SCHOOL EDUCATION ACT 1999**DECLARATION OF LOCAL-INTAKE AREAS FOR SCHOOLS WITH PRIMARY STUDENTS**

(Pursuant to Sections 60, 78, 79 and 80)

The Hon. Minister for Education has declared that the local-intake areas for the schools listed hereunder shall be as stated in this notice. Children of compulsory school age who reside within the local-intake areas stated shall be entitled to attend the schools to which such local-intake areas apply if there is an appropriate educational program for them at that school. Children who reside outside these local-intake areas may apply to attend the schools to which such local-intake areas apply.

ARBOR GROVE PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Gngangara Road and Pinaster Parade, north and north east along Pinaster Parade to The Promenade, west along The Promenade to The Broadway, north along The Broadway to Galatea Pass, north west along Galatea Pass to the middle of the Transit Corridor, north-north-east along the Transit Corridor to the intersection with Farmaner Parkway, north from this intersection to the proposed route of the Perth-Darwin Highway, south west along the proposed Perth Darwin Highway to Gngangara Road and east along Gngangara Road to Pinaster Parade. The boundary parts of Pinaster Parade (north west side), The Promenade (south side), The Broadway (west side), Galatea Pass (both sides) and Gngangara Road (north side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

ASHBURTON DRIVE PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Verna Street and Ashburton Drive, northwest along Ashburton Drive to Stennett Street, northeast along Stennett Street to Kellerman Way, northeast and east along Kellerman Way to the southerly extension of Rowland Court, north from this point between Rowland Court and Wilkinson Court to Goodall Street, northeast along Goodall Street to Corfield Street, northwest along Corfield Street to Astinal Drive west along Astinal Drive to a point immediately west of Warren Street, south from this point to the junction of Dionne Place and Prescott Drive, northwest along Prescott Drive to Hood Place, southwest along Hood Place and its extension to Moonstone Place, southwest along Moonstone Place to Compton Road, west along Compton Road to Anaconda Drive, south and southwest along Anaconda Drive to Greenwood Court, southeast along Greenwood Court and its extension to Southern River Road, southwest along Southern River Road to the Southern River, in a general southerly direction along the Southern River to the extension of Verna Street and northeast along the extension of Verna Street and Verna Street to Ashburton Drive.

The boundary parts of Goodall Street, Prescott Drive, Compton Road and Southern River Road, and the boundary streets of Hood Place and Moonstone Place (both sides in all cases) are included within the local-intake area for Ashburton Drive Primary School, while the boundary parts of Ashburton Drive, Stennett Street, Kellerman Way, Corfield Street, Astinal Drive, Anaconda Drive and Verna Street (both sides in all cases) and the boundary street of Greenwood Court are excluded from the area for Ashburton Drive Primary School.

The following defines an optional area between Ashburton Drive and Seaforth Primary Schools—

The area bounded by Ashburton Drive, Kellerman Way and Stennett Street. The boundary parts of Ashburton Drive and Stennett Street and the boundary street of Kellerman Way are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Ashburton Drive, Gosnells, Seaforth and Wirrabirra Primary Schools—

The area bounded by Corfield Street, Goodall Street, Eudoria Street and Stalker Road. The boundary parts of the four boundary streets are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Ashburton Drive and Wirrabirra Primary Schools—

The area bounded by Anaconda Drive, Greenwood Court, Southern River Road, the Southern River and Shearwater Way. The boundary part of Anaconda Drive and the boundary streets of Greenwood Court and Shearwater Way (both sides in each case) are included within this optional area, while the boundary part of Southern River Road (both sides) is excluded from this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Ashburton Drive Primary School and Seaforth Primary School—

From the bridge on Southern River Road crossing the Southern River, south west along Southern River Road to Holmes Street, south east along Holmes Street to Passmore Street, north east along Passmore Street to Dallen Street, south east along Dallen Street and its south easterly extension to the Tonkin Highway, north east along the Tonkin Highway to Midgegoroo Bridge, and generally north and north west along the Wungong River and the Southern River to Southern River Road. The boundary parts of Southern River Road (south east side), Dallen Street (both sides) and Tonkin Highway (north west side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Holmes Street (both sides) and Passmore Street (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

ASHDALE PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following will define the local-intake area of Ashdale Primary School when the proposed Madeley Primary School opens in 2009—

From the junction of Ocean Reef Road and Hartman Drive, south along Hartman Drive to Gnangara Road, continuing south along the proposed alignment of Hartman Drive to Hepburn Avenue, east along Hepburn Avenue to Rangeview Road, north along Rangeview Road to Kingsway, west along Kingsway to Denman Gardens, continuing west along Denman Gardens to the proposed alignment of Mirrabooka Avenue, north along the proposed Mirrabooka Avenue to the junction of the existing section of Madeley Street and Furniss Road, north along Madeley Street to Gnangara Road, east along Gnangara Road to the proposed alignment of Ocean Reef Road, and north west and west along the proposed alignment of Ocean Reef Road to Hartman Drive. The boundary parts of Hartman Drive (east side), the Hepburn Avenue (north side), Rangeview Road (west side), Kingsway (south side), Denman Gardens (south side), the proposed Mirrabooka Avenue (west side), Madeley Street (west side) and Gnangara Road (north side) are included within the local-intake area of this primary school. The existing and proposed sections of Ocean Reef Road (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area of this primary school.

The following defines an optional local-intake area between Ashdale Primary School and Landsdale Primary School—

The locality of Gnangara as delineated in the 2007 edition of the Perth Streetsmart Street Directory.

BALCATT A PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake of this school—

From the intersection of Amelia Street and Wanneroo Road, west along Amelia Street to Main Street, south along Main Street to Alexander Street, west along Alexander Street to Canning Street, south along Canning Street to Donnington Road, west along Donnington Road to Langworth Road, south along Langworth Road to Keal Street west along Keal Street to Jones Street, south and in a generally south-westerly direction along Jones Street to Karrinyup Road, southeast and east along Karrinyup Road to Hamilton Street, southeast and southwest along Hamilton Street to Swan Street, east along Swan Street to Wanneroo Road, and northwest along Wanneroo Road to the intersection with Amelia Street.

The boundary streets of Alexander Street (south side), Donnington Road (south side) and Keal Street (south side) and the boundary parts of Amelia Street (south side), Main Street (west side), Canning Street (east side), Langworth Road (east side), Jones Street (east side) between Keal Street and the Right of Way leading from Jones Street to Lowen Place, Karrinyup Road (north side), Hamilton Street (both sides), Swan Street (north side) and Wanneroo Road (west side) are included in the local-intake area for Balcatta Primary School. The boundary parts of Jones Street (both sides) from Karrinyup Road to the Right of Way leading from Jones Street to Lowen Place is excluded from the local-intake area for the Balcatta Primary School.

The following defines an optional area between Balcatta Primary School, Takari Primary School and West Balcatta Primary School—

From the junction of Rance Street and Poincaire Street, south along Rance Street to Woodhall Street, west along Woodhall Street to Drew Street, south along Drew Street to Lowen Place, east along Lowen Place and south-east along a Right of Way leading to Jones Street, northeast and north along Jones Street to Poincaire Street, and west along Poincaire Street to the junction with Rance Street. The boundary streets of Rance Street (east side) and Lowen Place (north side) and the boundary parts of Woodhall Street (south side), Drew Street (east side), Jones Street (west side) and Poincaire Street (south side) are included in the optional area.

The following defines an optional area for Balcatta Primary School and Takari Primary School—

From the intersection of Amelia Street and Main Street, west along Amelia Street to the eastern boundary of the Balcatta Senior High School site, south along such boundary to Poincaire Street, east along Poincaire Street to Jones Street, north along Jones Street to Keal Street, east along Keal Street to Langworth Road, north along Langworth Road to Donnington Road, east along Donnington Road to Canning Street, north along Canning Street to Alexander Street, east along Alexander Street to Main Street, and north along Main Street to the intersection with Amelia Street. The boundary streets of Keal Street (north side), Donnington Road (north side) and Alexander Street (north side) and the boundary parts of Amelia Street (south side), Poincaire Street (north side), Jones Street (west side), Langworth Road (west side), Canning Street (west side) and Main Street (west side) are included in the optional area.

The following defines an optional area for West Balcatta Primary School, Balcatta Primary School and Osborne Primary School—

From the intersection of Karrinyup Road and the Mitchell Freeway, south and southeast along the Mitchell Freeway to a point coinciding with the southern extension of Telford Crescent, north northeast to and along Telford Crescent to Karrinyup Road and in a general westerly direction along Karrinyup Road to the Mitchell Freeway. The boundary parts of the Mitchell Freeway (east and northeast sides), Telford Crescent (both sides) and Karrinyup Road (south side) are included within the optional area.

BLETCHLEY PARK PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Ranford Road and Warton Road, north east along Warton Road to Garden Street, south east along the locality boundary between Huntingdale and Southern River

(which corresponds to the extension of Garden Street) to the junction of Holmes Street and Balfour Street, south east along Holmes Street to Passmore Street, north east along Passmore Street to Dallen Street, south east along Dallen Street and its south easterly extension to the Tonkin Highway, south west along the Tonkin Highway to Ranford Road, and north west along Ranford Road to Warton Road. The boundary parts of Warton Road (south east side), Holmes Street (both sides), Passmore Street (both sides), Tonkin Highway (north west side) and Ranford Road (north east side) are included within this local-intake area. The boundary street of Dallen Street (both sides) is excluded from this local-intake area.

The following defines an optional area between Forrestdale Primary School and Bletchley Park Primary School—

From the intersection of Ranford Road and Warton Road, south east along Ranford Road to Skeet Road (previously Hale Road), south west along Skeet Road to the junction with Nicholson Road and Mason Road, north west along Mason Road to Warton Road, and north east along Warton Road to Ranford Road. The boundary parts of Ranford Road (south west side), Skeet Road (both sides), Mason Road (both sides) and Warton Road (south east side) are included within this optional area.

CARRAMAR PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Wanneroo Road and Flynn Drive, north and east along Flynn Drive to the locality boundary between Banksia Grove and Carramar (as shown in the Perth 2007 StreetSmart street directory), south along this locality boundary to Joondalup Drive, south west along Joondalup Drive to Wanneroo Road and north along Wanneroo Road to Flynn Drive. The boundary parts of Flynn Drive (east and south sides), Joondalup Drive (north side) and Wanneroo Road (east side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

The locality of Neerabup is an optional area for Carramar Primary School, Neerabup Primary School and Wanneroo Primary School.

CLARKSON PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following will define the local-intake area of this school from 2009—

From the junction of Hester Avenue and Marmion Avenue, south along Marmion Avenue to Belleville Gardens, east along Belleville Gardens to Victorsen Parade, north along Victorsen Parade to Aldersea Circle, north along Aldersea Circle to Frawley Ramble, east along Frawley Ramble to Haskell Gardens, north and north east along Haskell Gardens and its north east extension to Connolly Drive, north east through Clarkson Community High School to the junction of Hannaford Avenue and Ormiston Gardens, north east along Ormiston Gardens and through Ormiston Park to Walyunga Boulevard, north along Walyunga Boulevard to Lenswood Retreat, east, south, and east along Lenswood Retreat and its easterly extension to the Mitchell Freeway, north along the Mitchell Freeway to Hester Avenue and west along Hester Avenue to Marmion Avenue.

