WATER BOARDS ACT 1904

BUSSELTON WATER BOARD

Busselton Water Area By-Laws

Under the powers conferred by the *Water Boards Act 1904* and under all of the powers, the Busselton Water Board resolved on 18 February 2008 to amend the Busselton Water Area By-laws.

In this by-law, the Busselton Water Area By-laws as published in the *Government Gazette* on 23 September 1994 is referred to as the principal by-law. The principal by-law is amended as follows—

1 By-law 18 amended

After by-law 18 add the following-

A person must not, without the written approval of the Chief Executive Officer of Busselton Water, use water in contravention of any of the following clauses—

- (1) A person does not breach these restrictions if—
 - (a) The person uses water to water a market garden or plant nursery to the minimum extent necessary to ensure the viable operation of the market garden or plant nursery; and
 - (b) The market garden or plant nursery is not supplied with water other than by Busselton Water.
- (2) A person must not water a lawn or garden except by—
 - (a) Reticulation during either, but not both, the morning period or the evening period on one of both of 2 days of the week specified in Schedule 1 in relation to the relevant property where morning period means the period before 9:00am and evening period means the period after 6:00pm; or
 - (b) A hand held hose with one outlet; or
 - (c) A hand held watering can.
- (3) A person must not spray a building, paved area or road except—
 - (a) To the minimum extent necessary for fire fighting; or
 - (b) With—
 - (i) A high pressure water cleaner which uses pressurized water flowing at a rate of not more than 6L per minute; or
 - (ii) A hand held hose with one outlet;

To the minimum extent necessary for the cleaning of the building, path, paved area or road so as to avoid a threat to public health or safety; or

- (c) With a hand held hose with one outlet to the minimum extent necessary for purposes related to the construction, demolition or repair of the building, path, paved area or road.
- (4) A person must not fill a swimming pool except to the minimum extent necessary for the proper functioning of the pool.

Town Planning Scheme No. 4—Amendment No. 220

Ref: 853/6/16/7 Pt 220

It is hereby notified for public information, in accordance with section 87 of the *Planning and Development Act 2005* that the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure approved the Shire of

Murray local planning scheme amendment on 8 March 2008 for the purpose of introducing a new Part $3.3\mathrm{A}$ to read as follows—

- 1. Rezoning portion of Lot 508 Sutters Lane and portion of Lot 183 Thompson Road, West Pinjarra from "Rural" zone to "Special Use—Freeway Service Centre".
- 2. Modify the Scheme Maps accordingly.
- 3. Amending Appendix No. 1—Interpretations, by adding the following definitions—
 - "Freeway" means a road classed as a Primary Regional Road in the Peel Region Scheme and which is planned to a freeway standard with grade separated interchanges where direct access is restricted from adjacent property.

"Freeway Service Centre" means premises with access directly from a Freeway used for—

- (a) the retail sale of petroleum products, motor vehicle accessories and goods of an incidental convenience retail nature; and
- (b) Emergency breakdown repairs and only one service/lubrication bay for the carrying out of greasing, tyre repairs and minor mechanical repairs to motor vehicles (excluding premises used for a transport depot, panel beating, spray painting, major repairs of wrecking); and
- (c) The sale of food and drinks for the travelling public and its consumption on the premises and where seating is provided for patrons, but does not include the sale or consumption of alcohol under the Liquor Licensing Act 1988; and
- (d) Advertising road safety messages
- 4. Amending Schedule No 5 by inserting the following new item—

No.	(A) Specified Land	(B) Special Conditions Relating to (A)
	Portions of Lot 508 Sutters Lane and portion of Lot 183 Thompson Road, West Pinjarra	1. The land may only be used for Freeway Service Centre and associated facilities in accordance with a Development Plan adopted by Council and any Amendments thereto. 2. The following activities shall be applicable to the subject land— (a) The eating area shall not be greater than 240m² (equivalent to approximately 150 sit-down customers) with limited take-away food retailing contained within single building without a drive through fast-food facility. (b) Fuel hall only be sold by retail and there shall be no bulk fuel service. (c) Vehicles servicing shall be limited to emergency breakdown repairs and there shall be one only service / lubrication bay for the carrying out of greasing, tyre repairs and minor mechanical repairs to motor vehicles (excluding premises used for a transport depot, panel beating, spray painting, major repairs or wrecking). (d) The aggregate floor space of all retailing facilities shall be no more than 200m² NLA. (e) Parking for a range of vehicles shall be provided. (f) All facilities shall be available on a 24-hour basis. (g) All signs to be erected on the access way leading to the Freeway Service Centre sites shall be provided in accordance with a signage strategy approved by the Shire of Murray and the Western Australian Planning Commission so as to minimise commercial advertising along the freeway.
