Marsengo Road (north side) and Murdoch (east side) are included within this optional area.

Students resident within the following area have the entitlement of attending either Applecross Senior High School or Rossmoyne Senior High School—

From the junction of Leach Highway and Riseley Street, north along Riseley Street to Karoonda Road, east along Karoonda Road to Canning Avenue, north east along Canning Avenue and its extension to the Canning River foreshore, south along the Canning River and Bull Creek foreshores to Bateman Park, south through Bateman Park to the junction of Leach Highway and Bull Creek Drive, west along Leach Highway to the junction with Riseley Street.

The boundary parts of Riseley Street (east side) and Leach Highway (north side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Karoonda Road (both sides) and Canning Avenue (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

Secondary students who reside south of High Road in the local-intake area of Riverton Primary School, and who were enrolled at Riverton Primary School for at least the whole of Semester 2 whilst in Year 7 at that school, are entitled to attend Rossmoyne Senior High School. This provision will be reviewed during 2001.

Students resident within the former local-intake area for Kewdale Senior High School are entitled to attend Rossmoyne Senior High School. This area is described in the Belmont City College local-intake area notice.

SAFETY BAY SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Charthouse, Cooloongup, East Waikiki and Safety Bay.

The following defines a local-intake area for Safety Bay Senior High School—

From the coastline, east along Boundary Road to the proposed Garden Island Highway, south east and east along the proposed Garden Island Highway to Rae Road, east and north east along Rae Road to Ennis Avenue, south east along Ennis Avenue to Wilmott Drive, west along Wilmott Drive to Gngangara Drive, south west along Gngangara Drive to Read Street, south along Read Street to Rand Avenue, south west along Rand Avenue to Safety Bay Road, south east along Safety Bay Road to Hilda Road, west along Hilda Road and its extension to the coastline. The boundary parts of Boundary Road (both sides), Rae Road (south side), Ennis Avenue (west side), Wilmott Drive (north side), Gngangara Drive (north side), Read Street (west side), Rand Avenue (north side) and Safety Bay Road (west side) are included within the catchment of Safety Bay Senior High School. The boundary street of Hilda Road (both sides) is excluded from the catchment area of Safety Bay Senior High School.

All students resident in the above area are entitled to attend either Rockingham Senior High School or Safety Bay Senior High School.

SHENTON COLLEGE

The following defines the local-intake area for Shenton College—

From the Old Brewery on the Swan River, north west through Kings Park to the junction of Thomas Street and Nicholson Road, west along Nicholson Road to Rokeby Road, north along Rokeby Road to Roberts Road, north across the railway line to the southern end of Station Street (southern section), north along Station Street (southern section), to Salvado Road, west along Salvado Road to Station Street (northern section), north along Station Street (northern section) to Cambridge Street, west along Cambridge Street and its extension into Oceanic Drive to West Coast Highway, south along West Coast Highway to the junction of West Coast Highway and Rochdale Road, west from this junction to the coastline, south along the coastline to the local government boundary between Town of Mosman Park and the City of Fremantle, east along this local government boundary to the Swan River foreshore, in a generally northerly and easterly direction along the Swan River foreshore to the Old Brewery.

The boundary parts of Nicholson Road (south side), Rokeby Road (west side), Station Street (southern and northern sections, west side), Salvado Road (south side), Cambridge Street (south side), Oceanic Drive (south side) and West Coast Highway (east side) are included within the local-intake area for Shenton College.

SOUTH FREMANTLE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—Beaconsfield, Samson, White Gum Valley and Winterfold; the traditional catchment areas of Hilton and Fremantle Primary Schools and the following exceptions.

Children from Winterfold Primary School living in Healy Road (both sides) and north thereof are entitled to attend South Fremantle Senior High School. Children from Winterfold Primary School living in the area south of Healy Road have the entitlement of attending either South Fremantle Senior High School or Hamilton Senior High School.

The following defines an optional area between Hamilton and South Fremantle Senior High Schools—

From the intersection of Stock Road and Winterfold Road, east along Winterfold Road and continuing into Torquil Road to North Lake Road, north along North Lake Road to South Street, west along South Street to Stock Road and south along Stock Road to Winterfold Road. The boundary parts of Winterfold Road (north side), Torquil Road (north side), North Lake Road (west side), South Street (south side) and Stock Road (east side) are included within this optional area.