The boundary parts of Marmion Avenue (east side), Belleville Gardens (north side), Elvina Rise (both sides), the Mitchell Freeway (west side) and Hester Avenue (south side) are included within the area for Clarkson Primary School. The boundary parts of Victorsen Parade (both sides), Aldersea Circle (both sides), Frawley Ramble (both sides), Haskell Gardens (both sides), Ormiston Gardens (both sides), Walyunga Boulevard (both sides) and Lenswood Retreat (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area of this school.

The following defines an optional area between Clarkson Primary School and Somerly Primary School—

From the junction of Aldersea Circle and Frawley Ramble, east along Frawley Ramble to Danaher Mews, south along Danaher Mews to its southern extremity, east to Connolly Drive, north along Connolly Drive to the southern boundary of the Clarkson Community High School site, east along the southern boundary of the high school site to Hannaford Avenue and continuing east along Elkington Mews and its easterly extension to Redbank Rise, east along Redbank Rise and its easterly extension to the Mitchell Freeway, north along the Mitchell Freeway to a point east of the easterly extension of Lenswood Retreat, west along this extension, and west, north and west along Lenswood Retreat to Walyunga Boulevard, south along Walyunga Boulevard to Ormiston Park, west through Ormiston Park to Ormiston Gardens, west along Ormiston Gardens to Hannaford Avenue, west through the Clarkson Community High School to Connolly Drive, west to Haskell Gardens, south west and south along Haskell Gardens to Frawley Ramble and west along Frawley Ramble to Aldersea Circle. The boundary parts of Frawley Ramble (both sides), Danaher Mews (both sides), Connolly Drive (west side), Elkington Mews (both sides), Redbank Rise (both sides), Mitchell Freeway (west side), Lenswood Retreat (both sides), Walyunga Boulevard (both sides), Ormiston Gardens (both sides) and Haskell Gardens (both sides) are included within this optional area.

COOLBINIA PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Wanneroo Road and Armadale Crescent, north west along Wanneroo Road to Daley Street, east along Daley Street to Flinders Street, south along Flinders Street to Swanston Street, east along Swanston Street to Latrobe Street, north along Latrobe Street to Wordsworth Avenue, east along Wordsworth Avenue to Alexander Drive, south and south west along Alexander Drive, to Melrose Crescent, north along Melrose Crescent to Dumbarton Crescent, north west along Dumbarton Crescent to Ardross Crescent, north along Ardross Crescent to

Lanark Street, north west along Lanark Street to Carnarvon Crescent, west and north west along Carnarvon Crescent to Armadale Crescent and north west and west along Armadale Crescent to Wanneroo Road.

The boundary parts of Wanneroo Road (east side), Daley Street (both sides), Flinders Street (west side), Swanston Street (both sides) and Alexander Drive (west side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Latrobe Street (both sides), Wordsworth Street (both sides), Melrose Crescent (both sides), Dumbarton Crescent (both sides), Ardross Crescent (both sides), Lanark Street (both sides), Carnarvon Crescent (both sides) and Armadale Crescent (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area of this school.

Students who reside in the following area have the option of attending either Coolbinia Primary School or Kyilla Primary School—

From the junction of Wanneroo Road and Armadale Crescent, south along Wanneroo Road to Walcott Street, south east along Walcott Street to Alexander Drive, north east along Alexander Drive to Melrose Crescent, north along Melrose Crescent to Dumbarton Crescent, north west along Dumbarton Crescent to Ardross Crescent, north along Ardross Crescent to Lanark Street, north west along Lanark Street to Carnarvon Crescent, west and north west along Carnarvon Crescent to Armadale Crescent, and north west and west along Armadale Crescent to Wanneroo Road. The boundary parts of Wanneroo Road (east side), Walcott Street (north east side), Alexander Drive (north west side), Melrose Crescent (both sides), Dumbarton Crescent (both sides), Ardross Crescent (both sides), Lanark Street (both sides), Carnarvon Crescent (both sides) and Armadale Crescent (both sides) are included within this optional area.

Students who reside in the following area have the option of attending either Coolbinia Primary School, Kyilla Primary School or Tuart Hill Primary School—

From the intersection of Green Street and London Street, east along Green Street to Wanneroo Road, north west along Wanneroo Road to London Street, and south west along London Street to Green Street. The boundary parts of Green Street (north side), Wanneroo Road (west side) and London Street (east side) are included within this optional area.

Students who reside in the following area have the option of attending either Mount Lawley Primary School or Coolbinia Primary School—

From the junction of Alexander Drive and Bradford Street, southeast along Bradford Street to Learoyd Street, southwest along Learoyd Street to Walcott Street, northwest along Walcott Street to Alexander Drive and northeast along Alexander Drive to Bradford Street. The boundary parts of Bradford Street (both sides), Alexander Drive (east side), Walcott Street (north side) and the boundary street of Learoyd Street (both sides) are included within this optional area.

CRAIGIE HEIGHTS PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Marmion Avenue and Craigie Drive, north east along Craigie Drive to Coyle Road, north east along Coyle Road and its north east extension to the intersection of Ocean Reef Road and the Mitchell Freeway, south along the Mitchell Freeway to Whitfords Avenue, west along Whitfords Avenue to Marmion Avenue, and north along Marmion Avenue to Craigie Drive. The boundary parts of Craigie Drive (south side), the Mitchell Freeway (west side), Whitfords Avenue (north side) and Marmion Avenue (east side) are included within this local-intake area. The boundary parts of Coyle Road (both sides) are excluded from this local-intake area.

CURTIN PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Manning Road and Davilak Crescent, east along Manning Road to Kent Street, north along Kent Street to Hayman Road, north west along Hayman Road to Thelma Street, west along Thelma Street (eastern section) and its western extension through Penrhos College to Thelma Street (western section), west along Thelma Street (western section) to Morrison Street, south along Morrison Street to Saunders Street (eastern section), west along Saunders Street to Baldwin Street, south along Baldwin Street to Saunders Street (western section), west along Saunders Street (western section) to Canning Highway, south west along Canning Highway to the western extension of McDougall Street, east along this extension and east along McDougall Street to and through McDougall Park to the junction of Bickley Crescent and Ley Street, south along Ley Street to Davilak Crescent, and east and south along Davilak Crescent to Manning Road.

The boundary parts of Manning Road (north side), Kent Street (west side), Hayman Road (south west side), Saunders Street (eastern and western sections, south side), Baldwin Street (south side), Canning Highway (east side) and Ley Street (east side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Thelma Street (eastern and western sections, both sides), Morrison Street (both sides), McDougall Street (both sides) and Davilak Crescent (both sides) are excluded from this local-intake area.

The following defines an optional area between Collier Primary School and Curtin Primary School—

From the intersection of Canning Highway and Thelma Street, east along Thelma Street to Morrison Street, south along Morrison Street to Saunders Street (eastern section), west along Saunders Street (eastern section) to Baldwin Street, south west along Baldwin Street to Saunders Street (western section), west along Saunders Street (western section) to Canning Highway and north east along Canning Highway to Thelma Street. The boundary parts of Morrison Street (both sides), Saunders Street (both eastern and western sections, north side), Baldwin Street

(north west side), and Canning Highway (east side) are included within this optional area. Thelma Street (both sides) is excluded from this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Curtin Primary School and Manning Primary School—

From the junction of Manning Road and Elderfield Road, south along Elderfield Road and its southern extension to the Canning River foreshore, generally east along the Canning River foreshore to a point due south of the South Entrance to Curtin University of Technology, north from this point on the Canning River foreshore to the junction of Manning Road and the South Entrance to Curtin University, and west from this junction to Elderfield Road. The boundary parts of Elderfield Road (east side) and Manning Road (south side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Curtin Primary School and Manning Primary School—

From the junction of Manning Road and Davilak Crescent, north and west along Davilak Crescent to Ley Street, north along Ley Street to the junction with Bickley Crescent, west from this junction through McDougall Park to McDougall Street, west along McDougall Street and its western extension to Canning Highway, south west along Canning Highway to the Kwinana Freeway, south along the Kwinana Freeway to Manning Road and east along Manning Road to Davilak Crescent. The boundary parts of Davilak Crescent (both sides), Ley Street (west side), McDougall Street (both sides), Kwinana Freeway (east side) and Manning Road (north side) are included within this optional area.

DAWSON PARK PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Berkshire Road and Bougainvillea Avenue, north east through the Forrestfield Senior High School site to Sultana Road East, north west along Sultana Road East to Bruce Road, east along Bruce Road to Brewer Road, north along Brewer Road to Ravenswood Road, west, north and north west along Ravenswood Road to Rhodes Place, north along Rhodes Place to its northern extremity, west from the northern extremity to the Roe Highway, south west along the Roe Highway to a point on the north west extension of Cypress Road, south east along this extension, and south east along Cypress Road to Sorrel Court, north east along Sorrel Court to its northern extremity, north west between Linden Way and Carissa Way, north east between Tarata Way and Carissa Way to the junction of Dawson Avenue and Juniper Way, north east along the western arm of Juniper Way and north east between Tallerack Way (on the west) and Calliandra Way (on the east) to the junction of Bougainvillea Avenue and Pyrus Way, north east along the western arm of Pyrus Way, continuing north east to and along the western arm of Coronilla Way and south east along Coronilla Way to Bougainvillea Avenue, and north east along Bougainvillea Avenue to Berkshire Road.

The boundary parts of Sultana Road East (south side), Bruce Road (north side), Brewer Road (west side), Roe Highway (east side), Cypress Road (north side), Linden Way (both sides), Tarata Way (both sides) and Tallerack Way (both sides) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Ravenswood Road (both sides), Rhodes Place (both sides), Sorrel Court (both sides), Carissa Way (both sides), Juniper Way (both sides), Pyrus Way (both sides), Coronilla Way (both sides) and Bougainvillea Avenue (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area of this school.

The following defines an optional area between Dawson Park Primary School and Woodlupine Primary School—

From the junction of Bougainvillea Avenue and Pyrus Way, north east along the western arm of Pyrus Way, continuing north east to and along the western arm of Coronilla Way and south east along Coronilla Way to Bougainvillea Avenue, south west and north west along Bougainvillea Avenue to Pyrus Way. The boundary parts of Pyrus Way (both sides) and Coronilla Way (both sides) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Bougainvillea Avenue (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Maida Vale Primary School, Dawson Park Primary School and Woodlupine Primary School—

From the junction of Hawtin Road and Kent Road, south along Hawtin Road to Sultana Road East, west and north west along Sultana Road East to Bruce Road, east along Bruce Road to Brewer Road, north along Brewer Road to Kent Road and east along Kent Road to Hawtin Road. The boundary parts of Hawtin Road (west side), Sultana Road East (north side), Bruce Road (south side), Brewer Road (east side) and Kent Road (south side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Maida Vale Primary School and Dawson Park Primary School—

All of Ravenswood Road (both sides) and all of Rhodes Place (both sides).

The following defines an optional area between Forrestfield, Dawson Park and Woodlupine Primary Schools—

From the intersection of Tonkin Highway and Hale Road, northeast along Hale Road to Cypress Road, northwest along Cypress Road and its extension to Roe Highway, southwest along Roe Highway to Tonkin Highway, and southeast along Tonkin Highway to Hale Road. The boundary parts of Hale Road (north west side), Roe Highway (south east side) and Tonkin Highway (north east side) are included within the optional area, while the boundary street of Cypress Road (both sides) is excluded from the optional area.

