**PEARLING ACT 1990**

**CANCELLATION OF PEARL OYSTER FARM LEASE AND  
GRANT OF PEARL OYSTER FARM LEASE**

FD 319/06

I, Stuart Smith, Director General, as CEO of the Department of Fisheries, Western Australia, pursuant to Section 23 and Section 27 of the *Pearling Act 1990* have granted an application by Paspaley Pearling Co Pty Ltd to cancel an existing lease and conditionally issue a new pearl oyster farm lease in the same vicinity of the previous lease, of a larger size, in respect of an area of water located at Seaflower Bay.

The application together with any supporting documents should be lodged with the SAT within 28 days of publication of the Notice. When an application is accepted by the Chief Executive Officer of the SAT, the applicant is to give a copy of the application to the Director General (as CEO), Department of Fisheries, Level 3, 168 St Georges Terrace, Perth WA.
