The Western Australian Planning Commission intends to amend the Metropolitan Region Scheme for land in the City of Nedlands and the Town of Cambridge. Public comment is invited.

The purpose of this amendment is to transfer the existing road reservations of Stephenson Avenue from Rochdale Road to Underwood Avenue and Rochdale Road from West Coast Highway to Stephenson Avenue into the Other Regional Roads reservation in the Metropolitan Region Scheme.

WATER SUPPLY IMPROVEMENTS - SHIRE OF ESPERANCE - CONDINGUP

Notice of Proposal to Construct a Water Treatment Plant, Raw Water Supply and Concentrate Disposal Pipelines and Evaporation Pond.

To improve the water quality of the Condingup Water Supply, the Water Corporation proposes to construct a water treatment plant, raw water supply and concentrate disposal pipelines, with evaporation pond. The water treatment plant will be installed within the existing storage tank site near Sutcliffe Street.

At the water treatment plant the new proposed works include a packaged membrane desalination plant housed in a sea container, a sodium hypochlorite chlorination plant, ground level water storage tanks, pumps, associated ancillary works.

The evaporation pond will be 120m x 125m by 1.1m in depth and used to dispose of the treatment plant concentrate wastewater.


Construction of the proposed pipelines includes a 1.1km raw water pipeline using a 90mm diameter polyethelene pipe, and a 0.9km concentrate disposal pipeline using a 90mm diameter polyethelene pipe. Construction of the pipelines will be in the road reserve and includes open trench excavation which will be backfilled and restored.

The proposed works are scheduled to commence in June 2004 and will continue for approximately eight months.
