Alteration of Statutory Designations Act 1974

## Alteration of Statutory Designations Amendment Order 2001

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

#### 1. Citation

This order may be cited as the *Alteration of Statutory Designations Amendment Order 2001.* 

#### 2. Amendment of *Alteration of Statutory Designations Order (No. 2) 2001*

After clause 2(2) of the *Alteration of Statutory Designations Order (No. 2) 2001* the following subclause is inserted —

- (3) Without limiting subclause (1) and despite anything in subclause (2), a reference to a department of the Public Service is to be read and construed in accordance with subclause (1) even where it is a reference in a contract or agreement (including an industrial agreement within the meaning of the *Industrial Relations Act 1979* or a workplace agreement within the meaning of the *Workplace Agreements Act 1993*) to a department that has been abolished or that has been amalgamated with one or more other departments.

".

## Alteration of Statutory Designations Order (No. 3) 2001

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

#### 1. Citation

This order may be cited as the *Alteration of Statutory Designations Order (No. 3) 2001.* 

#### 2. References to departments altered

- (1) Subject to subclause (2), it is directed that a reference contained in
  - (a) any law; or
  - (b) any instrument, contract or legal proceedings made or commenced before the coming into operation of this order,

to a department of the Public Service with a designation set out in Column 1 of an item in Schedule 1 is to be read and construed as a reference to the department of the Public Service with the designation set out in Column 2 of that item.

- (2) A reference is not to be read and construed in accordance with subclause (1) if
  - (a) the contrary intention appears in the law, instrument, contract or legal proceedings containing the reference; or
  - (b) the context of the reference otherwise requires.
- (3) Without limiting subclause (1) and despite anything in subclause (2), a reference to a department of the Public Service is to be read and construed in accordance with subclause (1) even where it is a reference in a contract or agreement (including an industrial agreement within the meaning of the *Industrial Relations Act 1979* or a workplace agreement within the meaning of the *Workplace Agreements Act 1993*) to a department that has been abolished or that has been amalgamated with one or more other departments.

#### 3. Repeal of previous orders

The orders set out in Schedule 2 are repealed.
