REPEAL LOCAL LAW 2010

WATER SKI AREA City of Rockingham

Acting pursuant to the powers conferred by Regulation 48A of the Navigable Waters Regulations 1958, the Department of Transport hereby revokes Notice TR402 as published in the *Government Gazette* on 20 October 1998, and defines and sets aside the following area as a water ski area between the hours of sunrise and sunset and orders that bathing shall be prohibited therein—

WARNBRO SOUND: All those waters of Warnbro Sound bounded by lines commencing on the foreshore by the prolongation of Ernest Road, Safety Bay, thence in a south westerly direction to Passage Rock; thence extending approximately 3900 metres south easterly to a point 32° 21.718'S 115° 42.644'E; thence extending approximately 2150 metres easterly to a point 32° 21.718'S 115° 44.028'E.

DANGEROUS GOODS SAFETY ACT 2004
