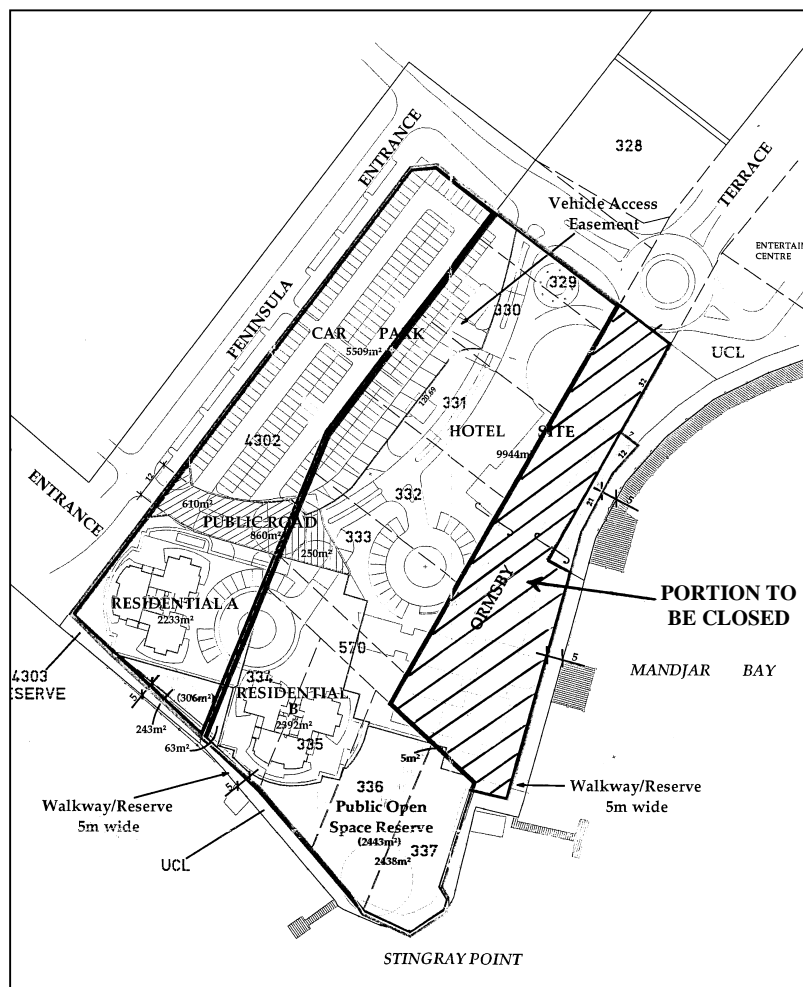
The subject portion of Ormsby Terrace being considered for closure is located adjacent to the proposed Peninsula Hotel development site, and commences after the Ormsby Terrace roundabout concluding where Ormsby Terrace currently ceases as a road. The applicant on behalf of the owner of Lot 337, has requested the City initiate the closure to facilitate a land exchange between the City, the State

Government and the Developers. The diagram below illustrates the area of road reserve proposed for closure.

At its meeting on 27 January 2004, Council resolved that pursuant to Section 58 of the Land Administration Act 1997, Council gives notice that it proposes to resolve that a portion of Ormsby Terrace, Mandurah, having an area of approximately 3,690sqm be closed for the purpose of amalgamation with the Peninsula Hotel development site.
