# Rules of Wagering Amendment Rules (No. 2) 2007

Made by Racing and Wagering Western Australia with the approval of the Commission under section 120 of the Act.

#### 1. Citation

These rules are the Rules of Wagering Amendment Rules (No. 2) 2007.

#### 2. The rules amended

The amendments in these rules are to the *Rules of Wagering 2005\**.

#### 3. Rule 43 amended

Rule 43(2) is amended as follows:

- (a) in paragraph (b)(i) by deleting "and the wager is requested more than 2 minutes prior to the advertised start time of the race";
- (b) in paragraph (b)(i) by deleting "\$5 000;" and inserting instead
  - " \$2 500 ";
- (c) by deleting paragraph (b)(ii) and "and" after it;
- (d) by inserting at the end of paragraph (b)(i) to (v) "and":
- (e) by inserting at the end of paragraph (c)(i) and (ii) —

  " and ".

The benefits of having all the gazettes and indices on-line and searchable will be enormous. This service should remove the need for clients to retain hard copies and will free up valuable storage space.

Barring any unforeseen delays, it should take around a month to scan each year and then release on our website.
