APPLICATION DETAILS

Central to any application made is the program of work proposed for each of the years of the six year term. Applications are to be made in accordance with Section 31 of the *Petroleum and Geothermal Energy Resources Act 1967*. Consideration of an application for the grant of a Permit shall take into account work programs relative to the whole of the area applied for, the adequacy of the work program, and the applicant's technical and financial ability to undertake the work. Permits are awarded on the understanding that the first two years work commitment will be fulfilled without variation.

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
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
