RESTRICTED SPEED AREAS—ALL VESSELS
Bandy Creek Boat Harbour
Shire of Esperance

Acting pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 67 of the Western Australian Marine Act 1982, the department by this notice revokes paragraph (b)(9) of Notice MH401 as published in the Government Gazette on the 25 October 1991 and hereby limits the speed of motor vessels to five (5) knots within the following area—

Bandy Creek Boat Harbour: All those waters of the boat harbour enclosed within the east and west breakwaters and extending a distance of 50 metres from the entrance to the harbour, excluding all boating prohibited areas.

DONGARA WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT—SHIRE OF IRWIN

Authorisation to Upgrade the Dongara Wastewater Treatment Plant


In accordance with the provisions of the Water Agencies (Powers) Act 1984, the Minister for Water Resources has authorised the Water Corporation to upgrade the existing Dongara Wastewater Treatment Plant, which comprises the following works—

- A new 1.2ML/d high performance aerated lagoon system, consisting of one aerated lagoon and three sedimentation lagoons.
- An inlet screenings facility complete with a screenings handling system (washing, compaction and dewatering)
- A disinfection system.
- Treated wastewater pump station and pressure main to transfer treated wastewater for reuse purposes to the Dongara golf course.
- The existing secondary lagoon will be converted to a sludge-drying lagoon.
- The existing primary lagoon will be converted to an emergency storage lagoon.
- An irrigation pumping station to transfer water from the emergency storage lagoon to the onsite filtration area.

The existing Dongara Wastewater Treatment Plant is located on Lot 908 and the proposed upgrade will be constructed on the same site.

The treated wastewater pressure main will be installed along Blenheim Road within the road reserve as well as on reserves 20720 and 35699 currently under care, control and management of the Shire of Irwin and Dongara Health Board, respectively.

The new treatment plant will treat wastewater flows from the Dongara and Port Denison area.
