SOIL AND LAND CONSERVATION (BRIDGETOWN-GREENBUSHES LAND CONSERVATION DISTRICT) AMENDMENT ORDER 2005

Made by the Governor in Executive Council under sections 22 and 23 of the *Soil and Land Conservation Act 1945* on the recommendation of the Minister for Agriculture.

1. Citation

This order may be cited as the *Soil and Land Conservation (Bridgetown-Greenbushes Land Conservation District) Amendment Order 2005*.

2. Principal Order

In this order the *Soil and Land Conservation (Bridgetown-Greenbushes Land Conservation District) Order 1989** is referred to as the principal order.
