Amendment of Management Plan

The Conservation Commission of Western Australia advises that the management plan for Herdsman Lake Regional Park is available.

The management plan was prepared in accordance with sections 53 to 61 of the *Conservation and Land Management Act 1984*, and was approved by the Minister for the Environment on 24 November 2004. No modifications were made to the management plan under section 60(2) of the Act, and it comes into operation with this *Gazette* notice.

The management plan provides direction for the planning, management and protection of Herdsman Lake Regional Park by encouraging the protection of park values, anticipating future community requirements and developing strategies aimed at addressing management issues and concerns.

AQUATIC EVENTS AND WATER SKI AREA Perth International Boat Show 2005

All the waters within an area defined by an imaginary line commencing on the South Perth foreshore at the western boundary of the Commercial Water Ski take-off area (31° 57.862' S, 115° 50.844' E); thence in a northerly direction to a buoy positioned at 31° 57.801' S, 115° 50.907' E; thence in a north-easterly direction to the Port-Hand Marker at position 31° 57.650' S, 115° 51.158' E; thence in a south-easterly direction to the Starboard-Hand Marker positioned at 31° 57.769' S, 115° 51.385' E; thence in a southerly direction to the Starboard-Hand Marker positioned at 31° 57.815' S, 115° 51.342' E; thence in a south- westerly direction to a point on the South Perth foreshore approximately 200 metres up-stream of the Queen Street Jetty.