EAST WANNEROO PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Wanneroo Road and Dundebur Road, east along Dundebur Road to Griffiths Road, north along Griffiths Road and continuing north, west, and north along the locality boundary between Sinagra and Wanneroo to Caporn Street, east along Caporn Street to Franklin Street, south along Franklin Street to Trichet Road, east along Trichet Road to Hawkins Road, south along Hawkins Road to Badgerup Road, south along Badgerup Road to Jambanis Road, west along Jambanis Road to Benmuni Road, north along Benmuni Road to Elliot Road, west along Elliot Road to Wanneroo Road and north along Wanneroo Road to Dundebur Road. The boundary parts of Dundebur Road (south side), Griffiths Road (east side), Caporn Street (south side), Franklin Street (west side), Trichet Road (south side), Hawkins Road (west side), Badgerup Road (west side), Elliot Road (north side) and Wanneroo Road (east side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Jambanis Road (both sides) and Benmuni Road (both sides) are excluded from this local-intake area.

The localities of Jandabup and Sinagra are optional areas for East Wanneroo Primary School and Wanneroo Primary School.

The locality of Gnangara is an optional area for Ashdale Primary School, East Wanneroo Primary School and Landsdale Primary School.

EDNEY PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Maida Vale Road and the Roe Highway north along the Roe Highway to Kalamunda Road, west northwest along Kalamunda Road to Range Court, south along Range Court to Range View Road, southwest along Range View Road to the south western boundary of Range View Park, northwest along this boundary to JeanHulley Road, southwest along JeanHulley Road to Wycombe Road, northwest along Wycombe Road to Norling Road, southwest along Norling Road to Kiandra Way, west along Kiandra Way to Cassowary Road, south from this point to and along Finch Court to Newburn Road west along Newburn Road to Butcher Road, south southwest and south along Butcher Road to Palmer Crescent west along Palmer Crescent to Norton Road, south from this point to the southern extremity of Kestral Court, northwest along Kestral Court to Palmer Crescent, southwest along Palmer Crescent to the junction with Mack Street, south west to the northern extremity of Everitt Place, south along Everitt Place to Maida Vale Road, west along Maida Vale Road to Dundas Road, south along Dundas Road to Berkshire Road, east along Berkshire Road to Milner Road, north east along Milner Road to Sultana Road West, south east along Sultana Road West and its south easterly extension to the Roe Highway and north along the Roe Highway to Maida Vale Road.

The boundary parts of the Roe Highway (west side), Wycombe Road (both sides), Norling Road (both sides), Kiandra Way (both sides), Newburn Road (both sides), Maida Vale Road (south side), Dundas Road (both sides), Sultana Road West (both sides) and the boundary streets of Range Court, Range View Road, JeanHulley Road, Finch Court and Everitt Place (both sides in each case), are included within the area for Edney Primary School. The boundary parts of Kalamunda Road (both sides), Butcher Road (both sides), Palmer Crescent (both sides), Berkshire Road (both sides), Milner Road (both sides) and the boundary street of Kestral Court (both sides) are excluded from the area for Edney Primary School.

The following defines an optional area between Edney and High Wycombe Primary Schools—

From the junction of Dundas Road and Sorensen Road, north east along Sorensen Road to Newburn Road, south east along Newburn Road to Butcher Road, south along Butcher Road to Palmer Crescent, west along Palmer Crescent (including Kestral Court) to the junction with Mack Close, south west to the northern extremity of Everitt Place, south along Everitt Place to Maida Vale Road, west along Maida Vale Road to Dundas Road, and north along Dundas Road to Sorensen Road. The boundary parts of Sorensen Road (both sides), Newburn Road (both sides), Butcher Road (both sides), Palmer Crescent (both sides), Kestral Court (both sides) and Dundas Road (both sides) are included within this local intake-area. The boundary parts of Mack Place (both sides) and Everitt Place (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Edney and High Wycombe Primary Schools—

From the junction of Kalamunda Road and Kenneth Road, north east along Kenneth Road and its north east extension between the following two streets on the west (Treen Close and Larwood Crescent) and Lambertina Crescent (on the east) to Adelaide Street, south east along Adelaide Street to Roe Highway, south along Roe Highway to Kalamunda Road and north west along Kalamunda Road to Kenneth Road. The boundary parts of Kenneth Road (both sides), Lambertina Crescent (both sides), Adelaide Street (both sides) Roe Highway (west side) and Kalamunda Road (both sides) are included in this optional area. The boundary parts of Treen Close (both sides) and Larwood Crescent (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Edney Primary School and Dawson Park Primary School—

From the junction of Dundas Road and Berkshire Road, east along Berkshire Road to Milner Road, north east along Milner Road to Sultana Road West, south east along Sultana Road West and its south easterly extension to the Roe Highway, south west along the Roe Highway to the Tonkin Highway, north west along the Tonkin Highway to Dundas Road and north along Dundas Road to Berkshire Road. The boundary parts of Berkshire Road (both sides), Milner Road (both sides), Roe Highway (west side), Tonkin Highway (north east side) and Dundas Road (both sides) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Sultana Road West (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

ELLEN STIRLING PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of The Broadway and The Promenade, east along The Promenade and continuing north east along Millhouse Road to a point due south of the western end of Trilogy Court, north from Millhouse Road to the western end of Trilogy Court, and continuing north to the junction of Bordeaux Lane and Farnborough Parkway, east along Bordeaux Lane to Vines Avenue, north along Vines Avenue to Cardinal Drive, north west along Cardinal Drive to Barbera Lane, generally north along Barbera Lane to the junction with Vines Avenue, north from this junction through Chardonnay Park to Maralla Road, west along Maralla Road to the future Perth-Darwin Highway route, south west along the future Perth-Darwin Highway route to a point due north of the intersection of the Transit Corridor and Farmaner Parkway, south to this junction and south west along the Transit Corridor to Galatea Pass, south east along Galatea Pass to The Broadway and south along The Broadway to The Promenade.

The boundary parts of The Promenade (north side), Millhouse Road (north side), Bordeaux Lane (north side) and The Broadway (east side) are included within this local-intake area. The boundary parts of Trilogy Court (both sides), Vines Avenue (both sides), Cardinal Drive (both sides), Barbera Lane (both sides), Maralla Road (both sides) and Galatea Pass (both sides) are excluded from this local-intake area.

The following defines an optional area between Upper Swan Primary School and Ellen Stirling Primary School—

From the junction of West Swan Road and Millhouse Road, south west along West Swan Road to the locality boundary between Belhus and Ellenbrook, north along this locality boundary to the dam at Corona Park, east from this dam to Corona Way, north along Corona Way to Millhouse Road, west along Millhouse Road to a point due south of the western end of Trilogy Court, north from Millhouse Road to the western end of Trilogy Court, and continuing north to Bordeaux Lane, east along Bordeaux Lane to Vines Avenue, north along Vines Avenue to Cardinal Drive, north west along Cardinal Drive to Barbera Lane, generally north along Barbera Lane to the junction with Vines Avenue, north from this junction through Chardonnay Park to Maralla Road, east along Maralla Road to the railway line, south east along the railway line to the locality boundary between The Vines and Upper Swan, west and south along this locality boundary to Ellen Brook, south and west along Ellen Brook to Millhouse Road and south along Millhouse Road to West Swan Road.

The boundary parts of West Swan Road (north side), Corona Way (both sides), Millhouse Road (western section, north side), Trilogy Court (both sides), Bordeaux Lane (south side), Vines Avenue (both sides), Cardinal Drive (both sides), Barbera Lane (both sides), Millhouse Road (eastern section, both sides) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Maralla Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

ELLENBROOK PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Gnangara Road and Pinaster Parade, north and north east along Pinaster Parade to The Promenade, east along The Promenade and its extension into Millhouse Road, north east along Millhouse Road to Corona Way, south along Corona Way to a point due east of the dam on the locality boundary between Belhus and Ellenbrook, west to the dam and south along the locality boundary to Ellen Brook, continuing south along Ellen Brook to the Swan River, west from the confluence of Ellen Brook and the Swan River to the eastern end of Henry Street, west along Henry Street to Gnangara Road and west along Gnangara Road to Pinaster Parade.

The boundary parts of Pinaster Parade (east side), The Promenade (south side), Millhouse Road (south side), Henry Street (both sides) and Gnangara Road (north side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

The following is an optional area between Ellenbrook Primary School, Caversham Primary School and Upper Swan Primary School : The locality of Henley Brook west of the Swan River as delineated in the 2008 Perth StreetSmart Directory.

EXCELSIOR PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Amherst Street and Katrine Parade, south east along Amherst Road to the intersection with Campbell Road, south through the public open space and lakes—with the following three streets on the east—Corsham Gardens, Ladham Turn, Welbeck Road and Repton Loop, and the following two streets on the west—Prior Close and Sandringham Promenade—to the intersection of Sandringham Promenade and Welbeck Road, south east along Sandringham Promenade to Warton Road, north east along Warton Road to Garden Street, north west along Garden Street to Clipper Parade, south west along Clipper Parade to Gateway Boulevard, north west along Gateway Boulevard to Barents Road, south west along Barents Road to Bering Promenade, south east along Bering Promenade to Becher Avenue, south west along Becher Avenue to Shreeve Road, continuing south west across the public open space to the junction of Katrine Parade and Cannich Boulevard, south and south west along Katrine Parade to Amherst Road.

The boundary parts of Amherst Road (north east side), Corsham Gardens (both sides), Ladham Turn (both sides), Welbeck Road (both sides), Repton Loop (both sides), Warton Road (north west side), Garden Street (south west side), Clipper Parade (both sides), Gateway Boulevard (west side), Bering Promenade (both sides), Becher Avenue (both sides) and Katrine Parade (south east side) are

included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Prior Close (both sides), Sandringham Promenade (both sides) and Barents Road (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area of this school.

FALCON PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the entry of the Dawesville Channel into the Indian Ocean, north along the coastline to Rakoa Street, south east along Rakoa Street and its south easterly extension through the Falcon Reserve to the Old Coast Road, south west along the Old Coast Road to Rebecca Place, east along Rebecca Place and its easterly extension to the Peel Inlet, generally south and south west along the western shoreline of the Peel Inlet to the Dawesville Channel and north west along the Dawesville Channel to the Indian Ocean. The boundary parts of Rakoa Street (both sides), the Old Coast Road (west side) and Rebecca Place (both sides) are included within the local-intake area of Falcon Primary School.

FORRESTDAL E PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Mason Road and Warton Road, south west along Warton Road to Armadale Road, west along Armadale Road to Liddelow Road, south along Liddelow Road to Rowley Road, east along Rowley Road to De Haer Road, south along De Haer Road to the more southern of the two junctions with Leslie Road, south from this point on De Haer to the locality boundary between Anketell and Oakford on Anketell Road, east along Anketell Road to Thomas Road, north east and east along Thomas Road to the Birriga Drain, north and east along the Birriga Drain to Kargotich Road, north east along Kargotich Road to Rowley Road, east along Rowley Road (and including the feeder street of Lentara Place) to Hopkinson Road, north from this point to Forrest Road, west and north west along Forrest Road to Twelfth Road, north north east along Twelfth Road to Armadale Road, west along Armadale Road to a point coinciding with the extension of Brigade Road, north east from this point to and along Brigade Road and its extension to Lake Road, north east along Lake Road to the locality boundary between Armadale and Westfield, north west along this locality boundary to the local authority boundary between the cities of Armadale and Gosnells, south west along this local authority boundary to Ranford Road, and north west along Ranford Road to Skeet Road (previously Hale Road), south west along Skeet Road to Mason Road and north west along Mason Road to Warton Road.

