WEST COAST ROCK LOBSTER MANAGEMENT PLAN AMENDMENT (No. 11) 2010

FD 1064/01 [988]

Made by the Minister under section 54.

1. Citation

This instrument is the West Coast Rock Lobster Management Plan Amendment (No. 11) 2010.

2. Management plan amended

The amendments in this instrument are to the West Coast Rock Lobster Management Plan 1993.

3. Clause 2 amended

Insert in the correct alphabetical position—

CDR book means the Catch and Disposal Record book issued in respect of a licence;

consignment means a quantity of rock lobster transferred by the master of an authorised boat;

holding over book means a book issued by the Department on request that contains holding over forms;

holding over form means a form approved by the CEO for the purpose of recording details of any rock lobster on board an authorised boat after 1930 hours on any day;

registered receiver means—

- (a) the holder of a fish processor's licence authorising a person to process rock lobster and who does not hold a commercial fishing licence, except where the fish processor's licence and the commercial fishing licence were first granted on or before 15 November 2010; or
- (b) a person who has received a certificate in accordance with clause 20A and who is not the holder of a commercial fishing licence;

registered receiver's premises means—

- (a) the premises identified in a fish processor's licence as the fish processing establishment; or
- (b) the premises specified on a registered receiver's certificate;

4. Clause 4A amended

- (1) In clause 4A before "Subject" insert—
 - **(1**)
- (2) In clause 4A after subclause (1) insert—
 - (2) The master of an authorised boat must not permit any rock lobster to be transferred—
 - (a) to another boat from; or
 - (b) from another boat to,

the boat while the boat is at sea in the waters of the Fishery.

5. Clause 4B replaced

Delete clause 4B and insert-

Fishing for rock lobster in approved landing areas and waters surrounding Rottnest Island and Quobba Point

- **4B.** (1) A person must not fish at any time in any of the areas described in Schedule 5.
- (2) A person must not fish during the period commencing on 16 January and ending on 14 November in any year, in the area described in Schedule 6.
- (3) A person must not fish at any time in any of the areas described in Schedule 9.

6. Clauses 5B and 5C inserted

After clause 5A insert—

Requirements in regard to rock lobster consigned for personal consumption

- **5B.** (1) A person on board an authorised boat must not remove rock lobster from the boat without the authority of the master of that authorised boat.
- (2) Where the master of an authorised boat consigns rock lobster for personal consumption the master must, prior to landing any rock lobster, ensure that the second and fourth segments of the tail fan of each rock lobster are clipped or punched.
- (3) In this clause—

clipped means the removal of the bottom half of a segment of the tail fan of a rock lobster;

punched means the punching of a circular hole of not less than 10 millimetres in diameter in a segment of the tail fan of a rock lobster.

Possession of rock lobster for personal consumption

- 5C. (1) A person must not—
 - (a) receive or retain more than 6 rock lobster on any one day for personal consumption; or
 - (b) have possession of any rock lobster for personal consumption unless the tail is clipped or punched in accordance with clause 5B.
- (2) The maximum quantity of rock lobster that have been tail clipped or punched in accordance with clause 5B that a person may be in possession of is 24 rock lobsters.
- (3) Subclause (1) does not apply in respect of rock lobster for which proof of purchase can be immediately provided.

7. Clauses 9L to 9O inserted

After clause 9K insert—

Rock lobster landing areas

- 9L. (1) For the purposes of this plan, an approved landing area is an area described in Schedule 9.
- (2) A person must not—
 - (a) bring onto land, or attempt to bring onto land; or
 - (b) remove from an authorised boat,

any rock lobster, unless it is brought onto land in an approved landing area.

- (3) The master of an authorised boat, prior to entering into an area that is an approved landing area, must—
 - (a) accurately determine the number of rock lobster on board that boat; or
 - (b) store rock lobster on that boat in a sealed container with a landing tag attached in respect of that container, in accordance with clause 9M, and determine the number of those containers of rock lobster on board that boat.
- (4) The master of an authorised boat must ensure that all rock lobster are removed from the boat immediately upon bringing that rock lobster into an area that is an approved landing area.
- (5) The master of an authorised boat must not remove, or permit to be removed, any rock lobster from the approved landing area unless clause 15G has been complied with.

