Fish Resources Management Act 1994

Fish Resources Management Amendment Regulations (No. 6) 2011

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Fish Resources Management Amendment Regulations (No. 6) 2011*.

A person must not fish for any fish using as bait any abalone material.

A person, other than the holder of a managed fishery licence that authorises abalone to be taken, must not —

- (a) on the seaward side of the high water mark; or
- (b) in the waters of any estuary, river or inlet, or in the entrance to any of those waters,

be in possession of any abalone material other than a whole abalone.

Penalty: a fine of \$10 000.

- (2A) A person, other than the holder of a managed fishery licence that authorises abalone to be taken, must not bring onto land, or attempt to bring onto land, an abalone from which the shell has been removed.

Penalty: a fine of \$5 000 and the penalty provided in section 222 of the Act.

3. All persons on board a vessel operated by an exempt person, when operating at a distance of greater than four hundred (400) metres offshore in unprotected waters, must wear a PFD type 2 (or equivalent) as defined by regulations 46 and 46A of the Regulations.

This exemption is valid from 19 July 2011 until 31 May 2012 unless otherwise revoked.