The boundary parts of Warton Road (both sides, between Mason Road and Armadale Road), Armadale Road (south side), Liddelow Road (east side), Rowley Road (western section, north side), De Haer Road (east side), Anketell Road (north side), Leslie Road (both sides), Forrest Road (south west side), Twelfth Road (both sides), Armadale Road (south side), Ranford Road (south west side) and are included within the area for Forrestdale Primary School. The boundary parts of Thomas Road (both sides), Kargotich Road (both sides), Rowley Road (eastern section, both sides), Hopkinson Road (both sides), Lake Road (both sides) and the boundary streets of Lentara Place (both sides), Brigade Road (both sides), Skeet Road (both sides) and Mason Road (both sides) are excluded from the area for Forrestdale Primary School.

The following defines an optional area for Atwell and Forrestdale Primary Schools—

From the junction of Armadale Road and Warton Road, north east along Warton Road to Jankdakot Road, north west along Jandakot Road to Fraser Road, south west along Fraser Road to Armadale Road and south east along Armadale Road to Warton Road. The boundary parts of Jandakot Road (south side), Fraser Road (east side) and Armadale Road (north side) are included in this optional area. The boundary parts of Warton Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Forrestdale and Marri Grove Primary Schools—

From the junction of Hopkinson Road and Rowley Road, west along Rowley Road (and including Lentara Place) to Kargotich Road, south west along Kargotich Road to the Birriga Drain, in a general easterly direction along the Birriga Drain to Hopkinson Road, and north along Hopkinson Road to Rowley Road. The boundary parts of Rowley Road (both sides), Kargotich Road (both sides), Hopkinson Road (both sides) and the boundary street of Lentara Place (both sides) are included within the optional area.

The following defines an optional area for Forrestdale and Ranford Primary Schools—

From the intersection of Nicholson Road and Warton Road, north along Nicholson Road to Acourt Road, north west along Acourt Road to Fraser Road, south west along Fraser Road to Jandakot Road, south east along Jandakot Road to Warton Road, and north east along Warton Road to Nicholson Road. The boundary parts of Fraser Road (east side) and Jandakot Road (north side) are included within this optional area, while the boundary parts of Nicholson Road (both sides), Acourt Road (both sides) and Warton Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area. Any child living outside the main catchment area or the optional area for Forrestdale Primary Schools and whose area of residence is served by a bus to Forrestdale Primary School, will not be excluded from attending that school. In the event, however, than any such service is discontinued, transport to Forrestdale Primary School will become a parental responsibility.

The following defines an optional area between the following primary schools—Calista, Forrestdale, Medina, North Parmelia, Orelia and Wattleup—

From the junction of Anketell Road and Thomas Road, south west along Thomas Road to the locality boundary between Anketell and Oakford, north along this locality boundary to Anketell Road and east along Anketell Road to Thomas Road. The boundary parts of Anketell (south side)

are included within this optional area, and the boundary parts of Thomas Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Forrestdale Primary School and Bletchley Park Primary School—

From the intersection of Ranford Road and Warton Road, south east along Ranford Road to Skeet Road (previously Hale Road), south west along Skeet Road to the junction with Nicholson Road and Mason Road, north west along Mason Road to Warton Road, and north east along Warton Road to Ranford Road. The boundary parts of Ranford Road (south west side), Skeet Road (both sides), Mason Road (both sides) and Warton Road (south east side) are included within this optional area.

GLENCOE PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of the Old Coast Road and Peelwood Parade, south west along the Old Coast Road to a point north west of the junction of Wattleglen Avenue and Eskdale Court, south east to this junction, south west along Wattleglen Avenue to the eastern arm of Silverton Crescent, south along the eastern arm of Silverton Crescent and its southern extension to the shoreline of the Peel Inlet, north east along the shoreline of the Peel Inlet to the Mandurah Estuary, north along the shoreline of the Mandurah Estuary to the Indian Ocean, south west along the coastline of the Indian Ocean to a point north west of the junction of Peelwood Parade and McLarty Road, south east from the coastline to this junction, south east along Peelwood Parade to the Old Coast Road.

The boundary parts of Old Coast Road (south east side) and Peelwood Parade (north east side) are included within the local-intake area for Glencoe Primary School.

The boundary parts of Eskdale Court (both sides), Wattleglen Avenue (both sides) and Silverton Crescent (eastern arm, both sides) are excluded from this local-intake area.

GREENWOOD PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Hepburn Avenue and Wanneroo Road, south along Wanneroo Road to Warwick Road, west along Warwick Road to Allenswood Road, north along Allenswood Road to Hepburn Avenue and east along Hepburn Avenue to Wanneroo Road. The boundary parts of Wanneroo Road (west side), Warwick Road (north side), Allenswood Road (east side) and Hepburn Avenue (south side) are included within this local-intake area.

The following defines an optional area between Greenwood Primary School and West Greenwood Primary School—

From the junction of Hepburn Avenue and Allenswood Road, west along Hepburn Avenue to a point midway between the eastern arm of Wirilda Crescent and the western arm of Crossandra Way, south from this point between Wirilda Crescent and Crossandra Way to the junction of Blackall Drive and Wirilda Crescent, south east along Blackall Drive to the western arm of Peppermint Drive, south along Peppermint Drive to the north-south bike path, south along the north-south bike path to Coolibah Drive, south east along Coolibah Drive to Redgum Street, south along Redgum Street to Callistemon Street, west along Callistemon Street to Sheoak Street, south along Sheoak Street and its southern extension through Sheoak Park to Warwick Road, east along Warwick Road to Allenswood Road and north along Allenswood Road to Hepburn Avenue. The boundary parts of Hepburn Avenue (south side), Crossandra Way (both sides), Blackall Drive (north east side), Peppermint Drive (both sides), Coolibah Drive (north east side), Redgum Street (both sides), Callistemon Street (south side), Sheoak Street (both sides), Warwick Road (north side) and Allenswood Road (west side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Wirilda Crescent (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The following defines an optional area for Greenwood Primary School, Glendale Primary School and Hawker Park Primary School—

From the junction of Badrick Street and Beach Road, east along Beach Road to Wanneroo Road, north along Wanneroo Road to Warwick Road, west along Warwick Road to Ballantine Road, south and southwest along Ballantine Road to Dorchester Avenue, southeast along Dorchester Avenue to Badrick Street and south along Badrick Street to Beach Road. The boundary parts of Beach Road (north side), Wanneroo Road (west side), Warwick Road (south side), Dorchester Avenue (both sides), and the boundary streets of Ballantine Road (both sides) and Badrick Street (both sides) are included within the optional area.

GUILDFORD PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake of this school—

From the point where the locality boundary between the localities of Guildford and Woodbridge meets the Swan River (near the Woodbridge historic house), south along the locality boundary between Guildford and Woodbridge to the railway line, west along the railway line to its junction with the north-south railway line at a point just west of the Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline Corridor, south along the railway line to the Great Eastern Highway Bypass, west along the Great Eastern Highway Bypass and Great Eastern Highway to Ivy Street, north west along Ivy Street to the Swan River and generally north east along the Swan River to the locality boundary between the localities of Guildford and Woodbridge.

The boundary parts of the Great Eastern Highway Bypass (north side) and Great Eastern Highway (north west side) are included within the local-intake area for Guildford Primary School. The boundary parts of Ivy Street (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area for Guildford Primary School.

HALLS HEAD PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of The Old Coast Road and Peelwood Parade, south west along the Old Coast Road to a point on the south east extension of Lambourne Place, north west from this point to the junction of Lambourne Place and Templetonia Promenade, north west between Lambourne Place and Staunton Rise, north east between Japonica Heights and Wintersweet Place, south west along Japonica Heights to Floribunda Avenue, north along Floribunda Avenue to Heather Gardens, north west along Heather Gardens to Buttercup Parkway, north east and north west along Buttercup Parkway to and across Boardwalk Boulevard and north west to the Indian Ocean coastline, north east along the coastline to a point north west of the junction of Peelwood Parade and McLarty Road, south east from the coastline to this junction, south east along Peelwood Parade to the Old Coast Road. The boundary parts of The Old Coast Road (north side), Staunton Rise (both sides), Wintersweet Place (both sides), Heather Gardens (both sides), Buttercup Parkway (both sides) and Peelwood Parade (south west side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Lambourne Place (both sides), Japonica Heights (both sides) and Floribunda Avenue (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area of this school.

HIGHGATE PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Vincent Street and Fitzgerald Street, east along Vincent Street to William Street, north and north east along William Street to Walcott Street, south east along Walcott Street to Lord Street, north east along Guildford Road through the subway to East Parade, south along East Parade to Pakenham Street, south east along Pakenham Street and its south easterly extension to the Swan River foreshore, south and generally west along the Swan River foreshore to the Narrows Bridge, north along the Mitchell Freeway to Wellington Street, west along Wellington Street to Sutherland Street, north along Sutherland Street to the Mitchell Freeway, east along the Mitchell Freeway to the Charles Street off-ramp, north along the Charles Street off-ramp and Charles Street to Cowle Street, south east along Cowle Street to Fitzgerald Street, and north east along Fitzgerald Street to Vincent Street. The boundary parts of Vincent Street (south side), William Street (east side), Walcott Street (south west side), Wellington Street (north side), Sutherland Street (east side), Charles Street (east side) and Fitzgerald Street (east side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Guildford Road (both sides), Pakenham Street (both sides) and Cowle Street (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area of this school.

Students who reside in the following area have the option of attending either Highgate Primary School or North Perth Primary School—

From the intersection of Charles Street and Vincent Street, east along Vincent Street to Fitzgerald Street, south west along Fitzgerald Street to Cowle Street, north west along Cowle Street to Charles Street and north along Charles Street to Vincent Street. The boundary parts of Vincent Street (south side), Fitzgerald Street (north west side), Cowle Street (both sides) and Charles Street (east side) are included within this optional area.

HOCKING PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Wanneroo Road and Elliot Road, east along Elliot Road to Benmuni Road, south along Benmuni Road to Jambanis Road, east along Jambanis Road to Badgerup Road, south along Badgerup Road to the locality boundary of Wangara, west along the locality boundary of Wangara to Ocean Reef Road, continuing west along Ocean Reef Road to Wanneroo Road and north along Wanneroo Road to Elliot Road. The boundary parts of Elliot Road (south side), Benmuni Road (both sides), Jambanis Road (both sides), Badgerup Road (west side), Ocean Reef Road (north side) and Wanneroo Road (east side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

JANDAKOT PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Beeliar Drive and the Kwinana Freeway, south along the Kwinana Freeway to Rowley Road, west along Rowley Road and continuing west along the local government boundary between the City of Cockburn and the Town of Kwinana to Mandogalup Road, north along Mandogalup Road and its northern extension to Russell Road, east along Russell Road to a point due south of the centre of Kogolup Lake, north from this point on Russell Road through Thompsons Lake and Kogolup Lake to Beeliar Drive, east along Beeliar Drive to a point due south of the junction of North Lake Road and Osprey Drive, north to a point on the western extension of Yangebup Road (eastern section), east along this extension to Yangebup Road, east along Yangebup Road to Cooper Road, east and south east along Cooper Road to Poletti Road, south along Poletti Road to Beeliar Drive and east along Beeliar Drive to the Kwinana Freeway. The boundary parts of the Kwinana Freeway (west side), Rowley Road (north side), Mandogalup Road (east side), Russell Road (south side), Beeliar Drive (western section, south side), Yangebup Road (south side), Cooper Road (south side), Poletti Road (west side) and Beeliar Drive (south side, eastern section) are included within the area for this school.

