

In accordance with the provisions of Section 91 of the Water Agencies (Powers) Act 1984, the Minister Assisting the Minister for Water Resources has authorised the Water Corporation to construct the following works—


- · Modifications to the existing chemical dosing building by internal modification of the rooms.
- Construction of a new operations building to replace the obsolete control room in the existing chemical dosing building. The building will be in place of the existing generator facility. It will be of brick construction to the adjoining chemical dosing building and be approximately 8m x 8m x 3m high.
- Construction of a new steel framed and metal sheeted weather shelter over the existing fluoride storage bund. The finish will match the adjoining chlorine store building.
- Replacement and upgrade of existing chemical dosing equipment within the existing chemical dosing building and chlorine drum store.
- Replacement and upgrade of existing electrical control equipment including a new outdoor emergency generator in a weather and soundproof enclosure.
- Associated pipework including valves, meters and valve operating platforms.
- Upgrade of the existing site security fence.

The location of the proposed works is within the existing chemical dosing plant compound at the base of the Canning Dam as shown on the plan.

The works will allow greater draw from Canning Dam and improve control of the chemical dosing systems.
