FIRE BREAK NOTICE

Notice to all owners and/or occupiers of land situated in the City of Melville

Pursuant to the powers contained in Section 33 of the above Act, you are hereby required on or before the 15th day of November 2005 or within 14 days of the date of you becoming the owner or occupier, should this be after the 15th day of November 2005 and thereafter up to and including the 30th day of April 2006 to clear flammable matter from that land in accordance with the following requirements—

 - (iv) In any event, clear the firebreaks to the satisfaction of Council's duly authorised officer.

If for any reason an owner or occupier considers it to be impracticable to clear firebreaks or comply with other fire protection measures in accordance with this requirement, the owner or occupier may apply in writing to the Council's duly authorised officer no later than 31 October 2005 for an exemption or partial exemption from compliance with the requirements of this notice.

The penalty for failing to comply with this notice is a fine of not more than \$5,000 and a person in default is also liable, whether prosecuted or not, to pay the cost of performing the work directed in this notice if it is not carried out by the owner or occupier by the date required by this notice.
