**METROPOLITAN REGION TOWN PLANNING SCHEME ACT 1959
METROPOLITAN REGION SCHEME (SECTION 33) AMENDMENT NO. 992/33
CLARKSON – BUTLER**

OUTCOME OF SUBMISSIONS

The Western Australian Planning Commission has considered all the submissions received in respect of the proposals for the Clarkson – Butler Amendment No. 992/33. This proposal was first published in the *Government Gazette* on 28 September 1999. The Commission has recommended that the amendment be modified, and is further subject to environmental conditions as set by the Minister for the Environment. The amendment as modified is shown on Western Australian Planning Commission plan 1.2795/5.

The amendment has been presented to and approved by the Governor in accordance with the requirements of the Metropolitan Region Town Planning Scheme Act. It will now be tabled in both Houses of Parliament, where it must remain for 12 sitting days. During this time either House may, by resolution, disallow the amendment. As soon as the amendment is no longer subject to disallowance it becomes legally effective in the Metropolitan Region Scheme.
