It is hereby notified for public information, in accordance with Section 87 of the *Planning and Development Act 2005* that the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure approved the City of Rockingham local planning Scheme Amendment on the 11th October 2007 for the purpose of—

- 1. Rezoning Lots 200 and 300 Dampier Drive, Golden Bay from 'Special Rural' to 'Special Residential'.
- 2. Amending Schedule No.5—Special Residential Zones by including Lots 200 and 300 in the Location Table applicable to portions of Planning Unit 3 of the Rural Land Strategy as follows—

- 3. Including a new provision in Schedule No.5—Special Residential Zones as follows—
 - 3. In the Landscape Protection Area of Location 3 (iii), no planting of non-indigenous species is permitted.
- 4. Amending Provision No.8, No.10 and No.20 of Schedule No.5—Special Residential Zones by including a reference to Location 3 (iii) as follows—
 - 8. With respect to Location 3 (i) and 3 (iii) all lots shall be connected to a reticulated water supply.
 - 10. With respect to Location 3 (i) and 3 (iii) on-site effluent disposal systems servicing development of the lots shall be in the form of alternative wastewater treatment systems having approved phosphorous retention capability, in accordance with the specifications and to the satisfaction of the Council.
 - 20. With respect to Location 3 (i) and 3 (iii) any development on those lots marked with an 'S' on the Subdivision Guide Plan are subject to special housing design requirements as specified in Council's Planning Policy No.2.14—Development Guidelines for the Peelhurst Special Residential Estate. These requirements are necessary in order to minimise the amount of site earthworks to protect the landscape character of each lot.
- 5. Amending the Scheme Maps accordingly.

Authorisation to construct Artesian (Leederville) Production Bore J5 at Jandakot Water Treatment Plant


In accordance with the provisions of the Water Agencies (Powers) Act 1984, the Minister for Water Resources has authorised the Water Corporation to construct the following works—

- One production artesian bore, being 400mm in diameter to a depth of approximately 300 metres in the confined Leederville aquifer
- Associated bore headworks, electrical works & DN300 pipework including valves, all within the Jandakot Water Treatment Plant

The proposed works are located within the grounds of the Jandakot Treatment Plant, Reserve 35271, 24 Bartram Road, Success.

Construction is proposed to commence in October 2007 and will take approximately eight (8) months to complete.

When completed, the works will augment the Perth Integrated Water Supply System.
