PROHIBITION ON FISHING (LANCELIN ISLAND LAGOON) ORDER 2001

Order No. 1 of 2001

FD 1620/98 [404] Made by the Minister under section 43.

Citation

1. This order may be cited as the Prohibition on Fishing (Lancelin Island Lagoon) Order 2001.

Prohibition on fishing

2. A person must not fish for any purpose in the waters described in the Schedule.

Schedule

All those waters bounded by a line commencing at the high water mark of the southernmost point of Lancelin Island; thence extending generally west and then northerly along the seaward edge of the subtidal reef platform to a point due west of the northernmost point of Lancelin Island; thence east along the geodesic to the high water mark of the northernmost point of Lancelin Island; thence generally southerly along the high water mark on the western side of Lancelin Island to the commencement point.

FISH RESOURCES MANAGEMENT ACT 1994

LANCELIN ISLAND LAGOON FISH HABITAT PROTECTION AREA ORDER 2001

FD 981/99

Made by the Minister under section 115 of the Act.

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Lancelin Island Lagoon Fish Habitat Protection Area Order 2001.

Definitions

2. In this Order "waters of the Lancelin Island Lagoon" means all those waters bounded by a line commencing at the low water mark of the southernmost point of Lancelin Island; thence extending generally west and then northerly along the seaward edge of the subtidal reef platform to a point due west of the northernmost point of Lancelin Island; thence east along the geodesic to the low water mark of the northernmost point of Lancelin Island; thence generally southerly along the low water mark on the western side of Lancelin Island to the commencement point.

Area of WA waters set aside as fish habitat protection area

3. The waters of the Lancelin Island Lagoon are set aside as a fish habitat protection area.

Purposes for which area is set aside

4. The purposes for which the waters of the Lancelin Island Lagoon are set aside as a fish habitat protection area are the—

(a) conservation and protection of fish, fish breeding areas, fish fossils and the aquatic eco-system; and

(b) management of fish and activities relating to the appreciation and observation of fish. Dated this 15th day of March 2001.

SHARK BAY PRAWN MANAGEMENT PLAN 1993

Clause 10 closure of areas within the Fishery

I, Peter Rogers, Executive Director of Fisheries Western Australia, in accordance with the *Shark Bay Prawn Management Plan 1993* hereby give notice that I have cancelled *Determination No. 1 of 2001* which set out the dates and times that fishing is prohibited in the Shark Bay Prawn Managed Fishery.

I hereby give notice that a new determination (*Determination No. 2 of 2001*) has been made in accordance with clause 10 of the *Shark Bay Prawn Management Plan 1993* of the times and dates that fishing is prohibited in the Shark Bay Prawn Managed Fishery during the period commencing from the date of gazettal of this notice and ending on 1 April 2002.

HOUSING ACT 1980

DETERMINATION OF STANDARD RATES OF INTEREST

Ministry of Housing (The State Housing Commission),

Perth 14 March 2001.

Pursuant to Sections 33 and 42 being loans under Section 36 of the Housing Act 1980, The State Housing Commission by this determination which was approved by the Honourable Minister for Housing fixes the following maximum standard rates of interest to apply in respect of the various classes of loan granted by it.

- 1. Keystart Loans, Income Based Loans, pre 1985 Variable Interest Schemes and Wisechoice under Sections 33 and 36 to 7.50% per annum.
- 2. In respect of Shared Equity 1994 (Real Start) (Subsidised Rate) Loans the standard rate of interest shall be 6.5% per annum rising by 1.0% per annum on every June 30 subsequent to the date from which interest is to be calculated until the rate of interest is 7.50% per annum.
- 3. In respect of Shared Equity 1994 (Aboriginal) (Subsidised Rate) Loans the standard rate of interest shall be 6.5% per annum rising 0.5% per annum on every June 30 subsequent to the date from which interest is to be calculated until the rate of interest is 7.50% per annum.
- 4. In respect of Shared Equity 1994 (Access) (Subsidised Rate) Loans the standard rate of interest shall be 6.5% per annum rising 0.5% per annum on every June 30 subsequent to the date from which interest is to be calculated until the rate of interest is 7.50% per annum.
- 5. In respect of Shared Equity 1994 (Real Start) (Unsubsidised Rate) Loans the standard rate of interest shall be 7.50% per annum.
- 6. In respect of Shared Equity 1997 (GoodStart) (Subsidised Rate) Loans the standard rate of interest shall be 6.5% fixed per annum, until the borrowers' income exceeds Homeswest's maximum rental income eligibility limits. The rate will then move to the Commonwealth Bank standard home loan variable interest rate subject to a minimum interest rate of 6.5% per annum.

This determination shall take effect from March 1, 2001.
