Town Planning Scheme No. 1—Amendment No. 47

Ref: TPS/0195

It is hereby notified for public information, in accordance with section 87 of the *Planning and Development Act 2005* that the Minister for Planning approved the Town of Victoria Park local planning scheme amendment on 7 July 2010 for the purpose of modifying the Town Planning Scheme No. 1 Policy Manual to insert the following words within clause 4.14 Development Standards For Causeway Precinct subclause 4.14.1 General Development Provisions after part (g) Pedestrian and Cyclist Access—

#### (h) RESIDENTIAL DENSITY

For areas coded R160 within the "Development Provisions for Designated Areas" below, the Council may exercise discretion to permit an increased density to a maximum equivalent of R240.

In the exercise of the discretion the Council must be satisfied that if approval were to be granted—

- (i) the development would be consistent with-
  - the orderly and proper planning of the locality;
  - · the conservation of the amenities of the locality; and
  - the statement of intent set out in the relevant Precinct Plan; and
- (ii) the development would not have any undue adverse affect on-
  - · the occupiers or users of the development;
  - · the property in, or the inhabitants of, the locality; or
  - the likely future development of the locality.

In the exercise of this discretion the Council must have regard to any assessment of the application by the Design Review Committee and their advice as to whether the application demonstrates a high standard of development and an appropriate design outcome.