SWAN VIEW SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Darlington, Glen Forrest, Helena Valley, Middle Swan and Swan View; the traditional catchment areas of Bellevue, Greenmount, Koongamia and Midvale, and the following boundary and exceptions.

The following defines a northern and western boundary for Swan View Senior High School—

From the bridge carrying Toodyay Road over Jane Brook, south-west along Toodyay Road to the Roe Highway, south along the Roe Highway to Great Eastern Highway, west along Great Eastern Highway to Lloyd Street, south along Lloyd Street to Clayton Street, south along Clayton Street to Military Road and south along Military Road to Bushmead Road. The boundary parts of Toodyay Road (south side), Roe Freeway (east side), Great Eastern Highway (south side) and Military Road (both sides) are included within the area for Swan View Senior High School. The boundary parts of Toodyay Road (north side), Roe Highway (west side), Great Eastern Highway (north side) and Lloyd Avenue (both sides) are excluded from the area for Swan View Senior High School.

Children from Middle Swan and Midvale Primary Schools living in the area east of the above boundary are entitled to attend Swan View Senior High School. Children from Middle Swan Primary School living in the area west of the above boundary are entitled to attend Governor Stirling Senior High School.

Children resident in the local-intake area of Darlington Primary School are entitled to attend either Swan View Senior High School, Eastern Hills Senior High School or Kalamunda Senior High School.

Children resident in the local-intake area of Glen Forrest Primary School are entitled to attend either Swan View Senior High School, Eastern Hills Senior High School or Kalamunda Senior High School.

The following defines the boundary for an optional area between Governor Stirling Senior High School and Swan View Senior High School—

From the intersection of Great Eastern Highway and Roe Highway, west along Great Eastern Highway to Bushby Street, north along Bushby Street and its extension northwards along the locality boundary to Eddie Barron Drive, east along the locality boundary between Middle Swan and Midvale to the Roe Highway, south along the Roe Highway to Great Eastern Highway. The boundary parts of Great Eastern Highway (both sides), Bushby Street (both sides) and Roe Highway (west side) are included within this optional area.

THORNLIE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—

Canning Vale, East Kenwick, Forest Crescent, Ranford and South Thornlie, and the traditional catchment areas of Thornlie and Yale Primary Schools.

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Nicholson Road and the railway line, north east along the railway line to Albany Highway, south east along Albany Highway to Austin Avenue, south west along the locality boundary between Kenwick and Maddington to the Canning River, generally south along the Canning River to the confluence of the Canning River and the Southern River, south along the Southern River to Corfield Street, north east along Corfield Street to Warton Road, south west along Warton Road to Nicholson Road, north along Nicholson Road to Acourt Road, north west along Acourt Road to Johnston Road, north along Johnston Road to Clifton Road, north west along the proposed Clifton Road to the south westerly extension of Bannister Road, north east along Bannister Road to Nicholson Road, and south east along Nicholson Road to the railway line.

The boundary parts of Albany Highway (south west side), Corfield Street (north side), Warton Road (north west side), Acourt Road (both sides), Johnston Road (both sides), proposed Clifton Road (both sides), Bannister Road (south side) and Nicholson Road (south west side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

The following is an optional area between Lynwood Senior High School and Thornlie Senior High School—

From the intersection of the Canning River and the railway line, south west along the railway line to Cameron Street, north west along Cameron Street to the proposed Roe Highway, north east along the proposed Roe Highway to the Canning River, and generally south east along the Canning River to the railway line.

The boundary parts of Cameron Street (both sides) and the proposed Roe Highway (south east side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

The following defines the boundary of an optional area between Gosnells Senior High School and Thornlie Senior High School:

From the junction of Ranford Road and Southern River Road, north east along Southern River Road to Gay Street, north west along Gay Street and its extension to Warton Road, south west along Warton Road to Ranford Road and south east along Ranford Road to Southern River Road.

The boundary parts of Southern River Road (both sides), Gay Street (both sides) and Warton Road (south side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Ranford Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

Students resident within the former catchment area for Kewdale Senior High School are entitled to attend Thornlie Senior High School. This area is described in the Belmont City College local-intake notice.

