LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1995

Shire of Morawa

EXTRACTIVE INDUSTRIES AMENDMENT LOCAL LAW 2009

Under the powers conferred by the *Local Government Act 1995* and under all other powers enabling it, the Council of the Shire of Morawa resolved on 19th March 2009 to make the following local law.

1. Title

This Local Law may be cited as the “*Shire of Morawa Extractive Industries Amendment Local Law 2009*”.

2. Principal Local Law

The *Shire of Morawa Extractive Industries Local Law 2008* as published in the *Government Gazette* on 16 July 2008 is referred to as the principal local law.

3. Amendment

The principle local law 2008 is hereby amended as follows—

- 3.1 In the contents page—
 - a. Insert ‘1.3 Application’ and renumber ‘1.3’ to ‘1.4’ accordingly;
 - b. Amend 2.1 to read ‘Extractive Industries Prohibited Without a License’;
 - c. Amend 2.2 to read ‘When a License is Not Required’;
 - d. Delete ‘3.2 Compliance with Local Law’ and renumber the remaining items accordingly;
 - e. Delete ‘5.2 Cancellation’; and
 - f. Delete ‘7.5 Damage to Roads and Prescribed Route’.
- 3.2 In clause 1.1, delete the definitions of ‘carry on an extractive industry’, and ‘infrastructure’.
- 3.3 Under the Applications clause, renumber clauses “1.1” as “1.3”, and under the Repeal clause renumber “1.2” as “1.4”.
- 3.4 Amend the heading to clause 2.2 to read ‘**When a License is not Required**’.
- 3.5 Delete clause 3.1(3) and insert—
 - (3) Without limiting subclause (2), the local government may impose conditions in respect of the following matters—
 - a. the orientation of the excavation to reduce visibility from other land;
 - b. the appropriate siting of access thoroughfares, buildings and plant;
 - c. the stockpiling of material;
 - d. the hours during which any excavation work may be carried out;
 - e. the hours during which any processing plant associated with, or located on, the site may be operated;
 - f. requiring all crushing and treatment plant to be enclosed within suitable buildings to minimise the emission of noise, dust, vapour and general nuisance to the satisfaction of the local government;
 - g. the depths below which a person shall not excavate;
 - h. distances from adjoining land or thoroughfares within which a person must not excavate;
 - i. the safety of persons employed at or visiting the excavation site;
 - j. the control of dust and wind-blown material;

- k. the planting, care and maintenance of trees, shrubs and other landscaping features during the time in which the extractive industry is carried out in order to effectively screen the area to be excavated and to provide for progressive rehabilitation;
 - l. the prevention of the spread of dieback or other disease;
 - m. the drainage of the excavation site and the disposal of water;
 - n. the restoration and reinstatement of the excavation site, the staging of such works, and the minimising of the destruction of vegetation;
 - o. the provision of retaining walls to prevent subsidence of any portion of the excavation or of land abutting the excavation;
 - p. requiring the licensee to furnish to the local government a surveyor's certificate each year, prior to the renewal fee being payable, to certify the quantity of material extracted and that material has not been excavated below the final contour levels outlined within the approved excavation programme;
 - q. requiring the licensee to enter into an agreement with the local government by which it agrees to pay any extraordinary expenses incurred by the local government in repairing damage caused to thoroughfares in the district by heavy or extraordinary traffic conducted by or on behalf of the licensee under the licence;
 - r. requiring the licensee to enter into an agreement with the local government in respect of any condition or conditions imposed under this local law; and
 - s. any other matter for properly regulating the carrying on of an extractive industry.'
- 3.6 Delete clause 3.2 and renumber clauses 3.3 to 3.8 accordingly.
- 3.7 In clause 3.7, delete the whole of subclause (1) and the symbol "(2)" at the beginning of subclause (2).
- 3.8 Delete clause 4.2 and insert—
- '4.2 (1) The local government may cancel a licence where the licensee has—
- (a) been convicted of an offence against—
 - (i) this local law; or
 - (ii) any other law relating to carrying on an extractive industry; or
 - (b) transferred or assigned or attempted to transfer or assign the licence without the consent of the local government;
 - (c) permitted another person to carry on an extractive industry otherwise than in accordance with the terms and conditions of the licence and of the provisions of this local law;
 - (d) failed to pay the annual licence fee under clause 3.3; or
 - (e) failed to have a current public liability insurance policy under clause 7.1(1) or failed to provide a copy of the policy or evidence of its renewal as the case may be, under clause 7.1(2).
- (2) Where the local government cancels a licence under this clause—
- (a) the local government shall advise the licensee in writing of the cancellation;
 - (b) the cancellation takes effect on and from the day on which the licensee is served with the cancellation advice; and
 - (c) the local government shall not be required to refund any part of the fees paid by the licensee in respect of the cancelled licence.'

3.9 In clause 4.4(1)(b) after 'licensee' add ', site owner (if different from the licensee)'

3.10 Insert a new clause 4.4(1)(e) as follows—

'(e) be forwarded to the CEO together with the fee determined by the local government from time to time, and'

And renumber previous clause '4.4(1)(e)' to '4.4(1)(f)' accordingly.