Landing containers and tags

- **9M.** (1) The master of an authorised boat must ensure that rock lobster are stored in a sealed container with a landing tag attached in respect of that container, in accordance with this clause, before it is removed from the boat.
- (2) The landing tag referred to in this clause—
 - (a) is to be issued by the Department; and
 - (b) must be attached to any container containing the rock lobster by passing the landing tag through the lid of that container and the container itself and securing the landing tag through the tag's locking device in such a manner that the landing tag is locked and intact and no rock lobster can be removed or added to that container.
- (3) A person must not use more than 4 landing tags in respect of a container.
- (4) A person must not remove rock lobster from an authorised boat unless that rock lobster is stored in a sealed container with a landing tag attached in respect of that container in accordance with this clause.
- (5) A person must not—
 - (a) transport rock lobster; or
 - (b) store rock lobster at a place that is not a registered receiver's premises,

other than rock lobster in sealed containers with landing tags attached in respect of those containers in accordance with this clause.

- (6) A person must not—
 - (a) remove a landing tag referred to in this clause; or
 - (b) open the container to which a landing tag is attached,

unless that container is at a registered receiver's premises.

- (7) Subclauses 5(b) and (6) do not apply to containers of rock lobster consigned for personal consumption where a person currently recorded on the Crew List-Log Sheet form in the CDR book issued in respect of a licence removes a landing tag or opens a container to which a landing tag is attached at the address specified at Part 1D of the triplicate form in a CDR book in respect of that consignment.
- (8) The master of an authorised boat must at all times keep safe and secure all landing tags and produce the landing tags to a Fisheries Officer on demand.

Weighing rock lobster

- 9N. (1) In this clause
 - gross weight means the weight of rock lobster and the container in which it is held, determined in kilograms to one decimal point (with an amount of 0.05 kilograms or more being rounded upwards to the next 0.1 of a kilogram);
 - **net weight** means the weight of rock lobster only, excluding the weight of the container in which it is held or the weight of any other thing in or attached to that container, determined in kilograms to one decimal point (with an amount of 0.05 kilograms or more being rounded upwards to the next 0.1 of a kilogram).
- (2) Where rock lobster is brought onto land, the master of the authorised boat must—
 - (a) immediately and accurately determine the gross weight and net weight of rock lobster; and
 - (b) ensure that any rock lobster that has been consigned or retained for personal consumption is removed from the boat and weighed before the remainder of rock lobster is weighed; and
 - (c) ensure that the weights referred to in paragraph (a) are determined—
 - (i) within 15 metres of that boat; or
 - (ii) at the nearest weighing point as specified in Schedule 10.
- (3) Subclause (2) does not apply in respect of a licensed carrier boat transporting rock lobster from the Abrolhos Islands Area to the mainland.
- (4) For the purposes of subclause (2), where rock lobster is brought onto the Seabird, Ledge Point or Wedge Island approved landing area, the master of the authorised boat must also immediately complete Part 1D of the form in a CDR book in respect of that rock lobster and which relates to the registered receiver's name and identification number.
- (5) For the purposes of clause 14K, where the weights recorded under clauses 15G(3) and 15I(3) are not the same, the higher weight is to be taken to be a quantity of rock lobster that was taken under the authority of the licence.

Storing rock lobster

- **90.** (1) The master of an authorised boat must not cause or permit any rock lobster to be on board that boat after 1930 hours on any day unless that boat is in an area that is not an approved landing area and—
 - (a) the master of the authorised boat accurately records all the information required in the original copy of a holding over form no later than 1930 hours on each day rock lobster is on board that boat; or
 - (b) the master of the authorised boat has provided verbal notice to the Department by means of a telephone call specifying the location and intended time at which rock lobster will be brought onto land.
- (2) A person must not—
 - (a) store rock lobster in the waters of the Fishery; or
 - (b) take possession of any rock lobster that has been stored in the waters of the Fishery; or
 - (c) bring onto any boat or land any rock lobster that has been stored in the waters of the Fishery.
- (3) A person must not store rock lobster on board a boat in the waters of the Fishery other than in accordance with this plan.
- (4) The master of an authorised boat must ensure that no rock lobster is on board that boat at any time unless the boat was used to take that rock lobster.
- (5) The master of an authorised boat must, immediately after weighing any rock lobster, forward the original copy of the completed holding over form to the Department.
- (6) A person must not record information that is false or misleading in a holding over form.
- (7) The master of an authorised boat must retain the duplicate copy of the completed holding over form, and at all times keep safe and secure the holding over book and all forms (used or unused inside it), and produce the holding over book to a Fisheries Officer on demand.

