ELECTORAL ACT 1907

(SECTION 65)

Notice of issue of writ for elections in all the electoral districts to elect members of the Legislative Assembly

- 1. Under section 65 of the *Electoral Act 1907* I give notice that on Sunday 23 January 2005 the Governor issued a writ under sections 64(1) and 69 of that Act directing me to proceed with elections in all the electoral districts to elect one member of the Legislative Assembly for each district.
- 2. For the purposes of those elections—
 - (a) the electoral rolls close at 6 p.m. on Monday 31 January 2005;
 - (b) nominations of candidates must be received before 6 p.m. on Friday 4 February 2005;
 - (c) polling will occur between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Saturday 26 February 2005;
 - (d) the last day for the return of the writ is Friday 15 April 2005.

ELECTORAL ACT 1907

(SECTION 65)

Notice of issue of writ for elections in all the electoral regions to elect members of the Legislative Council

- 1. Under section 65 of the *Electoral Act 1907* I give notice that on Sunday 23 January 2005 the Governor issued a writ under sections 64(2) and 69 of that Act directing me to proceed with elections in all the electoral regions to elect—
 - (a) 7 members of the Legislative Council for each of the electoral regions known, respectively, as the North Metropolitan Region and the South West Region; and
 - (b) 5 members of the Legislative Council for each of the electoral regions known, respectively, as the South Metropolitan Region, the East Metropolitan Region, the Agricultural Region and the Mining and Pastoral Region.
- 2. For the purposes of each of those elections—
 - (a) the electoral rolls close at 6 p.m. on Monday 31 January 2005;
 - (b) nominations of candidates must be received before $6\ \mathrm{p.m.}$ on Friday $4\ \mathrm{February}\ 2005;$
 - (c) polling will occur between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Saturday 26 February 2005;
 - (d) the last day for the return of the writ is Friday 15 April 2005.