WANNEROO SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains the following primary schools—East Wanneroo, Landsdale, Neerabup and Wanneroo, and Yanchep District High School.

The following defines a boundary for Wanneroo Senior High School—

From the intersection of Flynn Drive and Pinjar Road, west along Flynn Drive to Wanneroo Road, west south west to the proposed Mitchell Freeway at the intersection of the localities of Clarkson and Tamala Park, south along the proposed Mitchell Freeway to Burns Beach Road, east along Burns Beach Road and east along Joondalup Drive to the locality boundary between Joondalup and Wanneroo, south along the locality boundary between Joondalup and Wanneroo and continuing along the western shore of Lake Joondalup to Ocean Reef Road, east along Ocean Reef Road to Wanneroo Road, south along Wanneroo Road to Hepburn Avenue, east along Hepburn Avenue and the proposed Hepburn Avenue to the intersection with Alexander Drive and north along Alexander Drive to Gnangara Road.

The boundary parts of Flynn Drive (south side), Burns Beach Road (north side), Ocean Reef Road (north side), Joondalup Drive (north side), Wanneroo Road (east side), Hepburn Avenue (north side) and Alexander Drive (west side) are included within the area for Wanneroo Senior High School.

The following defines an optional area between Wanneroo Senior High School and Yanchep District High School—

The localities of Eglinton, Two Rocks and Yanchep, and the area of the locality of Carabooda located to the north of the following boundary: from the intersection of the locality boundaries of Alkimos, Carabooda and Eglinton, north east across Wanneroo Road to 476 Old Yanchep Road (as shown on Map 8 in the 1998 Streetsmart street directory).

The following defines an optional area between Clarkson Community High School and Wanneroo Senior High School—

From 476 Old Yanchep Road (as shown on Map 8 in the 1998 Streetsmart street directory), in a south westerly direction towards the intersection of the locality boundaries of Alkimos, Carabooda and Eglinton, south east along the locality boundary between Alkimos and Carabooda to the proposed Mitchell Freeway, south east along the proposed Mitchell Freeway to the locality boundary between Clarkson and Tamala Park, east north east from this point to the intersection

of Wanneroo Road and Flynn Drive and north, north east and east along Flynn Drive to Pinjar Road. The boundary parts of Flynn Drive (north side) are included within this optional area.

WARNBRO COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains the following primary schools—Charthouse, Endeavour, Koorana, Port Kennedy, Secret Harbour and Warnbro.

The following defines the local-intake area for Warnbro Community High School—

From the coastline, east along Hilda Road to Safety Bay Road, north west along Safety Bay Road to Rand Avenue, north east along Rand Avenue to Read Street, north along Read Street to Gnangara Drive, north east along Gnangara Drive to Willmott Drive, east along Willmott Drive to Ennis Avenue, south along Ennis Avenue to Mandurah Road, south along Mandurah Road to the boundary between the localities of Port Kennedy and Secret Harbour, and west along this locality boundary to the coastline. The boundary parts of Hilda Road (both sides), Safety Bay Road (east side), Rand Avenue (south side), Read Street (east side), Gnangara Drive (south side), Willmott Drive (south side), Ennis Avenue (west side) and Mandurah Road (west side) are included within the catchment area for Warnbro Community High School. The boundary parts of Safety Bay Road (west side), Rand Avenue (north side), Read Street (west side), Gnangara Drive (north side), Willmott Drive (north side), Ennis Avenue (east side) and Mandurah Road (east side) are excluded from the catchment area for Warnbro Community High School.

Children of secondary school age resident within the locality of Secret Harbour are entitled to attend either

Mandurah Senior High School or Warnbro Community High School.

WARWICK SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—Allenswood, East Greenwood, East Hamersley, Glendale and Hawker Park.

WILLETTON SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—Bull Creek, Burrendah, Oberthur, Riverton, Rostrata and Willetton.