8. Clause 12A inserted

After clause 12 insert—

Prohibition on dealing or attempting to deal in rock lobster

12A. (1) In this clause—

western rock lobster means fish described by the scientific classification Panulirus cygnus; otherwise dealt with includes handled, transported, weighed and recorded.

- (2) A person must not sell, purchase or deal in, or attempt to sell, purchase or deal in, any western rock lobster taken, landed or otherwise dealt with in contravention of this plan.
- (3) A person must not sell, purchase or deal in or attempt to sell, purchase or deal in any western rock lobster unless that rock lobster was taken and landed by the holder of a commercial fishing licence under the authority of a licence.
- (4) Subclause (3) does not apply to western rock lobster taken by the holder of a commercial fishing licence under the authority of a Windy Harbour-Augusta Rock Lobster managed fishery licence.

9. Clause 14 amended

- (1) In subclause 14(1) delete "16,698 pots. "and insert—16,694 pots.
- (2) Delete subclause 14(3) and insert—
 - (3) Subject to clause 14A, the capacity of zone B of the Fishery after 14 March in any season is 7,449 pots.
 - (4) Subject to clause 14A, the capacity of zone C of the Fishery is 17,817 pots.

10. Clauses 15B to 15J inserted

After clause 15A insert—

Issue of CDR books and replacements

- 15B. (1) Where a licence is in force the licence holder may request the CEO to issue a CDR book in respect of that licence.
- (2) Where a CDR book issued in accordance with subclause (1) cannot be produced, and the licence holder satisfies the CEO of the quantity of rock lobster taken under the authority of the licence, the CEO may issue a replacement CDR book in respect of that licence.

Licence holder or master must not operate unless CDR book issued in respect of a licence

- 15C. (1) The holder of a licence must not operate, or permit a person to operate, unless a CDR book has been issued in respect of that licence.
- (2) The master of an authorised boat must not operate unless the master is in possession of the CDR book issued for the licence specifying the authorised boat.

Obligations in respect of CDR books

- 15D. (1) The master of an authorised boat must return the CDR book to the holder of the licence in respect of which the CDR book has been issued when—
 - (a) the master ceases to be the master in respect of that authorised boat; or
 - (b) the CDR book has been completed; or
 - (c) clause 14K prohibits any further fishing under the authority of the relevant licence.
- (2) The licence holder must—
 - (a) retain the CDR book issued in respect of that licence for 5 years from the date of the last entry in that book; and
 - (b) produce the CDR book to a fisheries officer on demand.
- (3) The master of an authorised boat must accurately record the details of all persons operating under the authority of the licence on the Crew List-Log Sheet form in the CDR book issued in respect of that licence.
- (4) The master of an authorised boat must—
 - (a) keep the CDR book secure and in good condition at all times; and
 - (b) produce the CDR book to a fisheries officer on demand.
- (5) Where the holder of a licence or the master of an authorised boat loses—
 - (a) a CDR book; or
 - (b) a form required to be completed in a CDR book,

the licence holder or master, as the case may be, must immediately report the loss of the CDR book or form to the Department.

Offences in respect of CDR books

15E. A person must not be in possession of a CDR book at a registered receiver's premises.

Requirement of master of authorised boat to make records in a CDR book

15F. On any day that pots are to be pulled, or rock lobster are to be taken or landed by the use of an authorised boat, the master of an authorised boat must make any records required to be made under this plan in a CDR book.

