#### GENETICALLY MODIFIED CROPS FREE AREAS ACT 2003

GENETICALLY MODIFIED CROPS FREE AREAS EXEMPTION ORDER (No. 1) 2008

Made by the Minister for Agriculture and Food under Section 6 of the Act.

#### 1. Citation

This is the Genetically Modified Crops Free Areas Exemption Order (No. 1) 2008.

#### 2. Duration

This order comes into operation on the date of its publication and remains in force until 31 December 2008.

#### 3. Exemption

A person who cultivates a canola crop in Western Australia that contains genetically modified organisms is exempt from the application of section 5(1) of the Act in relation to canola cultivated for harvest in 2007 or 2008 if—

- (a) the genetically modified organisms are of a type licensed under the Commonwealth Gene Technology Act 2000 for intentional release into the environment;
- (b) the crop contains no more than 0.9 per cent of genetically modified organisms; and
- (c) the crop is derived from seed containing no more than 0.5 per cent of genetically modified organisms.
