Electricity Act 1945

Electricity (Energy Efficiency and Labelling) Notice 2001

Made by the Director of Energy Safety under the *Electricity Regulations 1947*.

1. Citation

This notice may be cited as the *Electricity (Energy Efficiency and Labelling) Notice 2001*.

2. Commencement

This notice comes into operation on the day on which it is published in the *Gazette*.

3. Meaning of “domestic”

For the purpose of this notice an apparatus or installation is “domestic” if it is primarily intended for domestic use.

4. Apparatus and installations which are subject to energy efficiency labelling regulations

The following apparatus and installations are subject to Part II of the *Electricity Regulations 1947* —

- (a) domestic rotary clothes dryers;
- (b) domestic clothes washing machines;
- (c) domestic refrigerators;
- (d) domestic dishwashers;
- (e) domestic room air-conditioners that —
 - (i) are refrigerative and have a single refrigeration circuit with one evaporator and one condenser;
 - (ii) have a rated cooling capacity of less than 7.5kW;
 - (iii) are not ducted systems; and
 - (iv) are designed for connection to low voltage single-phase supply.

5. Apparatus and installations which are subject to minimum energy efficiency standards

The following apparatus and installations are subject to Part III of the *Electricity Regulations 1947* —

- (a) domestic refrigerators;
- (b) domestic storage water heaters that —
 - (i) are un-vented displacement storage systems;
 - (ii) have tubular-sheathed immersion or bobbin type heating units; and
 - (iii) have a rated hot water delivery of between 25 and 630 litres (both inclusive) as measured in accordance with Australian Standards “Storage water heaters — Part 1: General Requirements” AS1056 — 1991;
- (c) three-phase air conditioners and heat pump systems that have a cooling capacity of up to 65kW;
- (d) three-phase electric motors that are rated from 0.72kW to 185kW (both inclusive).

6. Minimum energy efficiency laws

The laws set out in the Table to this clause are specified for the purposes of regulation 10 of the *Electricity Regulations 1947*.

1. This Order may be cited as the *Retail Trading Hours (Townsite of Northam) Amendment Order 2001*.

Amendments

2. The Retail Trading Hours (Townsite of Northam) Exemption Order 2000 [*Published in the Gazette of 8 September 2000 at p 5195*] is amended at Part 5 by deleting—

“on 17 December 2000 and 24 December 2000 provided the shop is closed on those days until 12.00 noon and from and after 6.00 pm”

and inserting after “Act” the following—

“on 16 December 2001 and 23 December 2001 provided the shop is closed on those days until 11.00 am and from and after 5.00 pm”.

3. The Retail Trading Hours (Townsite of Northam) Exemption Order 2000 [*Published in the Gazette of 8 September 2000 at p 5195*] is amended at Part 6 by deleting—

“on 20 December 2000 and 22 December 2000”

and inserting after “Act” the following—

“on 19 December 2001 and 21 December 2001 provided the shop is closed on those days until 8.00 am and from and after 9.00 pm”.