Records required to be made by master

- 15G. (1) The master of an authorised boat must, prior to unloading or landing any rock lobster from an authorised boat, complete Part 1B of the form in a CDR book in respect of that fishing trip by accurately recording—
 - (a) the Zones of the Fishery in which the rock lobster were taken; and

- (b) the fishing block numbers in which most of the fishing for rock lobster occurred; and
- (c) the maximum and minimum depths from which rock lobster were taken; and
- (d) the cumulative total of pots pulled in which rock lobster were taken; and
- (e) the number of days on which pots were pulled; and
- (f) the number of crew on board the authorised boat, including the master; and
- (g) details of any interaction with a protected species as a result of any activity connected with fishing, and whether the organism was alive or dead; and
- (h) the number and estimated weight of any fish other than rock lobster taken and retained.
- (2) The master of an authorised boat must, prior to entering an approved landing area other than at the Abrolhos Islands Area, complete Part 1C of the form in a CDR book in respect of that fishing trip by accurately recording—
 - (a) the landing area; and
 - (b) the date; and
 - (c) the number of rock lobsters or containers of rock lobster on the boat.
- (3) The master of an authorised boat must, immediately after weighing the rock lobster taken on a fishing trip, complete Part 1D of the form in a CDR book in respect of that fishing trip, by accurately recording in respect of each consignment—
 - (a) the number of the licence under the authority of which the rock lobster were taken; and
 - (b) the master's commercial fishing licence number; and
 - (c) the master's full name; and
 - (d) where consignments are made to more than one entity, a sequential consignment number for each consignment; and
 - (e) the number of containers of rock lobster in each consignment; and
 - (f) the serial numbers of the landing tags attached to the containers in a consignment; and
 - (g) the gross and net weights of each consignment; and
 - (h) the time and date the consignments were weighed; and
 - (i) where the rock lobster are to be consigned to registered receivers, the name and registration number of the registered receivers; and
 - (j) whether the master or a crew member will be transporting consignments to the premises of a registered receiver; and
 - (k) whether rock lobster in a consignment are for personal consumption; and
 - (l) where rock lobster have been consigned for personal consumption, the name and residential address of the persons to whom the rock have been consigned.
- (4) The master of an authorised boat must complete Part 1E of the form in a CDR book in respect of that fishing trip by accurately recording in respect of each consignment—
 - (a) the name and licensed fishing boat number of the authorised boat used to take the rock lobster; and
 - (b) the master's current telephone number.
- (5) The master of an authorised boat must complete Parts 1D and 1E of the form in a CDR book in respect of that fishing trip, in respect of each consignment of rock lobster.
- (6) Where rock lobster are to be consigned to a registered receiver, or delivered to a registered receiver by carrier boat, the master of an authorised boat must provide the triplicate of the form in a CDR book in respect of that fishing trip to—
 - (a) the registered receiver, prior to allowing the registered receiver to take possession of the rock lobster; or
 - (b) the master of a carrier boat at the time the rock lobster is delivered to a carrier boat.
- (7) Where rock lobster are brought onto land, and—
 - (a) are to be transported by the master of the authorised boat to a registered receiver; or
 - (b) have been consigned for personal consumption,

the master of the authorised boat must place the triplicate of the form in a CDR book in respect of that fishing trip in a waterproof bag securely attached to a container in that consignment.

(8) Where rock lobster are consigned for personal consumption to a person nominated at Part 1D of the form in a CDR book in respect of that fishing trip, the nominated person must forward the triplicate of that form to the Department at the address specified on the form within 24 hours of the rock lobster reaching the address of the nominated person.

Masters obligations in regard to the forms in a CDR book

- **15H**. (1) The master of an authorised boat must, immediately upon consigning the rock lobster taken on a fishing trip, forward completed original copies of all CDR forms required to be made in respect of that trip to the Department, at the address specified on the relevant forms.
- (2) The master of an authorised boat must—
 - (a) ensure that duplicate copies of all CDR forms remain attached to the CDR book; and
 - (b) complete the forms in a CDR book in consecutive order.

