 (d) To encourage co-location as a means of preventing unnecessary proliferation and duplication of such infrastructure;

- (e) To minimise the visual impact of such infrastructure on the surrounding locality; and
- (f) To prevent ad-hoc development of such infrastructure by requiring applicants to provide a report in accordance with the requirements of WAPC Statement of Planning Policy 5.2 and any other relevant Statement of Planning Policy and demonstrating an industry-wide strategic approach to the location of such infrastructure throughout the City.
