I, David Kingsley Malcolm, AC, was appointed Lieutenant-Governor by a commission dated 19 March 1990.

I, David Kingsley Malcolm, AC, proclaim and declare that, under Clauses XI and XIII of the *Letters Patent relating to the Office of Governor General of the State of Western Australia* dated 14 February 1986, I have assumed the administration of the government of the State and, under Clause XIV of those Letters Patent, may perform and exercise the powers and functions of the Governor.
