**EXOTIC DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT 1993**

**CONTROL ORDER No. 04/2007**

Made by the Chief Veterinary Officer under section 40(3) of the *Exotic Diseases of Animals Act 1993*.

**Reference**

This Control Order is in relation to the Controlled Area described in Controlled Area Order No. 02/2007, dated 25 August 2007.

**Commencement**

Control Order 04/2007 comes into effect at 1600 hours on 29 August 2007.

**Revocation**

This order revokes Control Order 03/2007.

**Duration**

This order remains in effect unless varied or revoked by a further order.

**Control measures**

The following disease control measures apply to the listed class of animals—

Item	Disease control measure
Equines	<p>A person may move, or allow to move, an equine within Western Australia subject to the following conditions—</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. A person moving an equine from one property to another property shall exercise reasonable care and caution, and hygiene and biosecurity measures, so as to prevent the spread of equine influenza virus.</li> <li>2. If as a result of his own information or information provided by another person the Chief Veterinary Officer is of the view that a risk exists in relation to any equine or thing in relation to equine influenza, the Chief Veterinary Officer may direct the restriction of movement of that equine and the cleaning of that equine prior to it being moved.</li> </ol>