3.11 Delete clause 5.2.

3.12 In clause 6.1(b) delete ', under the provisions of subclause 6.1(5) of this local law'.

3.13 In clause 6.1(4) delete ', under the provisions of subclause 6.1(5) of this local law'.

3.14 Insert a new clause 6.4(5) as follows—

‘(5) A licensee shall not store, or permit to be stored, any explosives or explosive devices on the site to which the licence applies other than with the approval of the local government and the Department of Mines and Petroleum ‘.

3.15 Delete clause 7.5.

3.16 In the Schedule, change ‘3.7(2)’ to ‘3.6’.

2. Pastoral lands being all land outside townsites held under pastoral lease, low fuel breaks are required to be not less than twenty five metres wide, totally surrounding and within three metres of the perimeter of all buildings and/or haystacks or groups of buildings.
3. Townsite Lands—
 - 1(a) Where the area of the land is 2023 square metres or less, all flammable material from the whole of the land is required to be removed, with any stubble left not exceeding seventy five millimetres in height.

- 1(b) Where the area of the land is greater than 2023 square metres a bare mineral earth fire break of not less than three metres in width of a trafficable condition, inside, along and within two metres of the external boundaries of the land, free of all overhanging vegetation to a height of four metres,
OR—
- 1(c) A low fuel break of not less than three metres wide of a trafficable condition with vegetation not exceeding seventy five millimetres in height inside, along and within three metres of the external boundaries of the land, free of all overhanging vegetation to a height of four metres.
AND
- 2(a) A bare mineral earth fire break of not less than three metres wide of a trafficable condition and within three metres of the perimeter of all buildings and/or haystacks or groups of buildings, free of all overhanging vegetation to a height of four metres.
OR;
- 2(b) A low fuel break of not less than ten metres wide with vegetation not exceeding seventy five millimetres in height completely surrounding and within three metres of the perimeter of all buildings and/or haystacks or groups of buildings.
For the purposes of this requirement live standing trees and non-flammable maintained lawns and gardens are deemed to comply.

- 2(c) All flammable material from the whole of the land is required to be removed, with any stubble left not exceeding seventy five millimetres in height.
4. Rubbish Sites being all rubbish sites for pastoral stations, townsite and community use. Fire breaks are required to be of bare mineral earth in a trafficable condition not less than four metres wide and within five metres of the perimeter of the rubbish sites.
5. Fuel dumps and depots—remove all flammable material where fuel drum ramps or dumps are located, and where fuel drums, whether containing fuel or not are stored to a distance of at least ten metres outside the perimeter of any drum, ramp or stack of drums.
6. The acts referred to in sections 1 to 5 hereof must be performed to the satisfaction of a duly authorised Fire Control Officer of the Shire of Derby/West Kimberley.
7.  1. All subdivision is to be generally in accordance with the Subdivision Concept Plan adopted by Council and endorsed by the Commission.
 8. At subdivision, the development setback from either side of any creek-line/s is to be confirmed in conjunction with the Department of Water.
 9. A Foreshore Management Plan is to be prepared and implemented for the creek-lines identified as requiring such a plan by the Department of Water.
 10. (a) At the time of subdivision suitable arrangements are to be made with the Water Corporation for the adequate provision of a reticulated water supply to service lots above the RL 112 AD line. This shall include the transfer of freehold land (free of cost) and any infrastructure works (at the subdividers expense) as indicated on the Subdivision Concept Plan.
(b) In regards to the proposed water tank site, an over head tank erected on a stand is not permitted.
(c) The infrastructure (tank and associated buildings/infrastructure) shall be of a colour complimentary to the existing landform and landscape elements, to the satisfaction of the local government. Ziincalume or a galvanised corrugated iron finish or similar is not permitted;
(d) The Water Corporation or Developer will be required at the time of installing a water storage tank to submit a landscaping plan for screening purposes to be endorsed by the local government, with this plan to be implemented within 12 months from the date of approval unless other wise approved by the Local Government.
 11. All buildings shall be sympathetic in design and construction, and complimentary in colour and materials to the existing landform and landscape elements, to the satisfaction of the local government.
 12. The use of zincalume and/or coloured roof and wall materials, which in the opinion of the local government prejudices the landscape amenity of the surrounding landform, is not permitted.
 13. The clearing of remnant vegetation on the property other than for fire management and or driveway access purposes is not permitted unless otherwise determined by the local government.
 14. A landscaping plan shall be submitted as a part of a development application for each lot clearly showing the planting of native trees and shrubs around all proposed buildings on the property, to the satisfaction of the local government.
 15. At the time of subdivision the site that includes the historic Coffee Pot and Waggrakine Well as shown of the Subdivision Guide Plan shall be set aside as the Public Open Space to be transferred to the local authority.
 16. The subdivider is to contribute to the upgrade and maintenance of the historic Coffee Pot and Waggrakine Well at the time of subdivision.