The following defines an optional area for Jandakot Primary School and Orelia Primary School—

From the intersection of the Kwinana Freeway and Rowley Road, south along the Kwinana Freeway to Anketell Road, west along Anketell Road to Clementi Road, north from this junction to Madogolup Road, north west along Madogolup Road to the local government boundary between the City of Cockburn and the Town of Kwinana, east along this local government boundary to

Rowley Road, and continuing east along Rowley Road to the Kwinana Freeway. The boundary parts of the Kwinana Freeway (west side), Anketell Road (north side), Mandogolup Road (east side) and Rowley Road (south side) are included in this optional area.

Students who reside in the following area have an option to attend either Coolbinia Primary School, Kyilla Primary School or Tuart Hill Primary School—

From the intersection of Green Street and London Street, east along Green Street to Wanneroo Road, north west along Wanneroo Road to London Street, and south west along London Street to Green Street. The boundary parts of Green Street (north side), Wanneroo Road (west side) and London Street (east side) are included within this optional area.

Students who reside in the following area have the option of attending either Coolbinia Primary School or Kyilla Primary School—

From the junction of Wanneroo Road and Armadale Crescent, south along Wanneroo Road to Walcott Street, south east along Walcott Street to Alexander Drive, north east along Alexander Drive to Melrose Crescent, north along Melrose Crescent to Dumbarton Crescent, north west along Dumbarton Crescent to Ardross Crescent, north along Ardross Crescent to Lanark Street, north west along Lanark Street to Carnarvon Crescent, west and north west along Carnarvon Crescent to Armadale Crescent, and north west and west along Armadale Crescent to Wanneroo Road. The boundary parts of Wanneroo Road (east side), Walcott Street (north east side), Alexander Drive (north west side), Melrose Crescent (both sides), Dumbarton Crescent (both sides), Ardross Crescent (both sides), Lanark Street (both sides), Carnarvon Crescent (both sides) and Armadale Crescent (both sides) are included within this optional area.

MADELEY PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following will define the local-intake area of this school when it opens in 2009—

From the junction of Wanneroo Road and Ocean Reef Road, east along Ocean Reef Road to Hartman Drive, south along Hartman Drive to Gngara Road, continuing south along the proposed alignment of Hartman Drive to Hepburn Avenue, west along Hepburn Avenue to Wanneroo Road and north along Wanneroo Road to Ocean Reef Road. The boundary parts of Hartman Road (west side), the proposed Hartman Drive (west side), Hepburn Avenue (north side) and Wanneroo Road (east side) are included within the local-intake area of this primary school. The boundary parts of Ocean Reef Road (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area of this primary school.

MANNING PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The boundary parts of Manning Road (south side) and Elderfield Road (west side) are included within this local-intake area.

The following defines an optional area between Curtin Primary School and Manning Primary School—

From the junction of Manning Road and Elderfield Road, south along Elderfield Road and its southern extension to the Canning River foreshore, generally east along the Canning River foreshore to a point due south of the South Entrance to Curtin University of Technology, north from this point on the Canning River foreshore to the junction of Manning Road and the South Entrance to Curtin University, and west from this junction to Elderfield Road. The boundary parts of Elderfield Road (east side) and Manning Road (south side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Curtin Primary School and Manning Primary School—

From the junction of Manning Road and Davilak Crescent, north and west along Davilak Crescent to Ley Street, north along Ley Street to the junction with Bickley Crescent, west from this junction through McDougall Park to McDougall Street, west along McDougall Street and its western extension to Canning Highway, south west along Canning Highway to the Kwinana Freeway, south along the Kwinana Freeway to Manning Road and east along Manning Road to Davilak Crescent. The boundary parts of Davilak Crescent (both sides), Ley Street (west side), McDougall Street (both sides), Kwinana Freeway (east side) and Manning Road (north side) are included within this optional area.

The boundary parts of Roland Road (east side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Cameron Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The following is an optional area for Glen Forrest, Mundaring and Parkerville Primary Schools—

From the junction of Great Eastern Highway and Craven Road, south along Craven Road to Jacoby Street, east along Jacoby Street to Coppin Road, south along Coppin Road to Phillips Road, west along Phillips Road and its westward extension to the junction of Homestead Road and Strettle Road, west along Strettle Road to Brooking Road, north along Brooking Road to Great Eastern Highway and east along Great Eastern Highway to Craven Road. The boundary parts of Craven Road (both sides), Jacoby Street (both sides), Phillips Road (both sides), Strettle Road (both sides), Brooking Road (both sides) and Great Eastern Highway (south side) are included within this optional area. The boundary part of Coppin Road (both sides) is excluded from this local-intake area.

The boundary parts of Vincent Street (north side), William Street (west side), Walcott Street (south west side), Alexander Drive (east side), Charles Street (west side), Loftus Street (east side), Mitchell Freeway (north side), Charles Street off-ramp (west side) and Charles Street (west side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Mabel Street (both sides) and Haynes Street (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area of this school.

Students who reside in the following area have the option of attending either Highgate Primary School or North Perth Primary School—

From the intersection of Charles Street and Vincent Street, east along Vincent Street to Fitzgerald Street, south west along Fitzgerald Street to Cowle Street, north west along Cowle Street to Charles Street and north along Charles Street to Vincent Street. The boundary parts of Vincent Street (south side), Fitzgerald Street (north west side), Cowle Street (both sides) and Charles Street (east side) are included within this optional area.

Students who reside in the following area have the option of attending either North Perth Primary School or West Leederville Primary School—

From the intersection of Oxford Street and Richmond Street, east along Richmond Street to Loftus Street, north along Loftus Street to Salisbury Street, west along Salisbury Street to Oxford Street, and south along Oxford Street to Richmond Street. The boundary parts of Richmond Street (north side), Loftus Street (west side) and Oxford Street (east side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Salisbury Street (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

OSBORNE PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Scarborough Beach Road and Main Street, north along Main Street to Swan Street, west along Swan Street to Hamilton Street, north along Hamilton Street to Karrinyup Road, west along Karrinyup Road to Telford Crescent, south west along Telford Crescent to the Mitchell Freeway, south east and south along the Mitchell Freeway to Scarborough Beach Road, and east along Scarborough Beach Road to Main Street. The boundary parts of Main Street (east side), Swan Street (south side), Karrinyup Road (south side), Mitchell Freeway (north and east sides) and Scarborough Beach Road (north side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Hamilton Street (both sides) and Telford Crescent (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area of this school.

The following defines an optional area for West Balcatta Primary School, Balcatta Primary School and Osborne Primary School—

From the intersection of Karrinyup Road and the Mitchell Freeway, south and southeast along the Mitchell Freeway to a point coinciding with the southern extension of Telford Crescent, north northeast to and along Telford Crescent to Karrinyup Road and in a general westerly direction along Karrinyup Road to the Mitchell Freeway. The boundary parts of the Mitchell Freeway (east and northeast sides), Telford Crescent (both sides) and Karrinyup Road (south side) are included within the optional area.

The boundary parts of Brooking Road (both sides), Hedges Road (both sides), Oxley Road (both sides), Park Road (both sides) and Great Eastern Highway (north side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area for Glen Forrest, Mundaring and Parkerville Primary Schools—

From the junction of Great Eastern Highway and Craven Road, south along Craven Road to Jacoby Street, east along Jacoby Street to Coppin Road, south along Coppin Road to Phillips Road, west along Phillips Road and its westward extension to the junction of Homestead Road and Strettle Road, west along Strettle Road to Brooking Road, north along Brooking Road to Great Eastern Highway and east along Great Eastern Highway to Craven Road. The boundary parts of Craven Road (both sides), Jacoby Street (both sides), Phillips Road (both sides), Strettle Road (both sides), Brooking Road (both sides) and Great Eastern Highway (south side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Mirrabooka Avenue (west side), Beach Road (north side), Girrawheen Avenue (east side) and Marangaroo Drive (south side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

The following will define the local-intake area of this school when it opens in 2009—

From the intersection of Marmion Avenue and the locality boundary between Clarkson and Tamala Park, north along Marmion Avenue to Belleville Gardens, east along Belleville Gardens to Victorsen Parade, north along Victorsen Parade to Aldersea Circle, north along Aldersea Circle to Frawley Ramble, east along Frawley Ramble to Danaher Mews, south along Danaher Mews to its southern extremity, east to Connolly Drive, north along Connolly Drive to the southern boundary of the Clarkson Community High School site, east along the southern boundary of the high school site to Hannaford Avenue and continuing east along Elkington Mews and its easterly extension to Redbank Rise, east along Redbank Rise and its easterly extension to the Mitchell Freeway, south along the Mitchell Freeway to the locality boundary between Clarkson and Tamala Park and west along this locality boundary to Marmion Avenue.

The boundary parts of Marmion Avenue (east side), Belleville Gardens (south side) and Mitchell Freeway (west side) are included within this local-intake area. From the junction of Green Street and Main Street, east along Green Street to Tyler Street, north along Tyler Street and its northern extension through the Robinson Reserve to the northern section of Tyler Street, north along the northern section of Tyler Street to Swan Street, west along Swan Street to Main Street and south along Main Street to Green Street. The boundary parts of Green Street (north side), Tyler Street (west side, northern and southern sections), Swan Street (south side) and Main Street (east side).

The following defines an optional area between Nollamara Primary School and Tuart Hill Primary School—

From the intersection of Morley Drive and Wanneroo Road, east along Morley Drive to Flinders Street, south along Flinders Street to Swan Street, west along Swan Street to Wanneroo Road and north along Wanneroo Road to Morley Drive. The boundary parts of Morley Drive (south side), Flinders Street (west side), Swan Street (north side) and Wanneroo Road (east side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Coolbinia Primary School, Kyilla Primary School and Tuart Hill Primary School—

From the intersection of Green Street and London Street, east along Green Street to Wanneroo Road, north west along Wanneroo Road to London Street, and south west along London Street to Green Street. The boundary parts of Green Street (north side), Wanneroo Road (west side) and London Street (east side) are included within this optional area.

WANNEROO PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Wanneroo Road and Ocean Reef Road, north along Wanneroo Road to Joondalup Drive, west along Joondalup Drive to the local government boundary between the City of Joondalup and the City of Wanneroo, south along the local government boundary to Ocean Reef Road and east along Ocean Reef Road to Wanneroo Road. The boundary parts of Wanneroo Road (west side), Joondalup Drive (south side) and Ocean Reef Road (north side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

The following defines an optional area between Tapping Primary School and Wanneroo Primary School—

From the junction of Wanneroo Road and Pinjar Road, north east along Pinjar Road to the eastern extension of Castagno Approach, west along this extension and west along Castagno Approach to Yanez Lane, continuing west along Yanez Lane to Carosa Road, north along Carosa Road to Monet Drive, west along Monet Drive to Wanneroo Road and south west along Wanneroo Road to Pinjar Road. The boundary parts of Pinjar Road (west side), Castagno Approach (both sides), Yanez Lane (both sides), Carosa Road (both sides), Monet Drive (both sides) and Wanneroo Road (east side) are included within this optional area.

