Conservation and Land Management Act 1984

### **Conservation and Land Management Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2007**

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

**1. Citation**

These regulations are the *Conservation and Land Management Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2007*.

**2. Commencement**

These regulations come into operation as follows:

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on the day after that day.

**3. The regulations amended**

The amendments in these regulations are to the *Conservation and Land Management Regulations 2002*.

**4. Regulation 81 amended**

Regulation 81 is amended as follows:

- (a) by inserting after “include” —  
“ any of the following ”;
- (b) by deleting the full stop at the end of paragraph (c) and inserting instead —

- (d) the location of infrastructure, and other similar facilities, that serve the public interest, to the

**ELECTORAL ACT 1907**ISSUE OF WRIT FOR AN ELECTION FOR THE MURDOCH ELECTORAL DISTRICT

1. **FISH RESOURCES MANAGEMENT ACT 1994**

## PROHIBITION ON FISHING (ABROLHOS ISLANDS) ORDER 2008

Order No. 2 of 2008

FD 1620/98 [855]

Made by the Minister under section 43.

**1. Citation**

This order may be cited as the *Prohibition on Fishing (Abrolhos Islands) Order 2008*.

## 2. Interpretation

In this order—

“**baldchin groper**” means fish of that common name described by the scientific classification opposite that name in column 2 of Schedule 7 of the *Fish Resources Management Regulations 1995*;

“**coastal waters of the State**” has the definition given by section 3 of the *Coastal Waters (State Powers) Act 1980* of the Commonwealth;

“**waters of the Abrolhos Islands Fish Habitat Protection Area**” means the area of WA waters adjacent to the Abrolhos Islands from the high water mark to the seaward limits of the coastal waters of the State.

## 3. Prohibition on fishing for baldchin groper or by line

A person must not, at any time during the period commencing on 1 February 2008 and ending on 31 October 2008, fish in the waters of the Abrolhos Islands Fish Habitat Protection Area—

- (a) for baldchin groper; or
- (b) by line from a boat where there is any baldchin groper on board, or attached in any way, to the boat.