Requirement of registered receiver to complete certain forms in a CDR book

- 15I. (1) A registered receiver must, immediately upon taking possession of a consignment of rock lobster, complete Part 2A of the triplicate form in a CDR book in respect of that consignment and accurately record—
 - (a) the name and registration number of the registered receiver taking possession of the consignment; and
 - (b) the date and time the consignment was received.
- (2) Where a consignment of rock lobster is to be transported by a registered receiver, the registered receiver must complete Part 2B of the triplicate form in a CDR book in respect of that consignment, and accurately record—
 - (a) whether each container of rock lobster in the consignment was tagged and sealed as required under the plan; and
 - (b) the number of containers of rock lobster in the consignment; and
 - (c) the gross weight of the consignment; and
 - (d) the date and time the consignment was weighed; and
 - (e) the printed full name and signature of the natural person receiving the consignment; and
 - (f) the date; and
 - (g) where the registered receiver has provided a receipt for the consignment to the master of the authorised boat, the receipt number.
- (3) Where any rock lobster are brought onto a registered receiver's premises, the registered receiver must complete Part 2C of the triplicate form in a CDR book in respect of that consignment and accurately record—
 - (a) whether all containers in the consignment are tagged and sealed as required under the plan; and
 - (b) the number of containers in the consignment; and
 - (c) the gross weight of the consignment, where necessary; and
 - (d) the net weight of the consignment, as recorded not less than 10 minutes after the gross weight of the consignment was recorded; and
 - (e) the date and time the consignment was weighed; and
 - (f) the printed full name and signature of the person receiving the consignment; and
 - (g) where the registered receiver has provided a receipt to the person who delivered the consignment, the receipt number.
- (4) A registered receiver must, within 24 hours of receiving a triplicate, forward that completed triplicate to the Department at the address specified on the form.

Offences in respect of the forms in a CDR book

- 15J. Any person required under this plan to complete a form or part of a form in a CDR book, must not—
 - (a) fail to complete the forms or parts of a form required to be completed; or
 - (b) provide false or misleading information in a form or part of a form; or
 - (c) fail to forward any form required to be forwarded to the Department.

11. Clauses 20A to 20D inserted

After clause 20 insert—

Person to notify CEO of intent to register as a receiver

- **20A.** (1) A person who intends to receive rock lobster other than as a fish processing licence holder must notify the CEO in writing.
- (2) A person who notifies the CEO in accordance with subclause (1) and who is not the holder of a commercial fishing licence is to be given a certificate stating that the person is a registered receiver.
- (3) A certificate has effect when the person who has notified the Department in accordance with subclause (1) has received a certificate of registration from the Chief Executive Officer.
- (4) A person who is given a certificate under subclause (2) and who becomes a holder of a commercial fishing licence must immediately return that certificate to the Chief Executive Officer.

Master must only consign rock lobster to a registered receiver

- **20B**. The master of an authorised boat must not consign rock lobster taken in respect of a fishing trip to any person other than—
 - (a) a registered receiver; or
 - (b) a person acting on behalf of a fish processing licence holder; or
 - (c) a person currently recorded on the Crew List-Log Sheet form of a CDR book who receives rock lobster taken in respect of a fishing trip for personal consumption, and prior to that rock lobster being landed.

Only registered receiver to receive consignment of rock lobster

- 20C. (1) A person must not receive a consignment of rock lobster unless the person is—
 - (a) a registered receiver; or
 - (b) acting on behalf of a registered receiver; or
 - (c) the recipient of rock lobster consigned for personal consumption in accordance with this plan.
- (2) A person must not receive a consignment of rock lobster unless Part 2A of the triplicate form in a CDR book in respect of that consignment is attached.
- (3) The holder of a commercial fishing licence must not act for or on behalf of a registered receiver.

Registered receiver's obligations where rock lobster are delivered by master

- **20D**. Where rock lobster are received directly from the master of an authorised boat at a registered receiver's premises, the registered receiver must—
 - (a) ensure that the containers holding the rock lobster are tagged and sealed, and remain tagged and sealed until the time referred to in paragraph (b) has elapsed; and
 - (b) ensure that no rock lobster is removed from, or added to, a container until at least 10 minutes after the determination of the gross weight of the rock lobster.