The locality of Mariginiup is an optional area for Neerabup Primary School, Tapping Primary School and Wanneroo Primary School.

The locality of Neerabup is an optional area for Carramar Primary School, Neerabup Primary School and Wanneroo Primary School.

The localities of Jandabup and Sinagra are optional areas for East Wanneroo Primary School and Wanneroo Primary School.

From the junction of Delawney Street and Odin Drive, south southwest along Odin Drive and its extension to Karrinyup Road, east and southeast along Karrinyup Road to Jones Street, northeast along Jones Street to the easterly extension of Lowen Place, west to and along Lowen Place to Drew Street, north along Drew Street to Woodhall Street, east along Woodhall Street to Rance Street, north along Rance Street to Poincaire Street, west along Poincaire Street to the eastern boundary of Balcatta Senior High School site, north along this boundary to Amelia Street, east along Amelia Street to Kexby Street, north and west along Kexby Street to Buckle Street, north along Buckley Street to Attra Street, west along Attra Street to Cadd Street, north along Cadd Street to Knowles Street, west along Knowles Street to its western extremity, northeast from this point to Fontaine Street, northeast and north along Fontaine Street to Campsbourne Street, west along Campsbourne Street to its junction with Belham Way, due north from this point to Delawney Street and west along Delawney Street to Odin Drive.

The boundary parts of Karrinyup Road (north side), Jones Street (both sides), Drew Street (west side), Woodhall Street (north side), Poincaire Street (south side), Amelia Street (north side), Kexby Street (west and south sides), Attra Street (south side), Campsbourne Street (south side), Delawney Street (south side), and the boundary streets of Odin Drive (east side), Lowen Place (south side), Rance Street (west side), Buckley Street (west side) and Cadd Street (west side) are included within the area for West Balcatta Primary School, while the boundary parts of Knowles Street (both sides) and the boundary street of Fontaine Street (both sides) are excluded from the area for West Balcatta Primary School.

The following defines an optional area for West Balcatta Primary School, Balcatta Primary School and Osborne Primary School—

From the intersection of Karrinyup Road and the Mitchell Freeway, south and southeast along the Mitchell Freeway to a point coinciding with the southern extension of Telford Crescent, north northeast to and along Telford Crescent to Karrinyup Road and in a general westerly direction along Karrinyup Road to the Mitchell Freeway. The boundary parts of the Mitchell Freeway (east and northeast sides), Telford Crescent (both sides) and Karrinyup Road (south side) are included within the optional area.

The following defines an optional area for West Balcatta and Lake Gwelup Primary Schools—

The area bounded by Odin Drive, Erindale Road and the Mitchell Freeway. The boundary parts of Erindale Road (south side), the Mitchell Freeway (east side) and the boundary street of Odin Drive (west side) are included within the optional area.

The following defines an optional area for Balcatta Primary School, Takari Primary School and West Balcatta Primary School—

From the junction of Rance Street and Poincaire Street, south along Rance Street to Woodhall Street, west along Woodhall Street to Drew Street, south along Drew Street to Lowen Place, east along Lowen Place and south-east along a Right of Way leading to Jones Street, northeast and north along Jones Street to Poincaire Street, and west along Poincaire Street to the junction with Rance Street. The boundary streets of Rance Street (east side) and Lowen Place (north side) and the boundary parts of Woodhall Street (south side), Drew Street (east side), Jones Street (west side) and Poincaire Street (south side) are included in the optional area.

WEST GREENWOOD PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of the Mitchell Freeway and Hepburn Avenue, east along Hepburn Avenue to a point midway between the eastern arm of Wirilda Crescent and the western arm of Crossandra Way, south from this point between Wirilda Crescent and Crossandra Way to the junction of Blackall Drive and Wiralda Crescent, south east along Blackall Drive to the western arm of Peppermint Drive, south along Peppermint Drive to the north-south bike path, south along the north-south bike path to Coolibah Drive, south east along Coolibah Drive to Redgum Street, south along Redgum Street to Callistemon Street, west along Callistemon Street to Sheoak Street, south along Sheoak Street and its southern extension through Sheoak Park to Warwick Road, west along Warwick Road to the Mitchell Freeway and north along the Mitchell Freeway to Hepburn Avenue. The boundary parts of Wiralda Crescent (both sides), Blackall Drive (south west side), Coolibah Drive (south west side), Warwick Road (north side) and the Mitchell Freeway (east side) are included within this local-intake area. The boundary parts of Crossandra Way (both sides), Peppermint Drive (both sides), Redgum Street (both sides), Sheoak Street (both sides) are excluded from this local-intake area.

The following defines an optional area between Greenwood Primary School and West Greenwood Primary School—

From the junction of Hepburn Avenue and Allenswood Road, west along Hepburn Avenue to a point midway between the eastern arm of Wirilda Crescent and the western arm of Crossandra Way, south from this point between Wirilda Crescent and Crossandra Way to the junction of Blackall Drive and Wiralda Crescent, south east along Blackall Drive to the western arm of Peppermint Drive, south along Peppermint Drive to the north-south bike path, south along the

north-south bike path to Coolibah Drive, south east along Coolibah Drive to Redgum Street, south along Redgum Street to Callistemon Street, west along Callistemon Street to Sheoak Street, south along Sheoak Street and its southern extension through Sheoak Park to Warwick Road, east along Warwick Road to Allenswood Road and north along Allenswood Road to Hepburn Avenue. The boundary parts of Hepburn Avenue (south side), Crossandra Way (both sides), Blackall Drive (north east side), Peppermint Drive (both sides), Coolibah Drive (north east side), Redgum Street (both sides), Callistemon Street (south side), Sheoak Street (both sides), Warwick Road (north side) and Allenswood Road (west side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Wiralda Crescent (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

WOODLUPINE PRIMARY SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the junction of Cypress Road and Sorrel Court, north east along Sorrel Court to its northern extremity, north west between Linden Way and Carissa Way and north east between Tarata Way and Carissa Way to the junction of Dawson Avenue and Juniper Way, north east along the western arm of Juniper Way and north east between Tallerack Way (on the west) and Calliandra Way (on the east) to the junction of Bougainvillea Avenue and Pyrus Way, south east, east and north east along Bougainvillea Avenue to Berkshire Road, north east along the north east extension of Bougainvillea Avenue through Forrestfield Senior High School to Sultana Road East, south east and east along Sultana Road East to Hawtin Road, south west along Hawtin Road to Hale Road, south west along Hale Road to Cypress Road and north west along Cypress Road to Sorrel Court.

The boundary parts of Sorrel Court (both sides), Carissa Way (both sides), Juniper Way (both sides), Calliandra Way (both sides), Bougainvillea Avenue (both sides), Sultana Road East (south side), Hawtin Road (west), Hale Road (north west) and Cypress Road (both sides) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Linden Way (both sides), Tarata Way (both sides) and Tallerack Way (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area of this school.

The following defines an optional area between Maida Vale Primary School, Dawson Park Primary School and Woodlupine Primary School—

From the junction of Hawtin Road and Kent Road, south along Hawtin Road to Sultana Road East, west and north west along Sultana Road East to Bruce Road, east along Bruce Road to Brewer Road, north along Brewer Road to Kent Road and east along Kent Road to Hawtin Road. The boundary parts of Hawtin Road (west side), Sultana Road East (north side), Bruce Road (south side), Brewer Road (east side) and Kent Road (south side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Forrestfield, Dawson Park and Woodlupine Primary Schools—

From the intersection of Tonkin Highway and Hale Road, northeast along Hale Road to Cypress Road, northwest along Cypress Road and its extension to Roe Highway, southwest along Roe Highway to Tonkin Highway, and southeast along Tonkin Highway to Hale Road. The boundary parts of Hale Road (north west side), Roe Highway (south east side) and Tonkin Highway (north east side) are included within the optional area, while the boundary street of Cypress Road (both sides) is excluded from the optional area.

SCHOOL EDUCATION ACT 1999**DECLARATION OF LOCAL-INTAKE AREAS FOR SCHOOLS WITH SECONDARY STUDENTS**

(Pursuant to Sections 60, 78, 79 and 80)

The Hon. Minister for Education has declared that the local-intake areas for the secondary schools listed hereunder shall be as stated in this notice. Children of compulsory school age who reside within the local-intake areas of the following secondary schools shall be entitled to attend the schools to which such local-intake areas apply if there is an appropriate educational program for them at that school. The local-intake area of a secondary school may be defined in this notice by listing the names of the contributory primary schools, the local-intake areas and the traditional catchment areas of which, when amalgamated, constitute the local-intake area of that secondary school. Children who reside outside these local-intake areas may apply to attend the schools to which such local-intake areas apply.

ALBANY SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (Dec07)

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools: Albany, Flinders Park and Spencer Park, the traditional catchment area of Mount Manypeaks Primary School and the following boundary between Albany and North Albany Senior High Schools—

From Melville Point (UBD Country Link Street Directory) on Princess Royal Harbour, north to Princess Royal Drive, north west along Princess Royal Drive to Hanrahan Road, north along Hanrahan Road to Serpentine Road, south along Serpentine Road to the south west extension of Wellington Street, north east along this extension and continuing along Wellington Street to Centennial Park, north east through Centennial Park to the junction of Sanford Road and North Road, north from this junction to the junction of Bond Road and Lockheed Road, east along Bond Road to Curtiss Road, north along Curtiss Road and the northern extension of Curtiss Road to the junction of Chester Pass Road and Willyung Road, north east along Chester Pass Road to King River, generally north west along King River to Hazzard Road, west along Hazzard Road to the junction with the southern extension of Bailey Road, north along this extension to Bailey Road, north along Bailey Road and its northern extension to the local government boundary between the City of Albany and the Shire of Plantagenet.

The boundary parts of Princess Royal Drive (north side), Hanrahan Road (east side), Chester Pass Road (both sides) and Hazzard Road (both sides) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Serpentine Road (both sides), Wellington Street (both sides), Bond Road (both sides), Curtiss Road (both sides) and Bailey Road (both sides) are excluded from this local-intake area.

ATWELL COLLEGE (Dec07)

The local-intake area for this school contains the following primary schools: Atwell, Harmony and Jandakot.

The following defines the local-intake area of Atwell College—

From the junction of Armadale Road and Liddelow Road, south along Liddelow Road to Rowley Road, east along Rowley Road to De Haer Road, south along De Haer Road to the more southern of the two junctions with Leslie Road, south from this point on De Haer Road to the locality boundary between Anketell and Oakford on Anketell Road, west along Anketell Road to the Kwinana Freeway, north along the Kwinana Freeway to Rowley Road, west along Rowley Road, and continuing west along the local government boundary between the City of Cockburn and the Town of Kwinana to Mandogalup Road, north along Mandogalup Road and its northern extension to Russell Road, east along Russell Road to a point due south of the centre of Kogolup Lake, north from this point on Russell Road through Thompsons Lake and Kogolup Lake to Beeliar Drive, east along Beeliar Drive to a point due south of the junction of North Lake Road and Osprey Drive, north to a point on the western extension of Yangebup Road (eastern section), east along this extension to Yangebup Road, east along Yangebup Road to Cooper Road, east and south east along Cooper Road to Poletti Road, south along Poletti Road to Beeliar Drive, east along Beeliar Drive to the Kwinana Freeway, and continuing east along Armadale Road to Solomon Road, north east along Solomon Road to Jandakot Road, and continuing north east along Solomon Road and its extension to the north west/south east runway of Jandakot airport, south east along the south east extension of the runway to Fraser Road, south west along Fraser Road to Jandakot Road, west along Jandakot Road to Fraser Road (southern section) and continuing south west along Fraser Road (southern section) to Armadale Road, east along Armadale Road to Liddelow Road.