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of High Road and Augusta Street, south along Augusta Street to Acanthus Road, west along Acanthus Road to Darvell Road, south along Darvell Road to Rhonda Avenue, west along Rhonda Avenue to the northern extension of Donald Street, south along this extension and Donald Street to Apsley Road, west along Apsley Road to Eagles Walk, south along the north-south alignment of Eagles Walk and its extension to Flamingo Way, south along the north-south alignment of Flamingo Way and its extension to Albatross Pass, west along Albatross Pass and its extension between Wren Close and Cormorant Cross, and continuing north east between Brolga Promenade and both The Taffrail and The Quarterdeck to the junction of The Quarterdeck and The Escarpment, west from this junction to Karel Avenue, south along Karel Avenue to Parry Avenue, west along Parry Avenue to Wheatley Drive, south along Wheatley Drive to the southern arm of Oberthur Crescent, east between Oberthur Crescent and Weeks Way to the walkway linking Weeks Way and Anstie Way, east along this walkway to Anstie Way, north then east along the northern part of Anstie Way to Hetherington Drive, north-east along Hetherington Drive to Owgan Place, south-east along Owgan Place to Karel Avenue, south along Karel Avenue to South Street, east along South Street to the proposed Roe Highway, north east along the proposed Roe Highway to Willeri Drive, north along Willeri Drive to High Road and west along High Road to Augusta Street.

The boundary parts of Albatross Pass (both sides), Cormorant Cross (both sides), The Taffrail (both sides), The Quarterdeck (both sides), Karel Avenue (east side for both northern and southern sections), Parry Avenue (south side), Wheatley Drive (between Vagg Street and Oberthur Crescent, both sides), Oberthur Crescent (both sides), Hetherington Drive (both sides), South Street (north side), Willeri Drive (west side) and High Road (south side) are included in this local-intake area. The boundary parts of Augusta Street (both sides), Acanthus Road (western section, both sides), Darvell Road (both sides), Donald Street (both sides), Eagles Walk (both sides), Flamingo Way (both sides), Wren Close (both sides), Brolga Promenade (both sides) and Wheatley Drive (between Parry Avenue and Vagg Street, both sides) are excluded from this local-intake area.

The following defines an optional area between Leeming Senior High School and Willetton Senior High School—

From the junction of South Street and Wheatley Drive, north along Wheatley Drive to the southern arm of Oberthur Crescent, east between Oberthur Crescent and Weeks Way to the walkway linking Weeks Way and Anstie Way, east along this walkway to Anstie Way, north then east along the northern part of Anstie Way to Hetherington Drive, north-east along Hetherington Drive to Owgan Place, south-east along Owgan Place to Karel Avenue, south along Karel Avenue to South Street and west along South Street to Wheatley Drive. The boundary parts of Wheatley Drive, Anstie Way, Owgan Place (both sides in all cases), Karel Avenue (west side) and South Street (north side) are included within this optional area, whilst the boundary parts of Hetherington Drive (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Willetton Senior High School and Leeming Senior High School—

From the intersection of Parry Avenue and the Kwinana Freeway, south along the Kwinana Freeway to a point opposite the western extension of Windich Road, in an easterly direction to

and along Windich Road and its eastward extension to Benningfield Road, south along Benningfield Road to Henry Bull Drive, east then south-east along Henry Bull Drive to James Street, east along James Street to Hardy Street, south-east along Hardy Street to Darley Circle, south-east along Darley Circle to More Crescent, north-east along More Crescent to Back Close, east along Back Close and the walkway linking Back Close and Darley Circle, south along Darley Circle to Vagg Street, east along Vagg Street to Wheatley Drive, north along Wheatley Drive to Parry Avenue and west along Parry Avenue to the Kwinana Freeway. The boundary parts of Parry Avenue (south side), Wheatley Drive (both sides) and the Kwinana Freeway (east side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts (both sides) of all other streets are excluded from this optional area.

Students resident within the former local-intake area for Kewdale Senior High School are entitled to attend Willetton Senior High School. This area is described in the Belmont City College local-intake area notice.

WOODVALE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools—Creaney, Halidon, North Woodvale and Woodvale.

YANCHEP DISTRICT HIGH SCHOOL

The following defines an optional area between Wanneroo Senior High School and Yanchep District High School—

The localities of Eglinton, Two Rocks and Yanchep, and the area of the locality of Carabooda located to the north of the following boundary: from the intersection of the locality boundaries of Alkimos, Carabooda and Eglinton, north east across Wanneroo Road to 476 Old Yanchep Road (as shown on Map 8 in the 1998 Streetsmart street directory).
