### LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1995

*Town of Victoria Park*

#### ACTIVITIES ON THOROUGHFARES AND TRADING IN THOROUGHFARES AND PUBLIC PLACES LOCAL LAW AMENDMENT

Under the powers conferred by the *Local Government Act 1995* and all other powers enabling it the Council of the Town of Victoria Park hereby records having resolved on 3 May 2005 to amend its *Activities on Thoroughfares and Trading in Thoroughfares and Public Places Local Law* published in the *Government Gazette* on 31 May 2000 as follows—

1. To the 'Definitions' clause 1.2
  - (a) The following definition is inserted in the appropriate alphabetical position—

“**thoroughfare**” has the meaning given to it in section 1.4 of the *Local Government Act 1995*;
  - (b) In the definition of “vehicle” under the words “but excludes —” after subclause (b) insert new subclause—

“(c) a shopping trolley; and”.
2. Clause 2.1
  - (a) in subclause (a)(ii) delete “so that the plant is within 6m of an intersection”;
  - (b) in subclause (a)(iii) delete “2m” and substitute “1m”.
3. Clause 2.7  
in subclause (2)(e) delete “third” and substitute “quarter”.
4. Clause 4.6  
Repeal subclause (2) and the following subclause is substituted—

“(2) A retailer shall remove a shopping trolley within 3 hours of being so advised under subclause (1).”
5. Schedule 1
  - (a) Clause 2.1(a)(ii)

In the description column after the word “thoroughfare” delete “within 6m of intersection”;
  - (b) Clause 2.1(a)(iii)

In the description column delete “2m” and substitute “1m”.

**MX401\*****WESTERN AUSTRALIAN MARINE ACT 1982****NAVIGABLE WATERS REGULATIONS****Restricted Speed Areas—All Vessels****Swan River**Department for Planning and Infrastructure,  
Fremantle WA, 10 May 2005

Acting pursuant to the powers conferred by Regulation 48A of the Navigable Waters Regulations the department by this notice revokes the 8-knot speed restrictions currently in force—

- under the Narrows Bridge, the Canning Bridge and the southern arch of the Causeway Bridges and
- within 45 metres of all the Barrack Street Jetties.

Under Section 67 of the Western Australian Marine Act 1982, the department also revokes the 8-knot speed limit in the area—

- between the Canning Bridge and a line drawn between Point Heathcoate and the outer end of the Como Jetty, as published at paragraph (d)(3)(1) of Notice MH401 in the *Government Gazette* dated 25 October 1991.

Providing that these revocations shall apply only between 0900 hrs and 1300 hrs on Sunday 15 May 2005, to official bona fide competitors competing in the “Swan Marathon Event” held by the Power Dinghy Racing Club.

On completion of the event all existing speed limits will be re-established.
