Genetically Modified Crops Free Areas Act 2003

Genetically Modified Crops Free Areas Exemption Order (No. 2) 2007

Made by the Minister under section 6 of the Act.

1. Citation

This order is the *Genetically Modified Crops Free Areas Exemption Order (No. 2) 2007*.

2. Commencement and duration

This order come into operation on the day of its publication in the *Gazette* and remains in force until 31 December 2009.

3. Exemption

A person conducting cotton field trials* in the Ord River Irrigation Area, may, for that purpose and within that area,

cultivate genetically modified cotton varieties (Liberty Link®, Bollgard II®, Roundup Ready® and Roundup Ready Flex®) or combinations of varieties that have been licensed for commercial release under the *Gene Technology Act 2000* (Commonwealth).

Conditions of this exemption are that—

1. A person intending to conduct a cotton field trial under the authority of this exemption must first apply to an officer of the Department designated by the Minister for approval of the proposed field trial and must agree to publication of the details of the trial on the Department's website.
2. Approval will not be given for any trial that exceeds an area of 20 hectares or for any trial that would result in the total area cultivated under authority of this exemption exceeding 100 hectares in any one year.
3. Field trials must comply with all relevant Genetically Modified Organisms (GMO) licence conditions and requirements of the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority.
4. The Department will audit compliance with the conditions of this exemption.

**Note:* Under the Act —

“**field trial**” means the small scale cultivation of a crop that is —

- (a) for the purpose of assessing the viability and environmental risks of that crop; and
- (b) not for commercial purposes.

An exemption from regulation 4.14(1) of the Occupational Safety and Health Regulations 1996 is also granted in relation to the use of 31 pressure vessels (tanks) at a workplace without individual plant registration by myself as WorkSafe Western Australia Commissioner or a regulatory authority.

The exemptions only apply to the pressure vessels (tanks) with the serial numbers 1230, 1231, 1281, 1282, 1283, 1284, 1285, 1286, 1287, 1288, 1289, 1290, NT-01, NT-02, NT-03, NT-15, NT-101, NT-103, NT-104, NT-108, NT-1928, NT-1931, NT-1933, NT-1940, NT-1949, NT-1950, DLN5, DLN6, SK7785, 213 and 250.

The exemptions are granted on the condition that, before the 31 pressure vessels (tanks) are filled, it is ensured that the supplier of the nitrogen, BOC Australia, as a competent person/organisation, inspects, tests and certifies each as safe for use.

The exemptions only apply in relation to the use of the 31 pressure vessels (tanks) to purge supply pipelines from oilrigs to shore for Woodside Petroleum Pty Ltd's Perseus over Goodwyn Project.

The exemptions are made for a once-off filling of the 31 pressure vessels (tanks) and are valid until 28 September 2007.

Exemption No. 4 of 2007 is hereby revoked.