12. Clause 21A replaced

Delete clause 21A and insert—

Offences and major provisions

- 21A. (1) A person who contravenes a provision of—
 - (a) clause 4, 4A, 4B, 5, 5A, 5C(2), 6, 7, 9A, 9C, 9E, 9L, 9M, 9N, 9O, 10, 12, 12A, 14I, 14K, 15C, 15D, 15E, 15F, 15G(2), 15G(3), 15G(4), 15G(5), 15G(6), 15G(7), 15G(8), 15G(9), 15H, 15I, 15J, 19(4), 20A, 20B, 20C or 20D; or
 - (b) clause 5B, 5C(1), 8, 15G(1) or 16,

commits an offence, and for the purposes of Section 75 of the Act the provisions specified in subparagraph (a) are major provisions.

(2) A person who contravenes a provision of clause 9 commits an offence, and for the purposes of Section 75 of the Act clause 9 is a major provision, except in respect of the soaking of a pot in an area that is not a designated rock lobster pot soaking area.

Schedule 9 Landing Areas

[clauses 4B, 9L and 9N]

Area 1: Carnarvon

All waters known as the Carnarvon Boat Harbour upstream of a line commencing at the intersection of $24^{\circ}54.326'$ south latitude and $113^{\circ}39.152'$ east longitude, thence westerly to the intersection of $24^{\circ}54.326'$ south latitude and $113^{\circ}39.035'$ east longitude.

Area 2: Denham

All waters bounded by a line commencing at $25^{\circ}55.675'$ south latitude and $113^{\circ}31.975'$ east longitude, thence to a point at $25^{\circ}55.731'$ south latitude and $113^{\circ}31.939$ east longitude, thence to a point at $25^{\circ}55.777'$ south latitude and $113^{\circ}32.025'$ east longitude, thence to a point at $25^{\circ}55.717'$ south latitude and $113^{\circ}32.062'$ east longitude, thence along a line to the commencement point.

Area 3: Kalbarri

All waters bounded by a line commencing at $27^{\circ}42.526'$ south latitude and $114^{\circ}09.480'$ east longitude, thence along the high water mark to a point at $27^{\circ}41.962'$ south latitude and $114^{\circ}10.164'$ east longitude, thence to a point at $27^{\circ}41.823'$ south latitude and $114^{\circ}10.027'$ east longitude, thence along the high water mark to a point at $27^{\circ}42.403'$ south latitude and $114^{\circ}09.772'$ east longitude, thence along a straight line to the commencement point.

Area 4: Lucky Bay

All waters bounded by a line commencing at $28^{\circ}00.829'$ south latitude and $114^{\circ}09.326'$ east longitude, thence to a point at $28^{\circ}00.829'$ south latitude and $114^{\circ}09.188'$ east latitude, thence to a point at $28^{\circ}00.974'$ south latitude and $114^{\circ}09.227'$ east longitude, thence to a point at $28^{\circ}00.974'$ south latitude and $114^{\circ}09.397'$, thence along a line to the commencement point.

Area 5: Port Gregory

All waters bounded by a line commencing at 28°11.513′ south latitude and 114°15.218′ east longitude, thence to a point at 28°11.624′ south latitude and 114°15.137′ east longitude, thence to a point at 28°11.276′ south latitude and 114°14.263′ east longitude, thence to a point at

28°11.190′ south latitude and 114°14.335′ east longitude, thence along a line to the commencement point.

Area 6: Little Bay

All waters bounded by a line commencing at $28^{\circ}20.500'$ south latitude and $114^{\circ}24.526'$ east longitude, thence to a point at $28^{\circ}20.500'$ south latitude and $114^{\circ}24.000'$ east longitude, thence to a point at $28^{\circ}20.830'$ south latitude and $114^{\circ}24.000'$ east longitude, thence to a point at $28^{\circ}20.830'$ south latitude and $114^{\circ}24.507'$ east longitude, thence along a line to the commencement point.

Area 7: Horrocks

All waters bounded by a line commencing at $28^{\circ}22.680'$ south latitude and $114^{\circ}25.720'$ east longitude, thence to a point at $28^{\circ}22.680'$ south latitude and $114^{\circ}25.577'$ east longitude, thence to a point at $28^{\circ}22.980'$ south latitude and $114^{\circ}25.687'$ east longitude, thence to a point at $28^{\circ}22.980'$ south latitude and $114^{\circ}25.800'$ east longitude, thence along a line to the commencement point.

Area 8: Coronation Beach