The boundary parts of Liddelow Road (west side), Rowley Road (eastern section, south side), De Haer Road (north side), Anketell Road (north side), Kwinana Freeway (east side), Rowley Road (western section, north side), Mandogalup Road (east side), Russell Road (south side), Beeliar Drive (south side, western section),

Yangebup Road (south side), Cooper Road (south side), Poletti Road (west side) Beeliar Drive (south side, eastern section), Armadale Road (western section, south side), Solomon Road (east side), Fraser Road (both northern and southern sections, west side) Jandakot Road (north side) and Armadale Road (eastern section, south side).

The following defines an optional area for Atwell College and Armadale Senior High School—

From the junction of Armadale Road and Warton Road, north east along Warton Road to Jandakot Road, north west along Jandakot Road to Fraser Road, south west along Fraser Road to Armadale Road and south east along Armadale Road to Warton Road. The boundary parts of Armadale Road (north side), Jandakot Road (south side) and Fraser road (east side) are included in this optional area, while the boundary parts Warton Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

The following defines an optional area for Atwell College and Kwinana High School—

From the intersection of the Kwinana Freeway and Rowley Road, south along the Kwinana Freeway to Anketell Road, west along Anketell Road to Clementi Road, north from this junction to Madogolup Road, north west along Madogolup Road to the local government boundary between the City of Cockburn and the Town of Kwinana, east along this local government boundary to Rowley Road, and continuing east along Rowley Road to the Kwinana Freeway. The boundary parts of the Kwinana Freeway (west side), Anketell Road (north side), Mandogolup Road (east side) and Rowley Road (south side) are included in this optional area.

AUSTRALIND SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following description will define the local-intake area of Australind Senior High School from 2009.

The local-intake area for this school contains the following primary schools: Australind, Clifton Park and Parkfield and all or part of the traditional catchment areas of Brunswick Junction and River Valley Primary Schools.

The following defines the local-intake area of Australind Senior High School—

From the intersection of the westerly extension of Pead Road with the coastline, east along the aforesaid extension of Pead Road, east along Pead Road and the easterly extension of Pead Road to the electricity transmission line, south along the electricity transmission line to a point due west from the confluence of the Mornington River and Wellesley River, east to the aforesaid confluence, south along the Wellesley River to the Brunswick River, south west along the Brunswick River to the Australind Bypass, south and south west along the Australind Bypass to the Collie River, generally west along the Collie River to the Leschenault Inlet, west across the Leschenault Inlet to The Cut on the coastline of the Indian Ocean and north along the coastline to the western extension of Pead Road. The boundary parts of Pead Road (both sides) and the Australind Bypass (west side) are included within this local-intake area.

The following defines the boundary for an optional area between Australind Senior High School and Harvey Senior High School—

From the Wellington Dam north west and west along the Collie River to the Australind Bypass, north along the Australind Bypass to the Brunswick River, east and north east along the Brunswick River to the confluence with the Wellesley River, north along the Wellesley River to the confluence with the Mornington River, east along the Mornington River to the intersection with Campbell Road, east to the intersection of Sandalwood Road with the South Western Highway and east along Sandalwood Road for a distance of three kilometres. The boundary parts of the Australind Bypass (east side) are included within this optional area. The boundary parts of Sandalwood Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area.

BUSSELTON SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (Dec07)

The local-intake area of this school is defined by the traditional catchment areas of Busselton Primary School and Geographe Primary School.

The following will define a partial boundary between Busselton Senior High School and Cape Naturaliste College—

From the coastline of Geographe Bay, south along Queen Street to Albert Street, west along Albert Street to Bussell Highway, continuing west along Bussell Highway to the drainage channel adjacent to Queen Elizabeth Avenue, south along the drainage channel to the New (Broadwater) River, west along the New River to Fairway Drive, south along Fairway Drive to the Busselton Bypass, east along the Busselton Bypass to Queen Elizabeth Avenue, south along Queen Elizabeth Avenue to Don Road, and continuing south to Evans Road. The boundary parts of Queen Street (east side), Albert Street (south side), Bussell Highway (south side), Fairway Drive (east side), the Busselton Bypass (north side), Queen Elizabeth Avenue (east side) and Don Road (east side) are included within the local intake area of Busselton Senior High School.

The following local-intake area of West Busselton Primary School defines an optional area between Cape Naturaliste College and Busselton Senior High School—

From the coastline of Geographe Bay, south along Holgate Road and its extension to and along the eastern north-south boundary of Lot 219 on the Busselton Bypass, east along the Busselton Bypass to Fairway Drive, north along Fairway Drive to the New (Broadwater) River, east along the New (Broadwater) River to the drainage channel, north along the drainage channel to Bussell Highway, east along the Bussell Highway and continuing east along Albert Street to Queen Street, north along Queen Street to Geographe Bay, and west along the coastline of Geographe Bay to the northern extension of Holgate Road. The boundary parts of Holgate Road (both sides), the Busselton Bypass (north side), Fairway Drive (west side), the drainage channel (west side), Bussell Highway (north side), Albert Street (north side) and Queen Street (west side) are included within this optional area. Lot 219 on the Busselton Bypass is excluded from this optional area.

CANNING VALE COLLEGE (Dec07)

The local-intake area for this school contains the following primary schools: Caladenia, Campbell, Canning Vale, Excelsior and Ranford.

The following defines the local-intake area of this secondary school—

From the junction of Garden Street and Warton Road, south west along Warton Road to Nicholson Road, north along Nicholson Road to Acourt Road, north west along Acourt Road to Johnston Road, north along Johnston Road to Clifton Road, north and north west along Clifton Road and its extension to the railway line, north east along the railway line to Nicholson Road, south east along Nicholson Road to Garden Street, and continuing south and south east along Garden Street to Warton Road. The boundary parts of Warton Road (west side), Nicholson Road (southern section, east side), Acourt Road (north east side), Johnston Road (east side), Clifton Road (east side), Nicholson Road (northern section, south west side) and Garden Street (south west side) are included within the local-intake area of this secondary school.

The following defines an optional area between Canning Vale College, Southern River College and Thornlie Senior High School—

From the junction of Warton Road and Holmes Street, east along Holmes Street to Lakey Street, south west along Lakey Street to Barrett Street, south east along Barrett Street to Balfour Street, south west along Balfour Street to Ranford Road, north west along Ranford Road to Wright Road, south west along Wright Road to the main entrance of Carey College, north west from the main entrance of Carey College through Harrisdale Swamp to Warton Road and north east along Warton Road to Holmes Street. The boundary parts of Holmes Street (south side), Lakey Street (both sides), Barrett Street (south west side), Balfour Street (north west side), Ranford Road (north east side), Wright Road (north west side) and Warton Road (south east side) are included within this optional area. (It is anticipated that this optional area will eventually become part of the local-intake area of a future secondary school in Southern River or Forrestdale, and will cease to be part of the local-intake area of Canning Vale College.)

The following defines an optional area between Canning Vale College and Armadale Senior High School—

From the intersection of Nicholson Road and Warton Road, north along Nicholson Road to Acourt Road, north west along Acourt Road to Fraser Road, south west along Fraser Road to Jandakot Road, south east along Jandakot Road to Warton Road, and north east along Warton Road to Nicholson Road. The boundary parts of Fraser Road (east side) and Jandakot Road (north side) are included within this optional area, while the boundary parts of Nicholson Road (both sides), Acourt Road (both sides) and Warton Road (both sides) are excluded from this optional area. (It is anticipated that this optional area will eventually become part of the local-intake area of a future secondary school in Forrestdale, and will cease to be part of the local-intake area of Canning Vale College.)

CAPE NATURALISTE COLLEGE (Dec07)

The local-intake area of this school is defined by the traditional catchment areas of Dunsborough Primary School and Vasse Primary School.

The following defines a partial boundary between Cape Naturaliste College and Busselton Senior High School—

From the coastline of Geographe Bay, south along Holgate Road and its extension to the eastern north-south boundary of Lot 219 on the Busselton Bypass, east along the Busselton Bypass to Queen Elizabeth Avenue, south along Queen Elizabeth Avenue to Don Road, and continuing south to Evans Road. The boundary parts of the Busselton Bypass (south side), Queen Elizabeth Avenue (west side) and Don Road (west side), and Lot 219 on the Busselton Bypass, are included within the local intake area of Cape Naturalist Secondary College. The boundary street of Holgate Road (both sides) is excluded from the local intake area of this school.

The following local-intake area of West Busselton Primary School defines an optional area between Cape Naturaliste College and Busselton Senior High School—

From the coastline of Geographe Bay, south along Holgate Road and its extension to and along the eastern north-south boundary of Lot 219 on the Busselton Bypass, east along the Busselton Bypass to Fairway Drive, north along Fairway Drive to the New (Broadwater) River, east along the New (Broadwater) River to the drainage channel, north along the drainage channel to Bussell Highway, east along the Bussell Highway and continuing east along Albert Street to Queen Street, north along Queen Street to Geographe Bay, and west along the coastline of Geographe Bay to the northern extension of Holgate Road. The boundary parts of Holgate Road (both sides), the Busselton Bypass (north side), Fairway Drive (west side), the drainage channel (west side), Bussell Highway (north side), Albert Street (north side) and Queen Street (west side) are included within this optional area. Lot 219 on the Busselton Bypass is excluded from this optional area.

EATON COMMUNITY COLLEGE (Dec07)

The following description will define the local-intake area of Eaton Community College from 2009.

The local-intake area for this school contains the following primary schools: Eaton and Glen Huon.

The following defines the local-intake area of Eaton Community College—

From the bridge carrying the Australind Bypass over the Collie River, generally west along the Collie River to the Leschenault Inlet, south and south west along the shore of the Leschenault Inlet to the railway bridge near the mouth of the Preston River, generally south east along the railway line to the Australind Bypass, north east and north along the Australind Bypass to the Collie River. The boundary parts of the Australind Bypass (west side) are included within this local-intake area.

LAKELAND SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (Dec07)

The local-intake area for this school contains the following primary schools: Beeliar, Bibra Lake, South Lake and Yangebup.

