**General Description**

The Minister for Planning and Infrastructure has granted approval to the declaration of a Planning Control Area over the whole of Peel Estate Lot 593 Jarvis Road, Baldivis (Bush Forever Site No. 275) as shown on Western Australian Planning Commission Plan No. 3.1559.

**Purpose of The Planning Control Area**

The purpose of the Planning Control Area is to protect land identified in Bush Forever for conservation based on its representation of ecological communities with greater than 90% in excellent condition. The subject property contains part of Stakehill Swamp which is a conservation category wetland and is gazetted for statutory protection under the *Environmental Protection (Swan Coastal Lakes) Policy*. The Commission considers that the Planning Control Area is required to ensure that no further development occurs on this land which might prejudice this purpose until it may be reserved for the purpose of Parks and Recreation in the Metropolitan Region Scheme.

**Duration And Effects**

The declaration remains in effect for a period of five years from the date of publication of this notice in the *Government Gazette* or until revoked by the Western Australian Planning Commission with approval by the Minister, whichever is the sooner.

A person shall not commence and carry out development in a Planning Control Area without the prior approval of the Western Australian Planning Commission. The penalty for failure to comply with this requirement is \$2,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, a further fine of \$200 for each day during which the offence continues.



Compensation is payable in respect of land injuriously affected by this declaration, and land so affected may be acquired by the Western Australian Planning Commission in the same circumstances and in the same manner as if the land had been reserved in the Metropolitan Region Scheme for a public purpose.
