**WESTERN AUSTRALIAN MARINE ACT 1982  
NAVIGABLE WATERS REGULATIONS 1958**

*Shire of Augusta Margaret River*

**PROHIBITED SWIMMING AREA**

Augusta River

Department of Transport,  
Fremantle WA, 4 March 2011.

Acting pursuant to the powers conferred by Regulation 10A (b) of the *Navigable Waters Regulations 1958*, I hereby close all of the following waters to swimming, between 8:00pm and 9:00pm on Sunday 6th March 2011.

**AUGUSTA RIVER:** All the waters within a 200 metre radius around the firing point; located on the Augusta River Mouth at approximately 34° 19'26.44"S 115° 10'18.57"E.

This area is set aside for safety measures during the set up and display of pyrotechnics.
