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ENERGY COORDINATION ACT 1994

APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS TO THE REMCO RETAIL MARKET SCHEME

The Economic Regulation Authority, pursuant to Section 11ZOM of the *Energy Coordination Act* 1994, hereby gives notice that the following amendments to the REMCo Specification Pack and the REMCo Retail Market Rules have been approved—Rule Changes C01/11S, C02/11S, C03/11S, C04/11R and C05/11R.

- Rule Change C01/11S establishes a new version of the Interface Control Document to incorporate changes initiated by the Australian Energy Market Operator in South Australia. The proposed changes only relate to the South Australian gas market.
- Rule Change C02/11S proposes a new version of REMCo's FRC B2M-B2B Hub System Specifications document to amend the definition of high priority transactions.
- Rule Change C03/11S proposes a new version of the Specification Pack Usage Guidelines so that the document refers to the correct versions of several documents in the Specification Pack
- Rule Changes C04/11R and C05/11R propose a new version of the Retail Market Rules to amend a Notice of New or Changed Sub-Network Classification and the definition of Street/Suburb Combination.

REMCo has classified Rule Changes C01/11S, C02/11S, C03/11S and C05/11R as non-substantial rule changes and Rule Change C04/11R as low-impact rule change.

Rule Changes C01/11S, C02/11S, C03/11S, C04/11S and C05/11R are to take effect on 1 August 2011. Details regarding these amendments and the Economic Regulation Authority's decision are available on the Economic Regulation Authority website (www.erawa.com.au).
