I, William Lee Tinapple, Director of the Petroleum Division in the Department of Mineral and Petroleum Resources for the State of Western Australia being the Officer for the time being holding certain powers and functions of the Minister in respect of the area specified in the State of Western Australia by virtue of an instrument of delegation dated 1 March 2001 and published in the Government Gazette of Western Australia on 13 March 2001, give notice pursuant to Section 8(4) of the Petroleum Pipelines Act, 1969 that an application recorded as 3P/02-3 has been received from—Newcrest Mining Limited for a pipeline licence to construct and operate a pipeline for the conveyance of natural gas from the Pilbara Energy Gas Pipeline at Boodarie, Port Hedland to the proposed Newcrest Mining Limited power station at the Telfer mine site.
