District of Carnamah

(DISCONTINUATION OF WARD SYSTEM) ORDER 2006

Made by the Governor in Executive Council on the recommendation of the Minister for Local Government and Regional Development.

1. Citation

This order may be cited as the District of Carnamah (Discontinuation of Ward System) Order 2006.

2. Discontinuation of ward system (s.2.2 (1)(d) of the Act)

All wards in the district of Carnamah are abolished immediately before the first ordinary elections day of the district after the commencement of this order.

3. Declaration of vacant offices (ss.2.35 and 9.62 of the Act)

All the offices of member of the council of the Shire of Carnamah become vacant immediately before the first ordinary elections day after the commencement of this order.

4. Election to fill vacancies (ss.4.11 and 9.62 of the Act)

- (1) An election is to be held to fill the offices that become vacant under clause 3.
- (2) Any poll needed for an election to fill the offices is to be held on the first ordinary elections day after the commencement of this order.
- (3) Part 4 of the Act applies to preparing for and conducting the election as if clauses 2 and 3 had taken effect on the day on which this order commenced.
- (4) For the purposes of subclause (3), Part 4 of the Act is modified to the extent necessary to give effect to subclauses (1), (2), and (3).

I recommend that the orders in clauses 2, 3 and 4 be made as recommended by the Local Government Advisory Board.

OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH ACT 1984 OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH REGULATIONS 1996

EXEMPTION CERTIFICATE PURSUANT TO REGULATION 2.13

(No. 6 of 2006)

- I, Nina Lyhne, WorkSafe Western Australia Commissioner, hereby grant an exemption to Ms Sarina Smith from the requirements of the following regulations of the Occupational Safety and Health Regulations 1996—
 - Regulation 4.53(2)(a) through to Regulation 4.53(2)(e), inclusive; and
 - Regulation 4.54(4)(c) insofar as it relates to the requirements of Section 6.18 of AS 2550.1—2002

insofar as the above require a person suspended from a crane to be accommodated in a workbox. This exemption relates to the use of an 18 tonne capacity mobile crane set up on outriggers to suspend a performer during a performance at Berridge Park, Denmark on 5 March 2006.

I also grant an exemption from the requirements of Regulation 4.54(3) in relation to the use of the crane in the abovementioned performance.

The following conditions shall apply with respect to use of the crane—

- notwithstanding that Section 6.18.2 of Australian Standard AS2550.1 refers to use of a workbox, from which requirement Ms Smith is exempted, the requirements for the crane listed in clauses (a) to (g) of 6.18.2 shall still apply;
- the crane operator shall remain at the controls of the crane at all times during the performance;
- the only crane motion permitted whilst the performer is suspended from the crane hook is hoist up or down at slow speed; and
- a certificated dogger or rigger oversees the secure attachment of the fabric to the crane hook.

This exemption is valid on 5 March 2006 only.
