#### PROHIBITION OF ENTRY INTO A SAFETY ZONE

I, W L Tinapple, Director Petroleum Division of the Department of Mineral and Petroleum Resources of the said State by instrument of delegation dated 1 March 2001, and pursuant to section 119 of the above Act, hereby prohibit all vessels other than vessels under control of the registered holders of Exploration Permit No. TP/8, Production Licence L10 and Petroleum Lease L1H from entering or remaining in the area of the safety zone without the consent in writing of the Director, Petroleum Division. This safety zone extends to a distance of five hundred metres, measured from the subsea wellhead at the Double Island-1 well, location (latitude 20° 45' 21.21" South, longitude 115° 30' 19.847" East\*.)

Where an unauthorised vessel enters or remains in the safety zone specified in contravention of this instrument, the owner and the person in command or in charge of the vessel are each guilty of an offence against section 119 of the Act and are punishable, upon conviction, by a fine not exceeding \$100,000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 10 years, or both, pursuant to section 119(3) of the Act.

Permit applications (see attached form) shall specify a work program (minimum number of wells to be drilled, line kilometres of seismic, geophysical, geochemical surveys etc.) to be carried out, and estimated expenditures for each of the six years. Wells referred to in the work program should not include development wells.

Applicants should also make themselves aware of the existence of any areas, which have the potential to restrict exploration activities.

Applications are to be made in accordance with Section 31 of the Petroleum Act 1967. Consideration of an application for the grant of a Permit shall take into account work programs relative to the whole of the area applied for, the adequacy of the work program and the applicant's technical and financial ability to undertake the work. Permits are awarded on the understanding that the first two years work commitment will be fulfilled without variation.

Where there is more than one applicant to the application, the percentage participating interests of each party to the application is to be supplied including evidence that a satisfactory settlement has been, or can be reached on a Joint Operating Agreement (a copy of a Heads of Agreement dealing will generally suffice).
