This order may be cited as the *State Records (Implementation) Order 2002*.

## 2. Commencement

This order comes into operation on the day it is published in the *Government Gazette*.

The requirement in section 20(1) of the *State Records Act 2002* is to be complied with by all government organizations before 7 March 2004.

#### EXTRACTIVE INDUSTRIES LOCAL LAW

Under the power conferred by the *Local Government Act 1995* and by all other powers, the Council of the Shire of Dandaragan resolved on the 10 January 2002 to amend the Shire of Dandaragan Extractive Industries Local Law published in the *Government Gazette* on 9 May 2001 as set out below.

## Clause 2.3

Subclause (3) of clause 2.3 is deleted and the following is substituted—

- "(3) Where in relation to a proposed excavation—
  - (a) the surface area is not to exceed 4000m2; and
  - (b) the extracted material is not to exceed 4000m3;

the local government may exempt a person making application for a licence under subclause (1) from supplying any of the data specified in paragraphs (b), (d), (e) and (i) of subclause (1)".
