Town Planning Scheme No. 3—Amendment No. 65

Ref:85312123120 Pt 65

It is hereby notified for public information, in accordance with section 87 of the *Planning and Development Act 2005* that the Minister for Planning approved the City of Cockburn local planning scheme amendment on 18 December 2008 for the purpose of—

1. Deleting sub-clauses 7(a)(i), 7(b)(i) and 7(d)(i) in the Provisions column for the Gaebler Road Development Zone (DA 9) in Schedule 11.

2. Inserting the following new sub-clauses under clause 7 in the Provisions column for the Gaebler Road Development Zone (DA 9) in Schedule 11—

(a) Building Location

- (i) Development fronting Russell Road (other than car based development), Macquarie Boulevard and Yarra Promenade (other than residential development) is required to have a nil setback to the street front, or is to be paved and landscaped to achieve visual integration and pedestrian permeability between the building frontage and street, to provide a “main street” character to the centre.

(b) Building Form

- (i) Buildings shall be generally contiguous, other than for pedestrian access points, alfresco dining areas and vehicular access and parking. All buildings within the centre plan area should exhibit a high degree of architectural integrity and avoid the traditional “big box” supermarket style.

(d) Building Frontage

- (i) The facades of development along Russell Road, Macquarie Boulevard, Hammond Road and Yarra Promenade shall comprise an aggregate of at least 40% of the facade area below the eave line as clear windows to provide a visual connection between uses inside the building and activity on the street.

The amendment seeks to rezone the Belmont Park Racecourse site and surrounding land from a private recreation zone to an urban zone, rationalise the parks and recreation and waterways reservations to reflect existing site conditions and revise the primary regional roads (PRR) reservation to reflect the current alignment of the Graham Farmer Freeway.