The following defines the local-intake area of Lakeland Senior High School—

From the intersection of the railway line and Russell Road, north along the railway line to Barrington Street, east along Barrington Street to Wellard Street, north along Wellard Street to Spearwood Avenue, south east along Spearwood Avenue to Sudlow Road, north along Sudlow Road to Phoenix Road, east along Phoenix Road and the extension of Phoenix Road to Progress Drive, north along Progress Drive to the proposed Roe Highway, east along the proposed Roe Highway to Karel Avenue, south west along Karel Avenue to Hope Road, east along Hope Road to Berrigan Drive, south along Berrigan Drive to the site boundary of the Jandakot Airport, south west and south east along the site boundary of the airport to Solomon Road, south west along Solomon Road to Armadale Road, west along Armadale Road to the Kwinana Freeway, continuing west along Beeliar Drive to Poletti Road, north along Poletti Road to Cooper Road, north west and west along Cooper Road to Yangebup Road, continuing west along Yangebup Road and its westward extension into Yangebup Lake to a point due south of the junction of North Lake Road and Osprey Drive, south from this point to Beeliar Drive, west along Beeliar Drive to a point due north of the centre of Kogolup Lake, south from this point on Beeliar Drive through the centre of Kogolup Lake and continuing south through Thomsons Lake to Russell Road and west along Russell Road to the railway line.

The boundary parts of boundary parts of Barrington Street (south side), Wellard Street (east side), Spearwood Avenue (south side), Sudlow Road (east side), Phoenix Road (south side), proposed Roe Highway (south side), Karel Avenue (both sides), Hope Road (both sides), Berrigan Drive (both sides), Solomon Road (west side), Armadale Road (north side), Beeliar Drive (eastern section, north side), Poletti Road (east side), Cooper Road (north side), Yangebup Road (north side), Beeliar Drive (western section, north side) and Russell Road (north side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Progress Drive (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area for Lakeland Senior High School.

The following defines an optional area between Lakeland Senior High School and Leeming Senior High School—

From the junction of Farrington Road and the Kwinana Freeway, west along Farrington Road to Bibra Drive, south along Bibra Drive to the proposed Roe Highway, east along the proposed Roe Highway to the Kwinana Freeway and north along the Kwinana Freeway to Farrington Road. The boundary parts of the Kwinana Freeway (west side), Farrington Road (south side), Bibra Lake Drive (east side) and proposed Roe Highway (north side) are included within this optional area.

NORTH ALBANY SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (Dec07)

The local-intake area for this school is defined by the local-intake areas of the following primary schools: Little Grove, Mount Lockyer and Yakamia; and the following boundary between Albany and North Albany Senior High Schools.

The following defines a boundary between Albany and North Albany Senior High Schools—

From Melville Point (UBD Country Link Street Directory) on Princess Royal Harbour, north to Princess Royal Drive, north west along Princess Royal Drive to Hanrahan Road, north along Hanrahan Road to Serpentine Road, south along Serpentine Road to the south west extension of Wellington Street, north east along this extension and continuing along Wellington Street to Centennial Park, north east through Centennial Park to the junction of Sanford Road and North Road, north from this junction to the junction of Bond Road and Lockheed Road, east along Bond Road to Curtiss Road, north along Curtiss Road and the northern extension of Curtiss Road to the junction of Chester Pass Road and Wilyung Road, north east along Chester Pass Road to King River, generally north west along King River to Hazzard Road, west along Hazzard Road to the junction with the southern extension of Bailey Road, north along this extension to Bailey Road, north along Bailey Road and its northern extension to the local government boundary between the City of Albany and the Shire of Plantagenet.

The boundary parts of Princess Royal Drive (south side), Hanrahan Road (west side), Serpentine Road (both sides), Wellington Street (both sides), Bond Road (both sides), Curtiss Road (both sides) and Bailey Road (both sides) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Chester Pass Road (both sides) and Hazzard Road (both sides) are excluded from the local-intake area of this school.

The following defines an optional area between Denmark High School and North Albany Senior High School—

From the Southern Ocean, north east along Tennessee South Road to Lower Denmark Road, north west along Lower Denmark Road to Eden Road, west along Eden Road to Two Bob Hill, and south west from Two Bob Hill to the Southern Ocean. The boundary parts of Tennessee South Road (both sides), Lower Denmark Road (both sides) and Eden Road (both sides) are included within the optional area.

SOUTHERN RIVER COLLEGE (Dec07)

The local-intake area for this school contains all or part of the local-intake areas of the following primary schools -Ashburton Drive, Bletchley Park, Gosnells, Huntingdale and Wirrabirra, and the traditional catchment area of Seaforth Primary School.

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the rail crossing of Fremantle Road and the railway line, south east along the railway line to the closest point west of the junction of Albany Highway and Tonkin Highway, east to the aforesaid junction and north east along Tonkin Highway to the Canning River, generally south along the Canning River to the road to the Harry Hunter Rehabilitation Centre, west along the aforesaid road to Albany Highway, south along Albany Highway to the local government boundary between the City of Gosnells and the City of Armadale, north west and south west along this local government boundary to Ranford Road, north west along Ranford Road to Balfour Street, north east along Balfour Street to Gay Street, north west along Gay Street to Warton Road, north east along Warton Road to Corfield Street, south east along Corfield Street to the Southern River, north, east and south east along the Canning River to Albany Highway, south along Albany Highway to Fremantle Road and west along Fremantle Road to the railway crossing.

The boundary parts of Tonkin Highway (south east side), the road to the Harry Hunter Rehabilitation Centre (north side), Albany Highway (southern section, west side), Ranford Road (north east side), Balfour Street (south east side), Warton Road (south east side) and Corfield Street (south side) are included within the local-intake area of this school. The boundary parts of Gay Street (both sides) and Albany Highway (northern section, both sides) are excluded from this local-intake area.

The following defines the boundary of an optional area between Southern River College and Thornlie Senior High School—

From the junction of Barrett Street and Balfour Street, north east along Balfour Street to Gay Street, north west along Gay Street to Warton Road, south west along Warton Road to Holmes Street, east along Holmes Street to Lakey Street, south west along Lakey Street to Barrett Street and south east along Barrett Street to Balfour Street. The boundary parts of Balfour Street (north east side), Gay Street (both sides), Warton Road (south east side), Holmes Street (south side), Lakey Street (both sides) and Barrett Street (north east side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines the boundary of an optional area between Kelmscott Senior High School and Southern River College—

From the junction of Mills Road East and Tonkin Highway, south west along Tonkin Highway to the bridge over the Canning River, south along the Canning River to the local government boundary between the City of Armadale and the City of Gosnells, east, south and east along the local government boundary to the western boundary of the Cohunu Wildlife Sanctuary site and continuing north to a point east of the junction of Mills Road East and Pages Way, west from this point to the junction of Mills Road East and Pages Way and in a generally westerly direction along Mills Road East to the junction with Tonkin Highway. The boundary parts of Tonkin Highway (south east side), Canning Highway (east side), Pages Way (both sides) and Mills Road East (both sides) are included within this optional area.

The following defines a boundary for an optional area between Southern River College and Yule Brook College—

From the eastern extremity of Rushton Road, west and north west along Rushton Road to Ellis Brook, in a generally westerly direction along Ellis Brook to Mills Road West, north west along Mills Road West to Gosnells Road, west along Gosnells Road to Albany Highway, south along Albany Highway to Fremantle Road, west along Fremantle Road to the railway line, south east and south along the railway line to a point due west of the junction of Albany Highway and Tonkin Highway, east from this point to Tonkin Highway, north east along Tonkin Highway to Mills Road East, east along Mills Road East to Pages Way and due east from this point. The boundary parts of Rushton Road (both sides), Albany Highway (both sides), Fremantle Road (both sides) and Tonkin Highway (west side) are included within this optional area, while the boundary parts of Mills Road West (both sides), Gosnells Road (both sides) and Mills Road East (both sides) are excluded from the optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Canning Vale College, Southern River College and Thornlie Senior High School—

From the junction of Warton Road and Holmes Street, east along Holmes Street to Lacey Street, south west along Lacey Street to Barrett Street, south east along Barrett Street to Balfour Street, south west along Balfour Street to Ranford Road, north west along Ranford Road to Wright Road, south west along Wright Road to the main entrance of Carey College, north west from the main entrance of Carey College through Harrisdale Swamp to Warton Road and north east along Warton Road to Barrett Street. The boundary parts of Holmes Street (south side), Lacey Street (both sides), Barrett Street (south west side), Balfour Street (north west side), Ranford Road (north east side) Wright Road (north west side) and Warton Road (south east side) are included within this optional area. (It is anticipated that this optional area will eventually become part of the local-intake area of a future secondary school in Southern River or Forrestdale, and will cease to be part of the local-intake area of Canning Vale College.)

The following defines an optional area between Armadale Senior High School and Southern River College—

From the intersection of Ranford Road and Wright Road, south west along Wright Road to the main entrance of Carey College, north west from the main entrance of Carey College through Harrisdale Swamp to Warton Road, south west along Warton Road to Mason Road, south east along Mason Roads to Skeet Road (previously Hale Road), north east along Skeet Road to Ranford Road, and north west along Ranford Road to Warton Road. The boundary parts of Wright Road (south east side), Warton Road (south east side), Mason Road (both sides), Skeet Road (both sides) and Ranford Road (south west side) are included within this optional area.

THORNLIE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (Dec07)

The following defines the local-intake area of this school—

From the intersection of Nicholson Road and the railway line, north east along the railway line to Albany Highway, south east along Albany Highway to Austin Avenue, south west along the locality boundary between Kenwick and Maddington to the Canning River, generally south along the Canning River to the confluence of the Canning River and the Southern River, south along the Southern River to Corfield Street, north east along Corfield Street to Warton Road, south west along Warton Road to Garden Street, north west along Garden Street to Nicholson Road, and north along Nicholson Road to the railway line. The boundary parts of Albany Highway (south west side), Corfield Street (north side), Warton Road (north west side) and Garden Street (east side) are included within the local-intake area of this school.

The following is an optional area between Lynwood Senior High School and Thornlie Senior High School—

From the intersection of the Canning River and the railway line, south west along the railway line to Cameron Street, north west along Cameron Street to the Roe Highway, north east along the proposed Roe Highway to the Canning River, and generally south east along the Canning River to the railway line. The boundary parts of Cameron Street (north east side) and the Roe Highway (south east side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines the boundary of an optional area between Southern River College and Thornlie Senior High School—

From the junction of Barrett Street and Balfour Street, north east along Balfour Street to Gay Street, north west along Gay Street to Warton Road, south west along Warton Road to Holmes Street, east along Holmes Street to Lakey Street, south west along Lakey Street to Barrett Street and south east along Barrett Street to Balfour Street. The boundary parts of Balfour Street (north east side), Gay Street (both sides), Warton Road (south east side), Holmes Street (south side), Lakey Street (both sides) and Barrett Street (north east side) are included within this optional area.

The following defines an optional area between Canning Vale College, Southern River College and Thornlie Senior High School—

From the junction of Warton Road and Holmes Street, east along Holmes Street to Lacey Street, south west along Lacey Street to Barrett Street, south east along Barrett Street to Balfour Street, south west along Balfour Street to Ranford Road, north west along Ranford Road to Wright Road, south west along Wright Road to the main entrance of Carey College, north west from the main entrance of Carey College through Harrisdale Swamp to Warton Road and north east along Warton Road to Barrett Street. The boundary parts of Holmes Street (south side), Lacey Street (both sides), Barrett Street (south west side), Balfour Street (north west side), Ranford Road (north east side) Wright Road (north west side) and Warton Road (south east side) are included within this optional area. (It is anticipated that this optional area will eventually become part of the local-intake area of a future secondary school in Southern River or Forrestdale, and will cease to be part of the local-intake area of Canning Vale College.)
