# LEGAL PRACTITIONERS (PUBLIC NOTARIES) REPORT 2004

Made by the Legal Costs Committee under section 214 of the Act.

## PART 1—PRELIMINARY

### Citation

1. (1) This report may be cited as the *Legal Practitioners (Public Notaries) Report 2004*.
- (2) The determination set out in the Schedule to this report is referred to in this report as the *Legal Practitioners (Public Notaries) Determination 2004*.

## PART 2—NOTICE AND INQUIRIES

### Notice under section 213 of the Act

2. The Legal Costs Committee has complied with the notice provisions of section 213 of the Act.

### Inquiries and submissions under section 213 of the Act

3. Before making the *Legal Practitioners (Public Notaries) Determination 2004* the Legal Costs Committee—
  - (a) reviewed all submissions received as a result of the notice given under section 213 of the Act;
  - (b) consulted with the Courts, practising Public Notaries, and the Law Society of Western Australia;
  - (c) had regard to the fees chargeable by Public Notaries in comparable jurisdictions; and
  - (d) had regard to the hourly and daily rates applicable under the *Solicitors Costs Determination 2003\**.

## PART 3—REPORT OF COMMITTEE'S CONCLUSIONS

### Increase in fees

4. Having had regard to the public service nature of the duties of Public Notaries, considered input from practising Public Notaries about the time taken in the performance of their services, and having given consideration to the fees and charges applicable by Public Notaries in other comparable jurisdictions, the Legal Costs Committee concluded that the scale of Public Notaries fees that is applicable in Western Australia is inappropriate.

### Scale of costs to be adopted

5. (1) It is the recommendation of the Legal Costs Committee, after reviewing the information gained as a result of the inquiries and submissions described in clause 3, that the scale of costs set out in the Table to clause 4 of the *Legal Practitioners (Public Notaries) Determination 2004* be adopted for the business of Public Notaries.
- (2) It is the further recommendation of the Committee that given the amendments to the scale of costs in the manner set out in the Table to clause 4 of the *Legal Practitioners (Public Notaries) Determination 2002* were inclusive of any provision for the Goods and Services Tax (GST), the scale of Public Notaries fees continues to be inclusive of GST.

## SCHEDULE

## LEGAL PRACTICE ACT 2003

## LEGAL PRACTITIONERS (PUBLIC NOTARIES) DETERMINATION 2004

Made by the Legal Costs Committee under section 210 of the Act.

**Citation**

1. This determination may be cited as the *Legal Practitioners (Public Notaries) Determination 2004*.

**Commencement**

2. This determination comes into operation on 1 January 2005.

**Application**

3. (1) This determination applies to the remuneration of a Public Notary for the provision of notarial services.

(2) This determination does not apply to the remuneration of a Public Notary based on costs incurred in respect of instructions taken before the commencement of this determination.

**Scale of costs**

4. The fee charged by a Public Notary for providing notarial services shall not exceed the fee for those services set out in the Table to this clause (inclusive of GST).
